Tonight: Coming off a loss in the series opener, the Lugnuts play the second game in a six-game series against the TinCaps in the second of 18 meetings between the two clubs this season. 23-year-old left-hander **Brady Basso** becomes the first Lansing pitcher to make his third start of the season, taking on Fort Wayne right-hander **Edgar Martinez**, one of six Edgar Martinezes to have played professional baseball, who is also making his third start of 2021.

Last Night: TinCaps 13, Lugnuts 1. Third baseman Jordan Díaz launched his second home run of the season, his first since Opening Day, and that was pretty much all that happened on a warm Tuesday night at Parkview Field. Oh, and also Agustin Ruiz hit a third-inning three-run homer, a fourth-inning grand slam and a fifth-inning RBI single in a performance that tied the Fort Wayne franchise single-game RBI record.

Last Transaction: The Nuts have made only one roster move this year, placing starting pitcher **Jeff Criswell** on the Injured List and adding relief pitcher **Brandon Withers** from Extended Spring Training on May 12th. Withers, the 835th player in Lugnuts team history.

## Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020). The Athletics had previously partnered with Lugnuts rivals Burlington (1963-1974, 2011-2012), West Michigan (1994-1996), Kane County (1993-2010) and Beloit (2013-2020).

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

League Ranks: Despite allowing 13 runs yesterday, the Lugnuts' pitching staff continues to lead the High-A Central with a 2.61 earned run average. The Nuts also still lead the league in fewest walks (38), despite walking 10 TinCaps batters yesterday, and rank first as well in GO/AO ratio (1.70) and most runners caught stealing (8 in 26 attempts).

**Double Your Fun:** The The Lugnuts' offense leads the circuit in doubles (31), six more than second-place Fort Wayne, though the Lugnuts have also scored the fewest runs in the league (49). That team doubles total is tied for 5th-most in Minor League Baseball with the Modesto Nuts, trailing the Everett AquaSox (40), Lynchburg Hillcats (34), Sugar Land Skeeters (32) and Tampa Tarpons (32). Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** leads the High-A Central with six doubles and infielder **Ryan Gridley** is tied for fourth with four doubles.

A Slew of Starters: The Lugnuts have used eight starting pitchers this season, with a ninth on the horizon, namely: Seth Shuman (May 4, May 15); Brady Basso (May 5, May 12); Richard Guasch (May 6); Reid Birlingmair (May 7, May 14); Jeff Criswell (May 8); Stevie Emanuels (May 9, May 16); Rafael Kelly (May 11, May 18); and Shohei Tomioka (May 13); with Colin Peluse scheduled to start for the first time on Saturday.

**Port Side:** Low-A Stockton, a rung below the Lugnuts on the A's organizational ladder, is seeing exceptional play from two top prospects, outfielder **Lazaro Armenteros** and catcher **Tyler Soderstrom**, with both collecting three hits yesterday. Armenteros is hitting .400/.417/.514 in eight games and Soderstrom, the A's first-rounder in 2020, raised his slash line to .292/.404/.375 in 13 games. Should both players continue to excel, they should see time in Lansing this year.

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo coincidentally making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

## **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

**2012:** Lake County out-hit the Lugnuts, 10-2, but the Lugnuts beat the Captains, 2-1, at Classic Park. In the sixth inning, Kevin Pillar's sacrifice fly and Andy Burns's RBI double supplied all of the scoring the Lugnuts needed. The Caps left 12 runners on base and went 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University, and **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.) are the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

Finally: Pitchers Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielders Michael Guldberg and Jake Suddleson are all making their pro debut this season

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder Jake Suddleson and first baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Teammates Then, Teammates Now: Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. Jake Suddleson and Patrick McColl played together at Harvard, Reid Birlingmair and Charlie Cerny pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but William Simoneit played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing Colin Peluse by a year. Simoneit has caught Peluse twice this season, forming a full Demon Deacon battery.



Pronunciation: Brady's last name is pronounced "bass-o," with 'bass" like the fish rather than the instrument.

Last Outing: Started Wednesday, May 12th at Dayton, and fired three scoreless innings, allowing two hits, striking out five... received no-decision in Lugnuts' 7-2 victory... allowed leadoff single to Brian Rey in 1st inning and then picked him off, striking out Michael Siani and Quin Cotton to end the inning... gave up a two-out single to Victor Ruiz in the 2nd inning but retired Miguel Hernandez on a flyout to strand the runner at first... caused his own troubles in the 3rd inning, following a strikeout of Bren Spillane, allowed Jacob Hurtubise to reach on his own fielding error; after a passed ball by Drew Millas moved Hurtubise to second, committed a throwing error on a pickoff to advance Hurtubise to third; struck out Brian Rey and dispatched Michael Siani with a groundout to strand Hurtubise at third and end the inning and his outing... 46 pitches, 26 for strikes.

**Previously in 2021:** Used in a piggyback role with Rafael Kelly, Basso started the second game of the 2021 season for the Lugnuts... worked around a one-out single in the 1st inning, a two-out single in the 2nd and a one-out two-base error in the 3rd... ran into trouble in the 4th, allowing a leadoff triple to George Valera followed by consecutive singles, giving Lake County a 1-0 lead... recovered with a double-play grounder and a groundout, ending his outing: 4 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 2 K... charged with the loss as the Lugnuts fell, 3-1, to the Captains.

Raising Expectations: An MLB.com from Athletics MiLB camp by Jonathan Mayo on April 28, 2021, carried a bit of surprising news on a couple of breakout pitchers. One of them was today's starter. As Mayo wrote, "Brady Basso's role is changing. A lefty who signed for just \$75,000 as a 16th-round pick in the 2019 Draft out of Oklahoma State, Basso pitched almost exclusively in relief in college and threw well in that role in the Rookie-level Arizona League in 2019. Now that he's up to 95-96 mph with his fastball to go along with a curve that flashes plus and a work-in-progress changeup, he's going to get the chance to start." Melissa Lockard, writing for The Athletic on May 2, 2021, included Basso in her Lugnuts preview, writing, "Left-hander Brady Basso (2019, 16th round) opened a lot of eyes this spring with his fastball sitting at 95-97 mph."



**Pro Debut:** Brady pitched for Athletics Gold in the AZL after signing: 15 G, 1 GS, 1.64 ERA, 25 2/3 IP, 0 HR, 8 BB, 38 K... limited right-handed hitters to .194/.257/.313 in 74 PA, while lefties hit .250/.344/.286 in 32 PA... opposing base stealers were nabbed twice out of three attempts... made first professional start on 8/16/19, tossing three innings with 4 K's.

**Draft Day:** Basso was selected 494th overall in the 16th round of the 2019 draft from Oklahoma State... scout: Chris Reilly... signed for \$75,000... in the same round, two all-name players were drafted: the Tigers selected Kona Quiggle and the Blue Jays took Jackxarel Lebron... one of eight OSU Cowboys to be drafted in 2019... one of 10 Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 9th round (Colin Peluse), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 20th round (Jack Weisenburger), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall).

**Baseball Runs in the Family:** Brady's father, Mike, played in the minors for nine seasons in the San Diego Padres system, 1986-1994, rising as high as Triple-A... after retiring as a player, immediately began managing in 1995 at age 30, and managed in the Padres' org. from 1995-2000... joined the Toronto Blue Jays and managed in the Jays system in 2003-2006 and 2009... spent the next decade as an MLB scout before being let go by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2020.

Hometown: Hails from Pearland ("PAIR-land"), Texas, south of Houston... Megan Thee Stallion spent her teen years living in Pearland... during senior year at Pearland H.S., posted 0.48 ERA, with 101 strikeouts in 57 innings... also from Pearland H.S.: Kirk Dressendorfer, Clay Hensley and Robbie Weinhardt... in addition to starring in baseball, was named All-District in football.

College Days: Brady was primarily a reliever at Oklahoma State (12 G, 2 GS as freshman; 18 G, 5 GS as sophomore; 14 G, 0 GS as a junior)... after a rough sophomore season (8.27 ERA), rebounded as a junior (1.64 ERA, 11.0 IP, 6 H, 16 K)... majored in finance in Stillwater.
