#### LAST TIME OUT

**Moosic, PA (July 19)** - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the Worcester Red Sox 11-5 on Wednesday night. Greg Allen, on a Major-League rehab assignment, hit a three-run homer in the game.

In the top of the first, David Hamilton and Nick Sogard drew back-to-back walks and Ceddanne Rafaela singled to load the bases. A sacrifice fly from Bobby Dalbec scored Hamilton, but Tanner Tully worked out of the jam from there to hold the score at 1-0 in favor of Worcester.

In the bottom of the third, Sogard led off the inning with a triple before Dalbec singled him in to make it 2-0 Red Sox. Worcester expanded their lead in the top of the fourth, Ceddanne Rafaela doubled in two runs to stretch their lead to 4-0. The opponents added one more in the sixth off the bat of Stephen Scott.

A pair of singles from Jesús Bastidas and Wilmer Difo set the stage for Greg Allen in the bottom half. Allen, on a Major-League rehab assignment, notched a three-run shot to left field to trim the Worcester lead to 5-3.

In the top of the eighth, Ronaldo Hernandez started off the frame with a single and the next five consecutive batters reached on free passes. Rafaela and Dalbec drove in two more for a 11-3 lead.

A trio of singles from Everson Pereira, Carlos Narvaez and Andrés Chaparro loaded the bases to start the bottom of the eighth. Jake Lamb walked in Pereira. A groundout from Jamie Westbrook scored Narvaez and SWB tallied two, at the end of eight innings, Worcester led 11-5.

Tanner Tully (L, 5-4) went four innings allowing four runs on six hits with four strikeouts. Anthony Misiewicz worked 1.1 innings giving up just a run and a hit with a strikeout. Deivi García pitched 1.2 scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts. DJ Snelten's line finished with six runs on a hit and four walks. Michael Gomez pitched two clean innings to end the contest.

Kyle Barraclough (W, 5-0) tossed six innings giving up three runs on four hits, while AJ Politi recorded his ninth save of the season.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**HOMER HEAVEN** The RailRiders are the first team in Minor League Baseball to hit 150 home runs on the season and third in all of baseball. Last night in Major League rehab, Greg Allen smashed a three-run homer against his former team. Worcester has totaled 134 as a team. The New York Yankees have amassed 134, and the Atlanta Braves have the most with 178. The RailRiders have launched a half a dozen homers in two contests in this season. The team homered 20 times in a week against Charlotte, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Estevan Florial leads the team with twenty-one, while five players are in double digits.

**FIELDING FAUX PAS** - The RailRiders have committed a total of 79 errors on the season with one more last evening. This puts them second in the International League with Worcester leading at 88. Andres Chaparro has the most with eleven and David Hamilton with ten. Visalia leads all of Minor League Baseball with 124 errors.

**HAVING A RECORD YEAR:** Andres Chaparro and Jamie Westbrook are looking to track down record years in the home run department. Last night, Chaparro crushed his 18th of the season in 84 games. He totaled 20 last season which was shortened due to injury. Westbrook hit his 13th yesterday as well in his 66 games. The most he has hit in the summer is 19, back in 2018 when he was with the Diamondbacks organization.

**ALLEN ARRIVES:** Greg Allen joins the RailRiders on a rehab assignment after playing two games with the Tampa Tarpons. Allen was placed on the Injured List June 3rd with a right hip flexor strain after playing in 10 games with New York. He was traded from the Red Sox to the Yankees on May 20th of this season. Allen had an assignment clause (also known as an upward mobility clause) that required him to be added to the Red Sox's big-league roster by Friday. With no room for him on Boston's roster, the Red Sox worked a trade with the Yankees, where Allen was required to be added to New York's active roster. The trade is only the sixth between the Yankees and Red Sox since 1972 and first since a deal involving Adam Ottavino in 2021. The 30-year-old switch-hitter did play 15 games with the Yankees in 2021.

**SEVENTH MONTH STRONG:** Andres Chaparro is off to a stellar start in the month of July. He has played a team-high twelve games with a .340 batting average. The righty has totaled 16 hits, including four doubles and three home runs. He has batted in 16 runs and scored ten of his own. Chaparro is looking to build back up after a tough month of June where he batted .193 in 24 games.

**PEREIRA'S POWER:** Everson Pereira has really impressed as the Yankees #4 prospect in Triple-A with at least one hit in all nine games he has played in. He has also had three of multi-hit and four multi-RBI. Pereira has batted in nine runs and scored nine on 14 hits. The righty has played all three outfield positions. In Somerset, Pereira was batting .291 in 46 total games. There Pereira had 10 doubles and 10 homers.

**LEADING THE CHARGE** - The RailRiders have had nine different first basemen this season, with Jake Lamb making his debut last night. Andres Chaparro leads the way with Billy McKinney following shortly thereafter. Catchers Rodolfo Duran and Carlos Narvaez have turned into regulars in the corner. Mickey Gasper, Jake Bauers, Franchy Cordero and Max Burt have defended there as well.

**ATOP THE YANKS FARM** - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect outfielder Everson Periera (#4 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12), and Clayton Beeter (#13) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre this summer.

**PROSPECT RANKINGS:** Currently ranked #12 in the Yankees farm system by MLB Pipeline

**SPRING START:** For the second year in a row, Vasquez received the invite to Major League spring training and appeared in Grapefruit League contests. This spring he went 1-0 in three appearances with one start. He tossed 7.0 innings allowing four runs on 10 hits. He struck out seven and walked four.

**THE BIG DEBUT:** Randy Vasquez impressed in his first Major League start versus the San Diego Padres. Vasquez recorded his first big league strikeout to Rougie Odor and went on to also punch out Juan Soto and Fernando Tatis Jr. Later in the contest, Soto went on to hit and two-run homer, the only runs Vasquez allowed. He tossed 4.2 innings allowing just four hits and three walks. He struck out six. After the game, Vasquez was optioned back to Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre but remains on the 40-man roster for future use.

**PITCH CLOCK VIOLATION:** On 4/1/23, Vasquez committed the first pitch clock violation of the season. He took too long to come set on the mound to deliver his pitch and an automatic ball was issued to his batter.

**BRING ON THE CURVE:** Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 9 prospect and labeled as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands... combining low-80s power with vertical and horizontal movement produced by spin rates that top 3,100 rpm

**PLAYOFF RANDY:** He capped his 2022 season with eight no-hit innings in the deciding game of the Double-A Eastern League playoffs before getting added to the 40-man roster in November.

**INITIAL SIGNING:** Vásquez has gone from signing for just \$10,000 out of the Dominican Republic at the relatively old age of 19 in May 2018 to becoming one of the Yankees' better pitching prospects.

**2023 HIGHLIGHTS:** Got the ball on Opening Day, Recorded 2 pickoffs on 3/31, team's first quality start on 4/23...Made MLB Debut on 5/26 @ Yankee Stadium vs SD...First professional win on 6/8 over CWS

**PERSONAL/CAREER:**

- 2022: Spent the entire season with Double-A Somerset, going 2-7 with a 3.90 ERA (115.1IP, 106H, 56R/50ER, 41BB, 120K, 11HR) in 25 starts
- Was tied for third among Yankees farmhands in games started, fifth in innings pitched and eighth in strikeouts
- Was second in the Eastern League in ERA, fourth in opponents' batting average, tied for fourth in games started, fifth in WHIP, eighth in innings pitched and ninth in strikeouts
- Following the season, was tabbed by Baseball America as the Yankees' No. 9 prospect and labeled as having the "Best Curveball" among Yankees farmhands
- 2021: Combined with Low-A Tampa, High-A Hudson Valley and Double-A Somerset to go 8-4 with a 2.52 ERA (107.1IP, 91H, 47R/30ER, 38BB, 130K, 4HR) in 23 games (21 starts)...led all Yankees minor leaguers in ERA while ranking tied for fourth in starts and tied for fifth in wins and innings pitched
