TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express begin the second of five Red Dirt Rumble series of the 2021 season against the Oklahoma City Dodgers on Thursday night at Dell Diamond. Express RHP Collin Wiles is set to get the start on the mound against Dodgers RHP Austin Bibens-Dirkx. Tonight's first pitch is scheduled for 7:05 p.m.

LAST TIME OUT

The Round Rock Express fell to the Sugar Land Skeeters 4-2 in a rain-shortened series finale on Tuesday night at Constellation Field. The game was officially called due to weather just three pitches into the bottom of the fifth inning. Round Rock busted open the scoring in the first inning when 3B Andy Ibanez hit a two-run home run, bringing LF Delino DeShields home with him after DeShields drew a leadoff walk. Sugar Land responded with a run in the bottom of the frame as 1B Abraham Toro launched a solo homer. The Skeeters took a 4-2 lead in the third as 2B C.J. Hinojosa scored on a double from SS Alex De Goti before De Goti was sent home on a single by RF Jake Meyers. Meyers made his way to third on an Express error and scored the final run of the inning thanks to a Toro double. The game went into a rain delay in the bottom of the fifth inning and was officially called after a one hour and nine-minute delay.

WILES WITH THE START

Round Rock RHP Collin Wiles is scheduled to get his first start since May 31 in Tuesday's contest. Since his last start, the righty has made three relief appearances, allowing no runs and four hits in his 4.2 total innings. Over his seven outings this season, Wiles has totaled three walks and 23 strikeouts.

RAIN, RAIN, GO AWAY

The night after playing extra innings for the first time this season, Round Rock had its first rain-shortened contest of 2021. This marked the second time a game versus the Skeeters has been delayed or called early due to rain as May 16th's game in Round Rock was moved to a May 17 doubleheader.

WHAT A STEAL

After tallying a stolen base in Tuesday's series finale, Express INF Yonny Hernandez sits atop the Triple-A West League in stolen bases with 11. The double-digit total also pushes the speedster to fourth in all of Triple-A, where he sits just three behind first-place Vidal Brujan from Durham.

RED DIRT RUMBLE REVIVAL

Round Rock and Oklahoma City announced the Red Dirt Rumble rivalry prior to the season-opening six-game series between the two teams. The Express took the first series with a 5-1 win in Round Rock, scoring an impressive 49 runs on 70 hits and 14 home runs over the six contests. After this week's series, the rivalry continues with one more set in Round Rock before the Express travel to Oklahoma City in both August and September.

IBÁÑEZ ON A ROLL

Express INF Andy Ibanez cracked into the Triple-A West League's top 10 in batting average after hitting a two-run home run in one of his two at-bats during Tuesday's shortened contest. The Cuba native is currently ranked ninth in the league, hitting .322 (29-90) over the 23 games he has played for Round Rock this season.

ROCKY STARTS

Despite holding a 3-3 record in series openers this season, Round Rock has recorded five series wins. Interestingly enough, all three times the Express has dropped the opener, they have gone on to either win or split the series.

BEST IN THE WEST

Round Rock remains atop the Triple-A West League's East Division with a 1.5-game lead. The 23-13 record ties the West Division leader, Reno, for the best in the league.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Thirteen members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021: RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, C Blake Grant-Parks, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, OF Leody Taveras, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry and RHP Collin Wiles. LHP Sal Mendez is currently seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Taveras and Tejeda all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels in 2021 before making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock in May.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 13 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 21 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibáñez was born in Cuba, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
