FRISCO TAKES THRILLING OPENER AGAINST SOD POODLES BEHIND ROBY:

In front of 10,019 fans, the Frisco RoughRiders edged the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-2 on Tuesday at Riders Field after **Tekoah Roby** carried a no-hitter into the seventh inning. Roby tied his season high with eight strikeouts for the RoughRiders (14-19). Amarillo (15-19) picked up its first hit with one out in the seventh inning when AJ Vukovich tripled and Deyvison De Los Santos homered to tie the game, 2-2. **Marc Church** (2-2) entered in the seventh after Roby allowed the home run. Church struck out the first three batters he faced and put away all five hitters before **Nick Starr** pitched the ninth. Starr got the save with a three up, three down frame. Jackson Goddard (1-1) allowed just one hit in 2.1 innings for Amarillo, but that one hit was Harris' go-ahead homer. Frisco welcomed 10,019 fans on Tuesday, the biggest crowd at Riders Field since August 25, 2019. **Dustin Harris** homered on the first pitch of the bottom of the eighth inning to provide the game-winning run. It was the first one-run win for Frisco this season. **Nick Tanielu** started the scoring in the second inning with a solo home run for Frisco. He tacked on an RBI single in the sixth to push Frisco's lead to 2-0. Amarillo tied the game in the top of the seventh and Harris' home run was the only hit the rest of the game for either team. Harris went 3-for-4 on the day, while **Luisangel Acuña** and **Jax Biggers** both had base hits to extend their hit streaks to eight and six games, respectively.

PERFECT TIMING:

The RoughRiders took down the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-2 on Tuesday for their first win in games decided by one run or two runs on the season. **Dustin Harris'** solo home run in the eighth was also the first game-winning hit for the RoughRiders in their final at-bat on the year and the first time they won when tied in the sixth inning or later.

TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The Riders are hitting .245/.351/.390/.741 with runners in scoring position this season, which is the seventh-best batting average in the league during those situations. Overall, Frisco is hitting .255/.358/.412/.770 on the season and they are second in the league in batting average. In May, though Frisco is just 3-9, they are fourth in the league in average (.269) and seventh in runs scored (56), hitting .269/.349/.417/.766 with 13 home runs and 20 steals (third in the league).

PITCHING STRUGGLING:

Over the last 18 games, Frisco has a 7.46 ERA, which is the worst in the Texas League over that stretch. The Riders allowed 23 home runs over that stretch, which is the second-most in the league. The Frisco bullpen has a 5.50 this season, which is eighth in the league. After the tough two weeks, Frisco is still seventh in the league with a 5.57 ERA.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 15 games, he is hitting .364 (24-for-66)/.400/.545/.945 with four doubles, a triple, two homers, 13 RBIs and 11 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .352/.364/.500/.864 and has three four-hit games to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .317/.394/.492/.886 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking eight times. Over the last 16 games, he has raised his average 109 points and his OPS 277 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .319 (46-for-144)/.381/.465/.846 through the first 33 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (46), tied for sixth in doubles (10), fifth in total bases (67) and third in stolen bases (15). Over his last 29 games, he is batting .341/.408/.508/.916. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (125).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 172 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .358 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Evan Carter** and **Dustin Harris** are tied for the second in the league with 26 walks while Carter is eighth in OBP (.414) in the league.

ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over two starts on May 5th and May 11th, Leiter allowed just one unearned run over 11.0 IP while striking out 15 and walking four.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No.1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen as a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
