### ROCKHOUNDS HAND RIDERS THIRD ONE-RUN LOSS OF WEEK:

The Frisco RoughRiders tied the game late, but fell in their third-straight game to the Midland RockHounds 4-3 on Saturday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. After Frisco (44-24) starter **Dane Acker** was dominant through the first five innings, allowing just one hit, Midland (39-29) plated the first three runs of the game in the bottom of the sixth inning. With runners at first and second and one down, Jack Winkler singled to third baseman **Cody Freeman**, but his throw got away from first, allowing Jamaliel Rosado Jr. to score the first run. It was Freeman's first error of the season in 53 games at third base. Brennan Milone followed by hitting a two-run double down the left field line to increase the lead to 3-0. Acker threw his second-straight quality start and the second of his professional career, allowing three runs over six innings while striking out five in a no-decision. The Riders then fought right back in the top of the seventh with a pair of RBI ground outs from **Josh Hatcher** and **Aaron Zavala** to make it a 3-2 game. After **Florencio Serrano Jr.** (0-2) threw a scoreless seventh, **Maximo Acosta** blasted a game-tying solo homer in the top of the eighth, his second of the season. Midland took the decisive lead in the bottom of the eighth when Brennan Milone scored on a wild pitch, putting the RockHounds up 4-3. Seth Elledge (1-1) earned the win, even though he blew the save in the eighth, throwing the last two innings. Offensively, Freeman had the only two-hit game for the Riders. Frisco has now just scored four runs in their last three games and 11 in the first five games of the series, going 1-4.

### BROKEN BATS:

In this series against the RockHounds, the RoughRiders have struggled offensively. Their 11 total runs across five games are last in the league while they are slashing .186/.264/.269/.533 with one home run. Frisco hit seven home runs in their last series against Amarillo. Frisco has lost three of the five games this week by one run.

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

After a Midland loss on Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in all of Double-A at 44-24 and they have a 5.0-game lead over the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022. Frisco has not finished the first half with the best record in Double-A since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 89 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007).

### DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

With an error on Saturday, it snapped a streak of three-straight games without an error for the RoughRiders. The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (38) while also owning the best fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 65 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco are tied for the fewest stolen bases allowed in MiLB (44), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.92 ERA, which is also the second-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs on Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last four series, spanning 24 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.56 ERA (15ER/86.2IP). In June, **Steven Jennings** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his six outings, throwing 13.1 innings.

### FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 15 games, the Riders have allowed just 27 earned runs over 131.0 IP (1.85 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.45 through the first 19 games. Having won 20 of their last 26 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.29) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (eight) and tied for first in wins (19) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Palm Beach) has a 2.81 ERA. In those last 26 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just six times and three times in the last 14 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

### HICKS IS THE PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 32 games, batting .343 (37-for-108)/.455/.481/.936 with six doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks, 12 strikeouts and 21 runs. In his last 16 games, he is hitting .368 (21-for-57)/.486/.596/1.082. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

### RISP-ECT HIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 33 games, they are 21-12, but are hitting .240 (63-for-262) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .270 with RISP.

-Signed in 2020 for \$10,000 at age 18 (which is much older than the normal 16-year-old international signing age for most Dominican players).

-Routinely touches triple digits with his fastball.

-Comps to Jordano Ventura because of small frame and electric stuff. Changeup has splitter-like action to it.

### 2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation and as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization according to MLB.com.

-After allowing four runs over 2.2 innings in first start, has gone 2-0 with 1.20 ERA over last six starts (4ER/30.0IP).

-He allowed two doubles in his first start and did not allow any extra-base hits after until 5/26, when he surrendered a solo home run.

-Tied career-high with 11 strikeouts on 6/16 vs. AMA.

### 2023 SEASON

-Finished 4th among Rangers farm hands in 2023 with a 12.26 K/9 (7th-best in the South Atlantic League).

-Missed the first month and more with minor right forearm tightness (activated 5/23).
