Last Game: The Delmarva Shorebirds ended their series against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans with a 7-2 loss on Sunday afternoon. The Shorebirds fell behind in the top of the fourth on a solo home run by **Logan Poteet**, followed by an RBI single by **Darlyn De Leon**, making it 2-0 for Myrtle Beach. **Elvin Garcia** tied the game in the next half inning with a two-run homer, his first long ball in Single-A. The Pelicans reclaimed the lead with a run-scoring single by **Edward Vargas**, and an error on the play gave Myrtle Beach an additional run, putting them back up two at 4-2. A two-run home run by **Michael Carrico** in the seventh, plus an error in the eighth, helped Myrtle Beach take their largest lead at 7-2, and they'd go on to win by that score, handing Delmarva their first loss of the second half.

Sizzling Sanchez: After a tough start and an unlucky run with injuries, **Jordan Sanchez** has turned it on in a major way. Sanchez is currently riding a nine-game hitting streak and is 14-for-28 at the plate in June with four doubles, a home run, and nine RBIs, while striking out only three times. During this run, the Orioles' No. 16 prospect has four multi-hit performances and has scored ten runs.

Make Way for Lo Re: One of the Shorebirds' newest additions, **Jaiden Lo Re**, has quickly made an impact in the middle of Delmarva's order. In 14 games, Lo Re has 16 hits and is batting .314, with seven multi-hit games. He has already driven in ten runs and has been a regular on base, with 13 walks for an on-base percentage of .453.

Mighty Miggy: **Miguel Rodriguez** has been an RBI machine for Delmarva since returning from the injured list on May 26. In his first 16 games this season, Rodriguez has recorded a hit in 11. He has 17 RBIs, including five multi-RBI games. After not reaching base in his first start back on May 27, he has reached base safely in 15 consecutive games.

Play the hits, DJ: **DJ Layton** has been the most consistent bat for the Shorebirds in what has been a breakout campaign 19-year-old. Layton is the team leader in several offensive categories, including hits (52), runs (39), on-base percentage (.406), and OPS (.811). Layton is currently on a 21-game on-base streak, which is the longest by any Shorebird this season and is the ninth-longest run by any player in the Carolina League in 2026.

Hot Rod: In his debut season, **Christian Rodriguez** has emerged as Delmarva's most dependable starting pitcher. C-Rod has recorded three of the four Delmarva quality starts this season, including a career-high 9 Ks and his longest start, 6.1 innings, on June 12 at Columbia. Rodriguez is second in the league in innings pitched at 63.0, and his 74 strikeouts are the second-most in the Carolina League, behind only Columbia's **Michael Lombardi**, who has 81.

Two Out Hitting: The Shorebirds have the second-most hits (177) in the Carolina League with two outs. Additionally, with runners in scoring position and two outs, Delmarva has the most hits (90) and the highest batting average (.283).

About the Woodpeckers: The Shorebirds face the Fayetteville Woodpeckers for the second time this season and make their only trip to Segra Stadium this week. According to MLB.com, Fayetteville's roster includes the two best prospects for the Houston Astros, Kevin Alvarez and Xavier Neyens, the Astros' first-round pick from last year's draft. Delmarva's offense hit well at Segra Stadium last season, launching 11 home runs in 12 games there in 2025.
