Lake County has been in first place in the Midwest League East overall standings for the last 32 days, a stretch dating back to May 28. **Since the Captains are 20-8 and have the best winning percentage in Minor League Baseball in that span (71.4%).**

+100

Lake County owns a +100 run differential, the 2nd-highest at the High-A level, and tied for the 5th-highest in Minor League Baseball. **The last time Lake County had a +100 run differential was on 8/27/2008 after an 8-1 win against Low-A Hagerstown on 8/26.**

Lake County is tied with Single-A Carolina (Milwaukee Brewers) for the 6th-best record in Minor League Baseball, and the best record in High-A.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: The Captains outlasted the Loons 2-1 in front of 6,197 fans on Friday at Classic Auto Group Park for their 4th straight win and 11th win in 1-run games this season.

ROYAL FLUSH: The night the Roto-Rooter "Toilet Row" was revealed, RHP Carter Spivey (5-1) pitched his 6th quality start of the season, allowing only a solo home run to DH Kyle Nevin in the top of the 4th. RHP's Zane Morehouse and Magnus Ellerts stranded 4 Loons runners in the 7th and 8th but did not surrender a run. Ellerts pitched a 1-2-3 top of the 9th to earn his 8th save, tied for the Midwest League best.

HIP HIP, JORGE! The reigning Midwest League Player of the Week, RF Jorge Burgos drove in the go-ahead with a sacrifice fly in the bottom of the 5th. Burgos has now hit 2 homers in the series against Great Lakes, hitting 4 long balls in his last 8 games. **Since June 18, he ranks 1st in the MWL in SLG (.900) and 2nd in OPS (1.357) among batters with 20+ PA in that span.**

RUNNING OF THE BULLPEN: The Captains bullpen boasts a 3.60 ERA, the 3rd lowest in High-A. **In the month of June, LC's pitching staff ranks 2nd in MiLB in ERA (2.77) and 9th in Bullpen ERA (2.88).**

ALL DOWN THE LINE: In Thursday's 13-3 win, Lake County scored 5 in the 6th and 6 in the 8th, batting around (10+ PA) twice in the same game for the first time since 7/14/2021 at Lansing. **Thursday night also marked the first time the Captains have batted around twice in a 3-inning span since they did it in the 4th and 5th innings on 5/15/2013 vs. Lansing.**

COOPER CRUSHES: Lake County C Cooper Ingle put the Captains on the board 1st with an RBI single in the bottom of the 2nd, extending his on-base streak to 13 games. **Since May 17, Ingle is 3rd in MiLB in OBP (.480), and 7th in AVG (.369).**

DOMINANT DEBUTS: On June 27, Captains RHP Rorik Maltrud earned his 1st High-A win in his 1st High-A start, allowing 1 run on 4 hits while striking out 5. On June 28, former Captains RHP Austin Peterson struck out 10 and earned his 9th quality start of the season in his Double-A debut for Akron. Also in his Double-A debut, former Captains LHP Parker Messick pitched 5 no-hit innings versus Binghamton on June 23.

THIS IS 40: The Captains won their 40th game of the season in their 65th contest, **becoming the fastest team in franchise history to win 40 games since the 2010 Midwest League Championship Team won 40 in 61 games.**

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStix were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,807 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,419-1,388 (.506).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last 4 campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

BACK ON TOP IN JUNE: Lake County is 18-6 in June, the best record in Minor League Baseball this month. LC's 18 wins in June are already its most in June since at least 2005. The 2014 team went 16-9. **The Captains pitching staff leads Minor League Baseball with a 2.77 ERA in June.**

FEELS LIKE 2010: Lake County clinched its 4th First Half title in franchise history on Saturday, its first since winning the 2010 Midwest League East First Half crown. When they were previously in the South Atlantic League from 2003-09, the Captains won in 2003 and 2008. The 2010 Captains went 44-25 in the First Half and 77-62 overall, winning the Midwest League Championship in their first year in the league.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: INF Alex Mooney and OF Jonah Advincula are the 2nd Captains duo to steal 20-plus bases in Lake County's first 72 team games of a season since 2005. OF Lucas Montero stole 27 bases and OF Adam White stole 21 in this span during the 2008 campaign.

STEAL AWAY: The Captains have stolen 129 bases through their first 73 games, their most through their first 73 games since at least 2005. **Lake County ranks 2nd in MiLB with an 88.4% stolen base percentage. The Captains also have stolen a base in 10-straight games, the longest active streak in MiLB.**

TO THE MOON: INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, **is 1 of 10 MiLB players with 65+ hits, 20+ extra-base hits, and 25+ stolen bases in 2024.** After reaching 25 stolen bases in 71 team games, Mooney is the fastest Captain to steal 25 bases in a single season since Delvi Cid in 2010 (58 team games).

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": LHP Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson eclipsed 100 strikeouts on Tuesday versus Great Lakes and now ranks 3rd in MiLB with 103. **He joins current Guardians LHP Logan Allen as the only Cleveland Minor Leaguers since at least 2005 to reach 100-plus strikeouts through a team's first 70 games. Allen struck out 104 through 70 team games with Double-A Akron in 2022.**

TOP QUALITY: Through 73 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 24 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are the 3rd-most in High-A, and tied for 9th-most in MiLB. RHPs Austin Peterson (8), Trenton Denholm (6), Carter Spivey (6), and LHP Parker Messick (4) have all recorded quality starts for the Captains this year.

CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK: The Lake County starting rotation is among the best in the Midwest League, leading the MWL in: wins (28), innings pitched (372.1), strikeouts (359), and WHIP (1.18), while ranking 2nd in fewest walks (103) and 3rd in ERA (3.63).

LAST TIME OUT: Trenton Denholm (ND) earned his 6th quality start in a no-decision on June 21 at South Bend. Denholm allowed 3 runs (2 earned), striking out 3 and walking 2 in the 4-3 loss.

Denholm is tied with 3 other Midwest Leaguers (including teammate Carter Spivey) for 2nd in quality starts (6), trailing only former Captain and current Akron RubberDuck Austin Peterson (8).

MIDWEST LEAGUE RANKS: Denholm ranks top-10 in the Midwest League in: win percentage (87.5%, 1st), wins (7, T-1st), innings pitched (75.1, 2nd), WHIP (0.96, 2nd), ERA (2.87, 5th), opposing AVG (.212, 5th), ground ball rate (42.7%, 6th), and strikeouts (65, T-8th). He is also 1 of just 3 Midwest League pitchers to throw a complete game this season, and 1 of 2 to toss a shutout, both of which came on May 10 in Game 1 of a seven-inning doubleheader versus Dayton.

THE GREAT EIGHT: In his last 2 starts at home, Denholm has pitched 8+ innings. Back on May 22 versus West Michigan, Denholm pitched a Minor League-best 8.1 innings, the most by a Lake County pitcher since RHP Joe Colón also pitched 8.1 frames on 5/14/2022 vs. Great Lakes. Denholm allowed 3 runs on 5 hits while not recording a strikeout. He is the first Captain since at least 2005 to throw 8-plus innings without recording a strikeout.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Denholm earned Midwest League Pitcher of the Week honors for the week of May 6-12 after tossing a complete game shutout in 7 innings on May 10 versus Dayton. Denholm pitched Lake County's 1st 7-inning complete game since current Double-A Akron RHP Aaron Davenport recorded a CG SHO on Sept. 4, 2022 at Great Lakes.

HILLCAT ON THE HILL: Denholm pitched his 1st professional season in 2022, making 23 starts for the Single-A Lynchburg Hillcats. The right-hander finished the season with a 5-5 record, 4.79 ERA, and 107 strikeouts in 97.2 innings pitched.

AWESOME ANTEATER: Denholm had a strong collegiate career in his four seasons at UC Irvine. As a sophomore in 2019, the right-hander was named the 2019 Big West Pitcher of the Year, as well as a Collegiate Baseball Newspaper 3rd Team All-American, after finishing the campaign with a 9-4 record, 1.81 ERA, and 93 strikeouts in 99.2 innings pitched. This season resulted in Denholm being invited to the USA Collegiate National Team training camp, and being named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List prior to both the 2020 and 2021 seasons.

OTHER NOTABLE ANTEATERS: Three-time All-Star and former Boston/Baltimore/Cleveland OF Brady Anderson (1983-85), Keston Hiura (2015-17), former Cleveland pitcher David Huff (2004).

BASEBALL IN THE FAMILY: Denholm's mother, Judi, is cousins with former MLB catcher Rod Barajas. He played 14 MLB seasons with seven different teams, notably winning a World Series with the 2001 Arizona Diamondbacks. Barajas hit .235 in his MLB career, recording 812 hits, 136 home runs, 480 RBI, and 187 doubles in 14 seasons.

CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

7 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel: On Wednesday, June 26, **INF/OF Jhonkensy Noel** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Baltimore Orioles. He started at first base and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, finishing 1-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **In his 1st MLB at-bat, Noel hit a 413-foot solo home run to center field, becoming the 4th player in Cleveland franchise history to homer in his 1st career MLB at-bat. He was the first to do so since 2004 Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff, who became the 1st player in MLB history to hit a grand slam on his 1st MLB pitch on September 2, 2006.** Noel played 88 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .238 with 78 hits, 12 doubles, 27 home runs, 67 RBI, a .521 SLG, and an .827 OPS.

LHP Raymond Burgos: On Monday, June 24, **LHP Raymond Burgos** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Chicago Cubs. He pitched 1 inning of relief, allowing 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout. **Burgos** made 48 regular-season appearances (11 starts) for the Captains across the 2019, 2021, and 2022 seasons, going 10-6 with a 2.83 ERA, 115 strikeouts, a 1.29 WHIP, a .255 opposing batting average, and 8 holds, converting 1 of his 2 save opportunities. He also made 3 postseason relief appearances for Lake County in 2022, tallying a 4.26 ERA, 6 strikeouts, 2 walks, and a .150 opposing batting average, converting his lone save opportunity in Game 2 of the Midwest League East Championship Series.

He started at designated hitter and batted 9th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-3 with 1 strikeout. **Martínez** played 77 regular-season games for the Captains in 2022, hitting .288 with 81 hits, 17 doubles, 3 triples, 10 home runs, 27 RBI, 10 stolen bases, and an .861 OPS.

INF/OF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut for the San Francisco Giants at home against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians at home against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, **RHP Cade Smith** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. **Smith** made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.
