Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies got back to an even .500 record (9-9) with a dominant 6-1 win over the Akron RubberDucks on Friday. Justin Verlander shined in his rehab start for Binghamton and Matt Rudick led the way offensively with a three-hit, two-RBI day. The Ponies scored two rusn in the third and four in the seventh to get out to a 6-0 lead. Tanner Murphy had an RBI single and Rowdey Jordan smacked a two-RBI triple.

Justin Verlander's Rehab Start with Binghamton: New York Mets pitcher and three-time Cy Young Award winner Justin Verlander made a rehab start with the Rumble Ponies on Friday. He threw 4.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts and allowed just two hits and issued one walk. He threw 69 pitches and 52 strikes.

Rudy: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** had his second three-hit game of the season on Friday, and also drove in two runs. Rudick has upped his average to .312 and is tied for the team lead in hits with 16. Rudick ranks second in the Eastern League in OBP (.460) and fifth in OPS (1.000).

Matty O My: Catcher **Matt O'Neill** snapped an 0-for-20 skid with a go-ahead solo homer in Tuesday's series opener. O'Neill later smacked an RBI double. He drilled a game-tying RBI double in the final frame of the second game of the doubleheader on Thursday. In the series, O'Neill has a homer, two doubles, three RBIs, and two runs.

Jose, Jose, Jose: Infielder Jose Peroza has a team-leading five hits in this series, with a home run, five RBIs, and two runs. He is 5-for-11 (.455) with a .455 OBP, .727 SLG, and 1.182 OPS. He had three hits and three RBIs in Tuesday's series opener and had a solo homer and an RBI single across the doubleheader on Thursday.

Upcoming Schedule: Binghamton will finish its series with the RubberDucks on Sunday at Mirabito Stadium with first pitch set for 1:05 PM. The game will be broadcast on WNBF News Radio 1290 AM and 92.1 FM, and MiLB.TV and the Bally Live App.

Last Start: Vasil settled in well towards the end of his start on Saturday in Hartford. He allowed four runs and three earned runs in the first two innings and then retired nine of the final 10 hitters that he faced in the outing. Vasil finished with seven strikeouts, including five in his final three innings of work.

2022: Went 4-2 with a 3.53 ERA in 18 appearances and 17 starts across three levels. Made eight starts for both St. Lucie (A) and Brooklyn (A+). Went 3-1 with a 2.19 ERA for St. Lucie and 1-1 with a 5.13 ERA for the Cyclones. With St. Lucie, he allowed opponents to bat .193 against him. With Brooklyn, opponents hit .197 against him. He totaled 85 strikeouts in 71.1 innings across the three levels.

BACKGROUND: Begins the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' No. 4 pitching prospect and the No. 11 overall prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Virginia. Helped lead UVA to the College World Series in his final season as a junior in 2021, while ranking in the top 10 in the ACC in strikeouts looking (33), wins (7), and innings pitched (81.2). Was the 2017 Massachussetts Player of the Year and Perfect Game's No. 1 overall player out of Mass. and the No. 7 pitcher in the country out of high school.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization.
