Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Austin Peterson** to the mound today, hoping to salvage a series split (would be third straight split). Toledo will counter with RHP **Tanner Rainey**. Columbus is 14-8 (.636) versus right handers this year. Rainey has pitched against the Clippers 12 times in his career ('18 with Louisville, '25-26 with Toledo), going 1-0 with a 3.46ERA (13.0IP, 6H, 5R, 5ER, 11BB, 16K).

vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus was 10-11 opposing Toledo last year (have not won a season series since going 11-10 in 2022), including a 4-5 mark in Columbus (lost each of last 4G). Individually, **Cooper Ingle** has hit .300 (3x10) in 4G against Toledo in his career and **Dayan Frias** has hit .310 (9x29) in 11G, while **Juan Brito** has 3HR and 18RBI in 27G (**Nolan Jones** and **George Valera** each have 5HR).

Day of Rest

While winning the second half of last Sunday's doubleheader, the Clippers are still just 10-25 in the last 35G played on Sunday (2nd worst Sunday record in minor league baseball since 9/1/24; Salt Lake is 9-25). Columbus has been outscored by 53 runs in those 35G (204-151), but have tied the homer column at 38. In Huntington Park, the Clippers a 4-9 in the last 13 Sunday matinees (0-2 vs. Toledo).

Deficit Shmeficit

Last night's win was the 13th comeback win for the Clippers this season, three more than any other team in the IL. Columbus also improved to 11-10 (.524) when spotting the opposition the first run of the game (only team with a winning record). The Clippers have played only 3G this season in which they have not trailed (2nd fewest in the IL) with two of those wins coming last week in Buffalo.

Gone Cold

Like the infuriating weather that has rolled into Columbus, the bats were iced out of the homer column in the first 3G of the series (second time), but they have 3HR in the last 2G. The lineup pounded 13HR in the last 5G vs. Iowas, but has 8HR in the 11G since (.354SLG, 20th in the IL). The Clippers have scored a total of 14 runs in the last 4G, having averaged 7.0 in the dozen prior (4/15-4/28).

Watch Out for Watson

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .348/.500/.696 with 9XBH in his last 14G (1XBH in first 12G). He drew a walk on Friday, but has just 4BB in his last 6G (27PA), following three straight efforts with 2BB apiece (4/18-4/21, 15PA). When posting up in centerfield, as he is today, Watson is hitting .385/.520/.641 in 11G (50PA; .182/.333/.364 in all others, 68PA).

Familiar Surroundings

Juan Brito is slotting into the second spot in the batting order today for the 163rd time in his Clipper career (76G and 348PA more than any other player in the IL since his Triple-A debut on 9/19/23). Brito hammered the 25th homer of his Clipper career yesterday (sixth from the right side of the plate), but is still hitting just .194/.326/.306 with 2XBH and 5RBI in 10G since opening weekend (6x12, 4XBH in 3G).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 20BB in his first 54PA (37%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .261 (30x115) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .466OBP and a +17 differential in the walk to strikeout department (41 to 24). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 41BB are tied for 4th most (**Travis Bazzana** leads, 47).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .107/.265/.143 with 0HR and 0RBI in 8G (was 2x4 with a double in the series opener). Tolentino has struck out over a third of the time during his slump (35%, 12K in 34PA), after starting the year at 23% (18K in 77PA; had a 34% K-rate last season). All-time in Huntington Park, he owns an .895OPS.

Hot at Home

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to collect multi-hit games in his last pair (six multi-hit at home; hitting .327, 17x52, in 13G at Huntington Park, .212, 11x52 in 14G on the road). Among Clippers with at least 40PA at Huntington Park, Huff is one of four hitting over 100 points better at home (**Milan Tolentino** +188, **Stuart Fairchild** +182, **Kahlil Watson** +137). The team is +44.

This Date in Clipper History

5/3/1997

The Clippers scored 26 runs on 30 hits, both franchise records, in a 26-11 win at Norfolk. After scoring 4 runs in the 2nd and 4 more in the 4th, the Clippers went into the 6th inning trailing by a score of 9-8. They tacked on 2 runs in the 6th, 10 in the 7th, 1 in the 8th and 5 more in the 9th. **Matt Howard** went 6x8 in the contest to set the Clippers' individual record for hits in a game and **Mike Figga** added 5 hits and 7RBI.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,371).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 44-43 (.506) in pitch reviews, with batters going 27-30 (.474) and pitchers/catchers going 17-13 (.567). They have run out of challenges in 17G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-2 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-35 when playing past regulation (.593, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 86G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 14th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 18G this season (9-9, .500), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 4/26 at Buffalo and that runner came around to score in a rare loss. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-23 (.785) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-2 (.333, blew 7-run lead in on of the losses) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 402-422 (.488), 372-376 with Columbus (.497).
