NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

The 2026 season has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha but things are trending up, with the Chasers coming off series wins over Toledo and St. Paul.

- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha has won 10 of the last 16, since May 9.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... last year, the Chasers had just one winning month, going 15-11 in August ... with a 12-10 record in May, the Storm Chasers need to win 2 of their final 4 this month for a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Prior to Sunday's win, the Chasers had been under .500 for 29 days, from April 24 to May 23 ... Omaha has spent 18 days at or above .500, 15 of which came consecutively in a 13-game stretch from April 10 to 24.

SERIES SPEAKING

Last week's series win was Omaha's 2nd straight and the club's 5th of 9 series this year. The Chasers have won 5 of their 8 week-long series this season - taking series against Buffalo (4-2), Iowa (3-2), Indianapolis (4-2), Toledo (4-2) and St. Paul (4-2). In 4 of this season's 5 series wins, Omaha won the series opener ... in 3 of the series wins - against Buffalo, Toledo and St. Paul - the clubs split the first four games before the Storm Chasers took both remaining contests to claim the series.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have trailed at some point in each of their last 8 wins, with Sunday's 5-3 victory representing Omaha's 15th overall comeback win this year.

- Over Omaha's last 8 wins (since May 13), the Storm Chasers have trailed for a total of 16 1/2 innings, 6.5 of those innings coming in 4 wins last week in St. Paul.
- Omaha's 15 comeback wins rank tied for the 2nd-most in the International League and tied 4th at the Triple-A level ... the Chasers' '99 comeback wins since 2024 rank 2nd-most in the International League and 3rd-most at the Triple-A level.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.

- Omaha's 84.1% success rate (58-for-69) ranks 3rd in the IL and 5th in Triple-A.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (13) ... **Gavin Cross** has 11 steals in as many tries, tied for the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 9 bags, while **Tyler Tolbert** has 8 steals.

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE

A constant in 2026 has been Omaha's ability to go deep in plate appearances.

- The Storm Chasers are seeing 3.984 pitches per plate appearance, 4th-most in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.
- Among 182 Triple-A players with 150+ plate appearances this year, **Kameron Misner** is 6th in pitches seen/PA (4.412) while **John Rave** ranks 9th (4.347).

DON'T BRETT, SQUIRES IS HERE!

Chasers first baseman **Brett Squires** has been on fire across his first two weeks at the Triple-A level, since earning a promotion to Omaha on May 12.

- After a 1-for-15 start in his first 4 Triple-A games, Squires is 15-for-38 (.395) over his last 10 games with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs and 14 RBI.
- Combining his Double-A and Triple-A games, Squires is hitting .296 (51-for-172) with 15 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 45 RBI and a .996 OPS ... he ranks tied 2nd among Minor Leaguers in extra-base hits (29), tied 8th in the Minors in RBI and total bases (107), tied 9th in home runs and 10th in slugging percentage (.622).
- His 11 extra-base hits since May 16 are the most of any player in baseball (Majors & Minors), while 39 total bases in that stretch the most in the Minors and 2nd-most in baseball ... his 1.465 OPS since May 16 is the 2nd-best in baseball (min. 30 PA), trailing **Drew Cavanaugh** (1.528, RIC/SAC) and ahead of **Ketel Marte** (1.432, AZ).

MAYS-TERCLASS

With one week remaining in the month of May, the Storm Chasers have one of the league's best hitters this month and a trio of strong bullpen arms.

- Luca Tresh** has been one of the International League's best hitters in May, hitting .407 (24-for-59) with 8 extra-base hits and 13 RBI in 16 games, for a 1.045 OPS ... 20 hits in games he's caught this month are 3rd-most among MiLB catchers.
- Eric Cerantola**, **Jose Cuas** and **Ben Sears** have all been especially effective out of Omaha's bullpen this month ... Cerantola has pitched to a 1.13 ERA (1 ER in 8.0 IP) while Cuas has a 2.79 ERA (3 ER in 9.2 IP) in 10 games this month and Sears has worked a 3.31 ERA (6 ER in 16.1 IP) over 7 May appearances.

TODAY'S APPEARANCE

- Henry Williams is making his **2nd start** this year with the Storm Chasers, his **3rd Triple-A appearance** and his **10th overall appearance** this season.
- Playing his **4th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Williams' 1st career outing against Memphis ... has a 2.35 ERA in 8 career appearances against other Cardinals affiliates; pitched in 4 games against Springfield (AA) and 4 against Peoria (A+).

HENRY'S HUNCH

- ROAD TO OMAHA:** Williams was assigned to Omaha on May 12 for his second stint with the Storm Chasers after making his Triple-A debut last May ... he allowed 9 ER in 8.0 innings (10.13 ERA) across 2 starts at Triple-A last year (May 27 to June 5) ... in 20 appearances (18 starts) after returning to Double-A, he posted a 4.16 ERA (45 ER in 97.1 IP) for the Naturals.
- STRENGTH AND STAMINA:** Williams got off to a hot start in 2026, allowing 2 earned runs or less while going 5.0+ innings in 4 of his last 6 starts at Double-A ... following his stretch with the Storm Chasers in 2025, Williams went back to Northwest Arkansas (AA) and pitched 5.0+ innings in 13 of his last 18 starts at Double-A.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, MAY 23 @ ST. PAUL

- Made his 2nd Triple-A appearance of the season in relief of Andrew Pérez ... entered the game to begin the bottom of the 6th inning, but allowed a leadoff home run to Royce Lewis before walking the bases loaded with nobody out ... struck out back-to-back batters then allowed a 2-run single before working out of the 6th ... allowed another solo homer to Lewis in the bottom of the 7th ... recorded one out in the bottom of the 8th before a pair of singles chased him from the game.

- Made 7 starts for Northwest Arkansas before his promotion to Omaha ... worked a 4.72 ERA (18 ER in 34.1 IP) with a 1.37 WHIP ... 3 of his 7 starts went 5.0+ innings with 1 or less runs allowed.

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also made a pair of starts for Omaha ... among Royals Minor League pitchers, ranked 5th in innings pitched (115.1), tied 6th in strikeouts (106) and tied 6th in starts (21).
 - Opened the year with the Naturals and threw 5 quality starts over his first 8 appearances ... made his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on May 28 vs. St. Paul (MIN) ... in 2 starts for Omaha and allowed 9 ER in 8.0 IP (10.13 ERA) before returning to Northwest Arkansas on June 6 to finish his season.
 - In Northwest Arkansas, totaled 21 appearances (19 starts) and worked a 4.24 ERA (51 ER in 108.1 IP) with 100 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP throughout the season ... named the Texas League Pitcher of the Week for his start on July 2 @ Springfield (STL), tossing 5.0 scoreless innings with 1 hit and 7 strikeouts

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... appeared in 22 games (21 starts) with a 3.68 ERA (42 ER in 102.2 IP) and 92 strikeouts at High-A ... 7 of his 21 starts were scoreless, including his last 3 of the season, for a career-high 21.0-inning scoreless streak that stretched into April 2025.
- Spent the 2023 season between the Royals and Padres organizations ... opened the year with San Diego's Single-A affiliate, the Lake Elsinore Storm, but the Padres traded him to Kansas City at the trade deadline ... after the trade, made 5 starts for Columbia (A) and posted a 3.38 ERA (9 ER in 24.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts for the Fireflies..
- Made his professional debut at the start of the 2023 season with Lake Elsinore after San Diego drafted him in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Duke University ... made 12 starts for the Storm before his trade to the Royals, working a 5.74 ERA (27 ER in 42.1 IP) with 40 strikeouts for Lake Elsinore ... missed the 2022 season as he recovered from Tommy John surgery.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Attended Duke University (2019-2021), where he appeared in 9 games (7 starts) over 3 seasons with the Blue Devils (ACC), going 3-3 with a 3.82 ERA (16 ER in 37.2 IP) and 45 strikeouts ... only pitched one full season in Durham (2021) due to the COVID-19 pandemic shortening his freshman campaign (2020) and Tommy John surgery in December 2021, keeping him out of action his junior year (2022).
- Lettered in both baseball and basketball all 4 years at Darien High School (CT) ... was a team captain for the basketball team his senior season.
- Father David played collegiate baseball at Davidson College from 1987 to 1991.
