**HISTORIC FIFTH INNING HELPS FRISCO COAST BY CORPUS CHRISTI:**

With 10 runs in the fifth inning, the Frisco RoughRiders flew past the Corpus Christi Hooks for a 10-2 win on Friday night at Whataburger Field. Corpus Christi (0-2) scored the game's first run on Joseph Sullivan's RBI single off of **Dylan MacLean** in the third inning. Meanwhile, Hooks starter Brandon McPherson held Frisco (2-0) off the scoreboard through four innings with seven strikeouts. MacLean, who picked up his first Double-A win in his RoughRiders debut, surrendered just the one tally on three hits over five innings, striking out six while walking two. McPherson took the mound in the fifth and Frisco came back with a vengeance. After **Marcus Lee Sang** singled, **Keith Jones II** lased a triple off of the left field wall to drive him in and tie the game at one. **Tucker Mitchell** immediately doubled Jones in to deliver Frisco the lead, 2-1. Following a **Frainery Chavez** walk, **Dylan Dreiling** drove a fly ball the opposite way over the wall in left for the first Riders home run of the season and a 5-1 advantage. **Ian Moller** then picked up an RBI single in the inning before Lee Sang, Mitchell and Dreiling all had their second run-scoring hits of the frame. In total, 15 Riders batted in the nine-hit, 10-run inning. The RoughRiders bullpen combined to not allow an earned run over the game's final four frames and the one offensive inning was enough to float Frisco's night.

**YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:**

Through two games the RoughRiders are first in Double-A with 26 hits and second in all of Double-A, High-A and Low-A. Among teams with at least two games played, they are leading all of Double-A in batting average (.329) and runs (15). Their 26 hits are the most in the first two games in recorded franchise history (since 2005), breaking the record of 24 in 2015. Their 15 runs scored are also the most in franchise history (since 2005) through the first two games of a season (more than 14 in both 2021 and 2009). **Tucker Mitchell** has tied the franchise record for most hits on through the first two games of a season with five, becoming the fifth player to do so.

**QUITE THE START:**

Frisco starter **Leandro Lopez** poured in 4.2 no-hit innings on Thursday night, tying the longest no-hit outing of the season so far (**Noah Davis**, Triple-A Indianapolis, also on Thursday). **Dylan MacLean** followed that with 5.0 innings, allowing one run in his Double-A debut on Friday. Frisco's overall 1.00 ERA through two games is tied for the best mark in Double-A and second in Minor League Baseball among teams with at least two games played, while they are fourth in hits allowed (9) and fifth in WHIP (0.94) in the minors. Since 2005, only four Texas League teams have had a better ERA through two games than the RoughRiders' 1.00 (0.00 for 2016 Corpus Christi and 2012 Midland and 0.50 for 2006 San Antonio and 2023 Wichita). Frisco also had a 1.00 ERA through two games in 2019 and 2007.

**SOUTHERN SUCCESS:**

Since 2021, the Riders have been very good against their South Division opponents, going 252-185 (.577) against their division teams. The only problem is that they have gone just 55-53 against Midland while they went a combined 197-132 (.599) against Corpus Christi, Amarillo and San Antonio.

**CLASS OF THE LEAGUE:**

Since 2021, the RoughRiders have been the best team in the Texas League. Over the last six seasons, Frisco has a 361-308 (.540) record. Their .540 winning percentage is the top mark in the Texas League and the fifth-best in Double-A during that span. Somerset (Yankees affiliate) has the best record in Double-A, going 388-280 (.581) in that stretch. On the opposite end, Corpus Christi has had the worst winning percentage in the Texas League over the last six years, going 287-382 (.429), the third-worst in Double-A. (See below for more info)

**VERSUS THE CORPUS CHRISTI HOOKS:**

The Riders went 12-11 against the Hooks in 2025 and have gone 31-18 (.633) against the Astros affiliate since the start of 2024. Since 2021, the Riders are 59-43 (.578) against Corpus Christi despite their losing record against the Hooks in their franchise history (283-289). In both 2024 and 2025 combined, the Hooks' .366 winning percentage is worst in all of Minor League Baseball.

**WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:**

The RoughRiders have four players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2026. On the mound, **David Davalillo** (No. 7), **Leandro Lopez** (No. 14) and **Josh Trentadue** (No. 23) all slot into the starting rotation and are all returners to Frisco. The lone prospect on the offense side is **Dylan Dreiling** (No. 10), who makes his Double-A debut in 2026.

**FAMILIAR AND NEW FACES IN FRISCO:**

The RoughRiders welcome 16 returning players in 2026, but will have just three players on the roster (infielder **John Taylor**, outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** and RHP **Dylan MacLean**) who have yet to make their Double-A debut. Of the 28, 10 players will be making their Rangers organization debut with the RoughRiders.

## ABOUT DAVID

-Pronounced David (not da-VEED) dah-vuh-LEE-oh.

-In 2021, he was signed by the New York Mets for \$30,000 as a free agent, but did not pitch. After the contract was voided, he then signed with the Rangers for \$10,000 in 2022.

-Father, David, has spent 16 seasons as an MiLB coach in the Mets organization and was named the 2019 Mets MiLB Coach of the Year as the NYM Culf Coast League manager. Both his grandfather, Pompeyo, and great-uncle, Vic, played Major League Baseball. His younger brother, Gabriel, signed with the Angels in January of 2025 as a catcher and is currently their No. 14 prospect.

## 2026 SEASON

-Begins the 2026 season as the No. 7 prospect in the Rangers system, per MLB.com.

## 2025 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 16 prospect in the Rangers organization by *Baseball America*. He also was listed as having the best curveball in the organization by *Baseball America*.

-No. 28 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Dominated in first 10 starts in High-A Hub City, going 4-0 with 1.09 ERA while striking out 68 batters in 49.1 innings to just 11 walks.

-Went 3-0 with 0.96 ERA over five May starts, whiffing 35 in 28.0 innings to just four walks while holding opponents to a .152 batting average against. He was named South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month.

-Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Week on 4/20.

-Struggled in final High-A start, allowing a career-high six runs over 1.2 innings against Wilmington on 6/13.

-Won Texas League Pitcher of the Month for August, owning 1.82 ERA over five starts.

## 2024 SEASON

-Led all of Minor League Baseball (min. 20 GS) with a 1.88 ERA in 22 games, 21 games started. He never allowed more than three earned runs in a single outing between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory.

-Was named Carolina League Postseason All-Star.

## 2023 SEASON

-Made state-side debut for the Down East Wood Ducks in one start.

-Spent the offseason prior to 2024 with Tiburones de La Guaira of the Venezuelan Winter League, owning a 4.50 ERA, allowing 15 ER in 30.0 IP over nine games, six games started.

## CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

### PITCHING COACH



## THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

### HITTING COACH



## JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

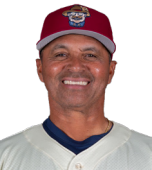
Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

### BENCH COACH



## JORGE HERNANDEZ

Pronounced "George"

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

## JAY SULLENGER

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

## KILEY BROWN

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).

## BRETT PLATTS

Platts is back with the RoughRiders for his third season and his fourth in the Rangers organization in 2026.

In his first year, he was the strength and conditioning coach for the Low-A Down East Wood Ducks before spending a season with the Cubs, working in the Dominican Summer League. The Canadian completed his strength and conditioning internship with the University of Iowa athletic department in 2022 and spent four years with the Okotoks Dawgs Baseball Academy from 2019 through 2022.
