YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Baysox, 4-2, for their fifth straight loss. The Baysox scored on an RBI triple in the first inning by Joseph Ortiz to take a 1-0 lead. **Armani Smith** tied the game with an RBI single in the bottom of the first. Bowie moved back in front, 2-1, in the third with a sac fly by Shayne Fontana. In the fifth, **Ricardo Genoves** hit a solo homer to tie the score, 2-2. Fontana gave the Baysox a 4-2 lead in the seventh with a two-run single and finished the game with three RBIs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. The two teams have met for three previous series. The Flying Squirrels opened the season with two wins in three games at Bowie from May 8-10. From April 26-May 1, the Flying Squirrels won five-of-six against the Baysox at The Diamond. In the first series of the second half, Richmond lost five-of-six against the Baysox at Prince George's Stadium. The two teams will also meet for a six-game series in Bowie from September 6-11. The Flying Squirrels are riding a five-game losing streak, their longest of the 2022 season so far.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 6-13 to open the second half. They won three straight prior to dropping the last five. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost five and split three this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 976 strikeouts (111 per game) and rank second with 112 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 25-18 at home this year. Richmond is 21-17 in games decided by two-or-less runs and 38-32 overall against the Southwest Division.

THE BAYSOX finished last in the Southwest Division in the first half of the season but are 11-6 in the second half, a half-game ahead of Altoona for first place. Bowie won four-of-five in last week's series against the RubberDucks, winning the first four before falling in Sunday afternoon's finale. Bowie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Colton Cowser (3), 3B Coby Mayo (6), 2B Connor Norby (9), INF Cesar Prieto (10), SS Joseph Ortiz (13), OF Hudson Haskin (14), LHP Drew Rom (15) and RHP Zach Peek (30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Kyle Harrison** makes his ninth Double-A start and second against the Baysox. He last pitched on Saturday in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium for the National League. His last start with Richmond was on July 8 against Reading and he fired six scoreless innings with a career-low three strikeouts. He faced the Baysox on July 2 and allowed one run over five innings in a win. Over his last five starts since June 15, Harrison is 3-0 with a 1.24 ERA (4 ER/29.0 IP), picking up 38 strikeouts. For the year, Harrison is ranked fifth in the minors with 119 strikeouts. With his Flying Squirrels debut on May 27, he became the youngest pitcher in team history. He also picked up the second-most strikeouts in a debut in franchise history with nine. Harrison began the season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, where he went 0-1 with a 1.55 ERA in seven starts. At the time of his promotion to Richmond, Harrison ranked third in the Northwest League in ERA (1.55), second in strikeouts (59), third in BAA (.179) and tied for fifth in WHIP (1.00). Harrison was selected in the third round (85th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft by the Giants out of De La Salle High School in Concord, Calif. He is currently rated by MLB.com and *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 2 prospect. **For more on Harrison, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Left-hander Drew Rom makes his 15th start of the season and his fourth against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on July 13 against Akron and allowed two runs over five innings with eight strikeouts, which tied a season high. He was the Opening Day starter for the Baysox on April 8 against the Flying Squirrels and allowed three runs over three innings in a loss. He pitched at The Diamond on April 28 and allowed three runs in three innings again in a no-decision. On June 30 in Bowie against Richmond, he set a season high with six innings pitched, allowing three runs with seven strikeouts in a win. In his three starts against the Flying Squirrels this year, Rom is 1-1 with a 6.75 ERA (9 ER/12.0 IP). Last year, he began the season with High-A Delmarva, going 8-0 with a 2.79 ERA in 14 outings, including 13 starts. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on July 31. At the time of his promotion, he ranked tied for seventh in the High-A East with 73 strikeouts. Rom went 3-1 with a 3.83 ERA in nine outings (seven starts) for the Baysox. He started Game 3 of the Double-A Northeast Championship Series at Akron on September 24 and pitched 5.0 scoreless innings with seven strikeouts before the RubberDucks scored six runs over the final two innings to clinch the league title. Rom finished the 2021 season ranked fifth in the Orioles organization with 120 strikeouts, first with 107.2 innings pitched, and first with 11 wins. Overall on the year, he went 11-1 with a 3.18 ERA in 23 outings (20 starts) and was selected as an MLB.com Orioles Organization All-Star. In 2019, he was a South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Delmarva. Rom was selected in the fourth round (115th overall) of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Orioles out of Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Ky.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (257,947) and average attendance (6,142). Richmond is 13th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 112 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (122). **Sean Roby** is first in the league with 23 homers on the season, with 19 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 176 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in every season except 2021, including 2010 (71), 2011 (83), 2012 (76), 2013 (109), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .336 (38-for-113) with six doubles, six homers and 25 RBIs over his last 29 games since June 7. In the series at Bowie from June 28-July 3, Rincones hit .600 (12-for-20) with a homer and two RBIs and struck out twice. Over the next two series from July 4-17 against Reading and Altoona, Rincones hit .186 (8-for-43) with two doubles, a homer and eight RBIs in 11 games. He went 1-for-4 with a single in the series-opener against the Baysox on Friday night.

SHANE TRAIN: From May 1-June 30, **Shane Matheny** hit .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. Over his last 13 games since July 1, Matheny is batting .109 (5-for-46) with two doubles and six RBIs and has walked nine times. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season at the time. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked sixth in OBP (.389).

TOASTY: **Frankie Tostado** hit .333 (12-for-36) with a homer, two doubles and six RBIs over nine games from July 2-15 but is 0-for-8 in his last two games since Sunday. On July 6, he hit the first grand slam of his professional career in a win over Reading. He hit .175 (10-for-57) over a 16-game stretch from June 9-29. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. He has hit 25 homers in his Flying Squirrels career, tied for fourth-most in franchise history. In the Eastern League this year, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.288) and tied for fifth in hits (83).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin' Phils, moving him ahead of **David Villar** for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9. Roby is first in the EL in home runs this year ahead of Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 19 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duvall** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

SMITH SURGING: In his last nine games since July 7, **Armani Smith** is batting .333 (11-for-33) with four doubles and seven RBIs. He has collected multiple hits in four-of-his-last-seven games. Last Tuesday and Wednesday in Altoona, he played on the infield for the first time in his professional career, manning first base.

FITZ ON FIRE: **Tyler Fitzgerald** has homered five times over his last six games played since July 10. He went deep in the series finale against Reading on July 10. He added a solo homer last Thursday night in Altoona, hit two solo homers on Friday night and hit another on Sunday afternoon in the series finale. In his last seven games since July 9, Fitzgerald is batting .391 (9-for-23) with five homers, a double and five RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.288) and tied for fifth in hits (83). **Sean Roby** is first in homers (23) and tied for ninth in SLG (.493). **Shane Matheny** is sixth in OBP (.389). **Mike Gigliotti** is ninth in OBP (.384), tied for eighth in walks (45) and fourth in stolen bases (22). **Tyler Fitzgerald** is tied for eighth in homers (15). **Ryan Walker** is tied for fourth in wins (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have five players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (11), **Cole Waites** (19), **Ricardo Genoves** (27) and **Chris Wright** (30). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genoves (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
