SUNDAY: The Richmond Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 6-2, on a walk-off grand slam by **Will Wilson** in the bottom of the 10th inning. The 10th inning began with a sacrifice bunt to move **Jacob Heyward** to third. After back-to-back intentional walks, Wilson drove a 3-1 pitch over the left field wall to win the game and the series. Altoona opened a 1-0 lead in the second with an RBI double by Connor Scott. Blake Sabol extended the lead to 2-0 with a solo home run in the fifth. In the bottom of the fifth, **Shane Matheny** worked a bases-loaded walk to bring home Richmond's first run. In the eighth, **Brett Auerbach** grounded into an out, scoring Matheny from third and tying the game. **Tristan Beck** started for Richmond and allowed two runs over five innings with six strikeouts. Relievers **Ryan Walker**, **Tyler Schimpf**, **John Russell** and **R.J. Dabovich** combined five scoreless innings. The Flying Squirrels were held to three hits in the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the opener of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This series is the only trip to Erie for the Flying Squirrels. The two teams will play twice in Richmond this season, including a six-game series from June 7-12 and another from September 13-18. Four of the six games in this week's series are day games.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have won four-of-five and sit in first place in the Eastern League's Southwestern Division. In last week's series, the Flying Squirrels dropped their home opener before winning four-of-the-next five games against the Curve at The Diamond. Last season, the Flying Squirrels went 57-56, their first winning season since 2015, and finished fourth in the Double-A Northeast's Southwest Division.

THE SEAWOLVES have lost five-of-the-last-seven games, including four-of-six in last week's series at Somerset. Erie's pitching staff has thrown two shutouts this season, including a 2-0 win on Opening Day and a 3-0 shutout last Wednesday at Somerset. Erie's roster includes seven of MLB.com's Top-30 Tigers prospects, including catcher Dillon Dingler (4), infielder Gage Workman (11), RHP Reese Olson (17), outfielder Daniel Cabrera (22), infielder Andre Lipcius (26), RHP Garrett Hill (27) and RHP Austin Bergner (30). Last year, the SeaWolves went 64-55 and finished third in the Double-A Northeast's Southwest Division, 8.5 games out of a playoff spot.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Matt Frisbee** makes his season debut. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1-3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with **Joey Marciano**, **Matt Seelinger** and **Patrick Ruotolo** for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. **For more on Frisbee, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Adam Wolf makes his second start of the season. In his Double-A debut last Wednesday at Somerset, Wolf worked 3.2 scoreless innings with three walks and five strikeouts. He was drafted by the Tigers in the fifth round in 2018 out of the University of Louisville, where he played two seasons alongside Richmond infielder **Tyler Fitzgerald**. He also played summer ball in the NECBL for the Newport Gulls in 2016 with Richmond infielder **Shane Matheny**. Wolf split 2021 with Low-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan, going 6-7 with a 4.12 ERA in 23 outings (21 starts). Following the season, he was named an MiLB.com Tigers Organization All-Star.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Through Saturday, the Flying Squirrels hold the third-highest average attendance of all 30 teams in Double-A at 6,486 fans per game, trailing only Portland (7,191) and Frisco (6,829). The Flying Squirrels have sold out all 12 of their home openers, including last Tuesday night. That game tied the third-largest crowd for the team at The Diamond in franchise history, evening the July 4 games in 2017 and 2018. The only two crowds with larger crowds were the home openers in 2018 and 2019, which drew 9,845 fans. Tuesday's crowd at The Diamond was the largest crowd in Double-A so far this season and the fourth-largest crowd of all 120 teams in Minor League Baseball.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 15 home runs this season, which is first in the Eastern League and leads all of Double-A. After hitting three homers in the season-opening series at Bowie from April 8-10, the Flying Squirrels hit 12 home runs over six games in their first homestand against Altoona last week. **Sean Roby** is leading the league with six homers on the season, including five in last week's series. Last Wednesday, the Flying Squirrels set the franchise record for homers in an inning with four in the fourth, and set a team record with five homers in the game.

BIG BATS: The Flying Squirrels offense is leading the Eastern League in runs (54), hits (79), homers (15), RBIs (49) and walks (41). The team is also ranked second in batting average (.261) and on-base percentage (.360), third in OPS (.806) and fourth in slugging percentage (.446).

A ROBUST WEEK: **Sean Roby** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after his performance during last week's six-game series against the Curve. In his five games, Roby hit .467 (7-for-15) and led the league with five homers and nine RBIs while adding five walks in five games played. He went 3-for-5 and homered twice last Wednesday with three RBIs. Last Thursday, he hit a two-run, go-ahead homer in the eighth inning in a 5-4 win. After he was out of the lineup on Friday, Roby returned on Saturday and added three more hits, including two homers, and drove in four runs in the Flying Squirrels' 8-4, comeback win. On the year, Roby is ranked tied for second in the minors with six homers and fifth in OPS.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Sean Roby** is leading the Eastern League in home runs (6), OPS (1.486) and total bases (28) and ranks ninth in batting average (.357), tied for second in RBIs (11), fourth in on-base percentage (.486), tied for first in slugging percentage (1.000), tied for seventh in hits (10), tied for second in extra-base hits (6) and third in runs scored (9). **Brett Auerbach** is ranked tied for seventh in hits (10). **Will Wilson** is tied for fifth in walks (7). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for fourth in stolen bases (3). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (2).

THE DENNIS PELFREY ERA: On March 3, **Dennis Pelfrey** was named the new manager for the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Last year in his first season as a manager in affiliated baseball, he led the Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship. Pelfrey, 44, played six professional seasons in independent baseball from 1999-2004. He began his coaching career at South Grand Prairie High School in Texas in 2006, a position he held through 2015. He continued that role as he began his professional coaching career in 2011 with the Gary SouthShore RailCats, where he spent four seasons. Pelfrey landed his first managerial job in 2015 with the Florence Freedom of the independent Frontier League, a role he held for five seasons through 2019. He was hired by the Giants entering the 2020 season to manage High-A San Jose before the season was canceled due to the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. Under his direction last year, the Emeralds went 69-50 before topping Spokane in the High-A West Championship Series.

WHATS OLD IS NEW AGAIN: This year, Minor League Baseball's 11 leagues returned to their historical names after using regional names for the 2021 season. With the restructuring of the player development system prior to last season, the former Eastern League was referred to as the Double-A Northeast. This year, the circuit was renamed back to the Eastern League, which dates back to 1923. However, the league's divisions will continue with the new names adopted last year. The Flying Squirrels play in the Southeast Division, which was previously called the Western Division. The former Eastern Division was renamed the Northeast Division last year.

REWRITING THE RULES: New experimental rules are in effect during the Flying Squirrels' season. With runners on base, pitchers will risk automatic baserunner advancement if a third pick-off attempt or step-off within the same plate appearance is made without recording an out. The size of the bases has increased from 15 inches square to 18 inches square in an attempt to reduce injuries. Defensively, teams must have a minimum of four players on the infield and two infielders complete on either side of second base.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tristan Beck** (30), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes **Dabovich** (17), **Wilson** (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
