- Following a 6-0 defeat in the completion of Thursday night's suspended game, the Blue Jays trounced Bradenton 10-1, behind an 8-RBI, 2 HR night from Victor Arias.
- Arias started the scoring with a first inning solo homer.
- After a rain delay, Jays' starter Fernando Perez returned to finish five shutout innings to eventually earn the victory.
- Leading 3-1, Dunedin busted the game open in the bottom of the seventh, as Victor Arias blasted a grand slam to make it 7-1.
- Arias didn't stop there, as he poked a 2-RBI single in the bottom of the eighth to get Dunedin to double digits for the fifth time this season.

ARIAS SHOW

Victor Arias' 8-RBI performance last night marked the most RBIs in a single game by a D-Jay since Blue Jays No. 2 prospect Orelvis Martinez tallied nine, along with three homers, on July 17, 2021. In that same 2021 campaign, Addison Barger tallied 7 RBIs on May 28. The two-homer game is the second by a Blue Jay this season (Feliz, 5/4 vs Tampa). 8-RBIs in a single game are the second-most in the FSL this season, behind Jordan Viars' nine for Clearwater on May 30.

ISN'T IT GRAND?

Victor Arias' seventh inning grand slam last night marked the first of his career and the first by a D-Jay this season of the team's 45 home runs.

SERIES SUCCESS

With last night's win, the Blue Jays have clinched five straight sets with a split or better. Across that stretch, Dunedin has earned two splits and two series wins. Across the last five weeks, the Jays are 18-14. Last week's series win on the road marked the Jays' first road series victory since they took five of six from Tampa, April 9-14.

STAYING ABOVE WATER

Thanks to wins in six of the last seven games, Dunedin has remained above .500 for four straight gamedays, the team's longest stretch of days above .500 since the squad was above the mark from April 7-24.

BLUE JAYS' BATS BOPPING

With last night's 10-run performance, the D-Jays have tallied eight runs or more four times in the last seven contests, including twice in this week's series vs Bradenton. The team's .249 batting average in 12 games this month ranks third in the FSL.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

With Wednesday night's 2-1 win, Dunedin has played 21 one-run games this season, going 10-11 in those contests. 41 of the Blue Jays 61 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 21-20 record in those games. In a rare occurrence, both games yesterday were decided by six or more runs.

BIG TIME BULLPEN

Across the last 11 games, Dunedin's bullpen has posted a 2.93 ERA in 40 innings of work (13 ER). Of those 11 games, the Blue Jays' pen has turned in a scoreless effort in six of them. Overall this season, the Jays bullpen ERA stands at 4.25 (6th in the league).

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays are tied for third in the Florida State League with 45 home runs, trailing Daytona by three for the league lead. 26 of those home runs have come at TD Ballpark. The team's 45 homers are good for fourth in all of Single-A. The Blue Jays led Single-A with 27 homers in the month of May.

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split twice and won twice.

A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his seventh start with the Blue Jays this evening. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot is the Cavemen.
