**'DOGS DROP THREE TO FIGHTINS** The Portland Sea Dogs (33-29) dropped third straight to the Reading Fightin Phils (28-34) with 5-2 loss on Saturday night. Marcelo Mayer hit his Double-A leading twenty-third double of the season while Kyle Teel recorded a multi-hit day going two-for-three. Wikelman Gonzalez fired 2.0 scoreless allowing three hits while striking out five. He did not issue a walk. Reading took a 2-0 lead in the bottom of the second inning after an RBI single from Trevor Schwecke along with a double from Bryce Ball. Portland cut the lead in half scoring a run in the top of the third. Teel would tie the game at two in the top of the fifth after a single to left field scored Mayer. A pair of homers would seal the deal for Reading. A solo homer from Carlos De La Cruz in the bottom of the fifth inning along with a two-run home run from Otto Kemp in the bottom of the seventh would secure a 5-2 Reading win.

**SEA DOGS STREAKS** Roman Anthony enters today riding a fifteen-game on-base streak along with a six-game hit streak. Across his last six games, Anthony is hitting .458 (11-24) with nine runs, four doubles, one triple, two homers, four RBI, one walk, one strikeout, and one stolen base along with a .519 OBP. Kyle Teel also enters today riding a seven-game hit streak where he has hit .357 (10-28) with two doubles, four RBI, four walks, nine strikeouts, and two stolen bases.

**ALL GOOD THINGS COME TO AN END** Blaze Jordan's Eastern League-leading nineteen-game hit streak came to an end after Friday night's game. Across those nineteen games, Jordan hit .363 (29-80) with ten runs, six doubles, three homers, sixteen RBI, five walks, nine strikeouts, and a .402 OBP. It is still the longest hit streak for an Eastern League bat this season with the second longest being Matthew Lugo's fourteen-game hit streak that lasted from April 14th-May 4th.

**HAVE A HIT** The Portland Sea Dogs are currently hitting .291 in the month of June which ranks second best in all of Double-A just behind the Montgomery ranks first (.297). In the month, Roman Anthony leads the way with a .458 average across seven games. Anthony has gone 11-24 with ten runs along with four doubles, one triple, two homers, four RBI, one walk, one strikeout, and one stolen base. Portland still leads all of Double-A in doubles with 147 while Montgomery ranks second with 125. Portland also sports the best average in the Eastern League currently (.265) which also ranks third best in all of Double-A.

**RECAPPING READING** This week will mark the third of four series against Reading this season. Portland currently owns a 11-6 record against the Fightin Phils. Portland took four of six in the first road series against Reading on April 9th-14th while taking five of six in a series at Hadlock Field from April 30th-May 5th.

**PROMISING PROSPECTS IN PORTLAND** The top three prospects in Boston's system (according to MLB.com) will begin the season in Portland with Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), and Kyle Teel (3) headlining the Opening Day Roster. In total, the current Sea Dogs roster boasts eleven of Boston's Top 30 Prospects according to MLB.com with Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Nick Yorke (6), Luis Peralas (9), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), Angel Bastardo (26), and Kristian Campbell (30) completing the group.

**THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY:** June 18, 2019 – Matthew Kent fired seven scoreless on two hits, as Portland won at Erie, 2-1...Luke Tandler knocked in both runs with a double and a single...Adam Lau worked the final inning to secure his fourth save of the year.

**PITCHING PREVIEW** RHP Bryan Mata will have the start in the series finale in what will be his second rehab start with the Portland Sea Dogs. In his first start with Portland on May 23rd, Mata tossed 3.0 innings allowing three runs on five hits while striking out two. Mata tallied a 9.00 ERA while holding opponents to a .417 average against him in his start against Hartford.

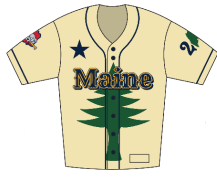

## Sea Dogs Coaching Staff

### **CHAD EPPERSON - MANAGER**

Epperson returns for his third season as Portland's manager. In 2023, he led the Sea Dogs to an overall record of 73-63 (.537). In 2022, Epperson led the Sea Dogs to a Double-A best 45-24 (.652) record in the second half, securing Portland's first post-season berth since 2014. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator. Prior to that, he spent his first eight seasons with the Red Sox as a manager or coach at the minor league level. A manager from 2004-09, he led his club to the playoffs in four straight campaigns beginning in 2006, including Single-A Salem in 2009. A back-to-back California League Manager of the Year with Lancaster from 2007-08, he also managed Wilmington to the playoffs in 2006. The Kentucky native managed Capital City in 2005 and Augusta in 2004 after spending two seasons (2002-03) as Sarasota's hitting coach. He also managed Cook County of the independent Frontier League in 2001. Epperson played nine years in the minor leagues in the Mets (1992-95), Red Sox (1997-99), and Orioles (2000) systems before his coaching career.

### **CHRIS HESS - HITTING COACH**

Chris returns to Portland after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. During his time with the Drive, they ranked first in batting average (.259), hits (1,133), doubles (249), second in triples (36) and third in RBI (618) in the South Atlantic League. The Drive were also crowned South Atlantic League champions for the 2023 season. This year will mark Hess' fourth year in the Red Sox organization. Previously, he was an assistant coach at the University of Rhode Island, his alma mater, after three seasons playing in the New York Yankees organization (2017-19). Hess replaces former Hitting Coach Doug Clark who was promoted to be the Hitting Coach for the Triple-A Worcester Red Sox.

### **SEAN ISAAC - PITCHING COACH**

Isaac enters his second season as a coach in the Red Sox organization. He led the Sea Dogs to a 4.10 ERA and 30 saves in 2023. His pitching staff finished the year with 1,308 strikeouts, fifth most in the Eastern League. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara. He spent three seasons (2016-2018) as a minor league pitcher in the Angels organization reaching the Triple-A level in 2017 and 2018. In 78 career games, he notched a 9-4 record with a 4.34 ERA. On May 2, 2018, he pitched the final inning of a combined no-hitter for Inland Empire.

### **MICKEY JIANG - COACH**

The 2024 season will be Jiang's 18th with the Red Sox where he has held several different roles, including work as a consultant with International Scouting (2007-2012). He has been coaching in the Red Sox minor league system since 2009. He previously served as a coach in Portland from 2016-2017 and 2023. He served as a coach with Single-A Greenville in 2022 and with Fort Myers in 2012 and 2018-2021. A native of Taiwan, Jiang received his B.A. in International Trade from Tung-Hai University.

### **KYLE SASALA- COACH**

Kyle joins Portland's staff after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record. The Wolverines also won 28 games in both 2021 and 2022. In 2019, Sasala assisted head coach Matt Royer in leading the Wolverines to a then-program record 28 victories. He served as the team's interim head coach during the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, guiding Grove City to a runner-up finish. Portland's former coach in 2023, Pablo Cabrera, was promoted to Complex Defensive Coach based out of Fort Myers with the Red Sox.

### **JUSTIN FROMETA - DEVELOPMENT COACH**

Justin begins his second season as the Sea Dogs Development Coach and fourth in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as a Baseball Operations Associate and Player Development Associate for the Red Sox. He is a 2020 graduate of Tufts University.

### **BOBBY STACHURA - ATHLETIC TRAINER**

Stachura returns to Portland for his second season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013. He received his M.S. from the University of Rhode Island's Department of Kinesiology in 2015.

### **DONNY GRESS- STRENGTH AND CONDITIONING COACH**

After spending the last two seasons with the Greenville Drive, Donny Gress joins the Sea Dogs for the first time. Previously, Gress spent four years at the University of Kentucky, first as a graduate assistant (2018-2020), before becoming a coaching assistant with the Wildcats' Olympic Strength and Conditioning staff. Joe Hudson has been promoted to Worcester's Strength and Conditioning Coach after previously working with Portland in the same role in 2023.

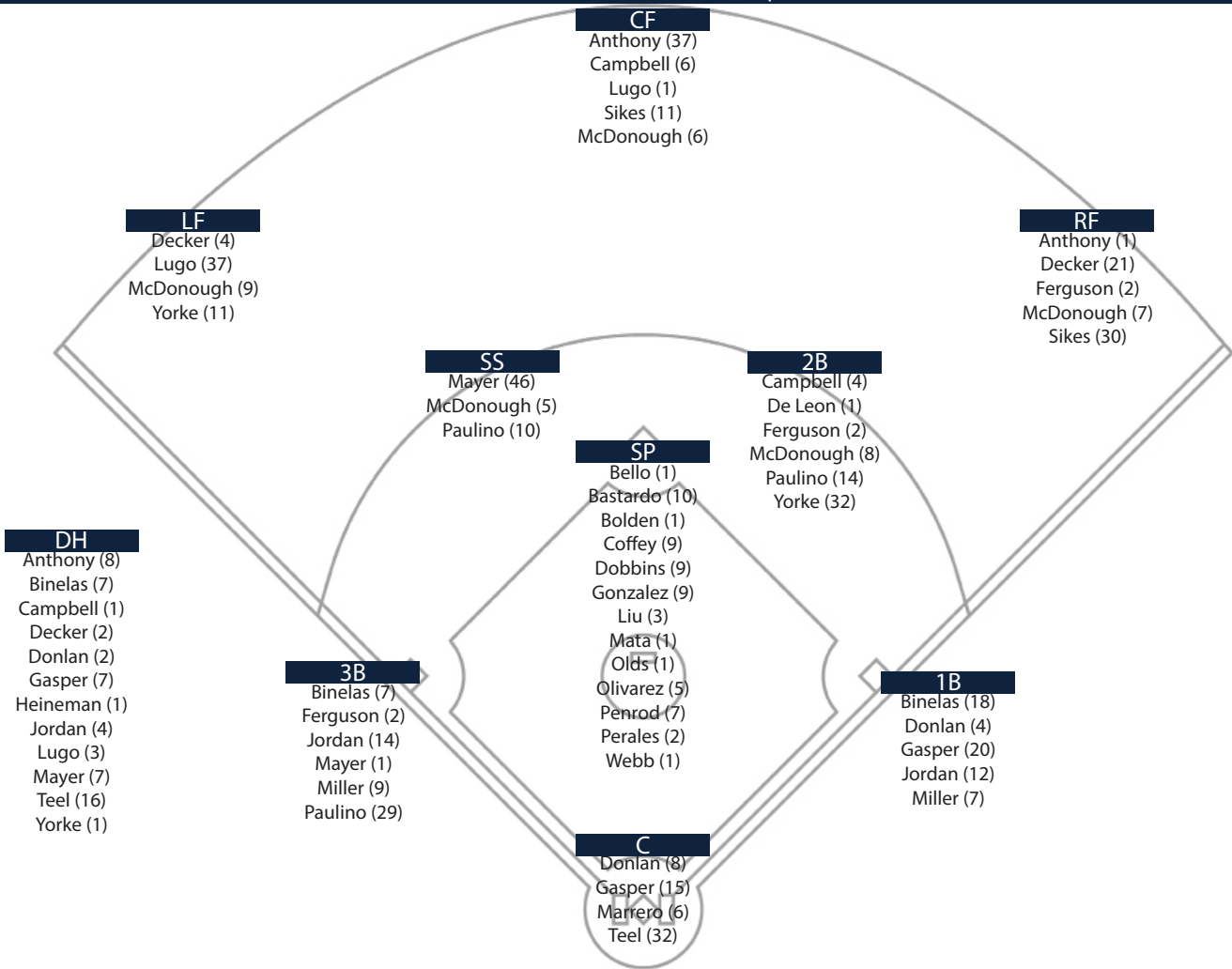
