GRAY DAY: After snapping the six-game losing streak with a big 6-5 bounce back win last night, the FredNats go for their second straight win on the weekend against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers, Single-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox. Major League rehabber Josiah Gray starts this series finale for Fredericksburg as he begins his climb back to D.C. from elbow inflammation. Gray, a 2023 MLB All-Star, makes his first ever appearance in Virginia Credit Union Stadium against the Cannon Ballers today. FXBG comes into today 5.0 games out of first place in the Carolina League North with 10 games left to play in the first half with six games coming next week against the first place Mudcats.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT**: Marc Davis pitched into the 5th inning for the first time this year, and Jared McKenzie hit a three-run home run in the 6th inning to power the FredNats to a 6-5 victory over the Cannon Ballers on Saturday night. Merrick Baldo slammed the door shut in the 9th inning after giving up a three-run homer in the 8th, and Roismar Quintana and Everett Cooper III also drove in runs for FXBG.

ROSTER MOVEMENT: Prior to the start of this series and during the series, the FredNats made several roster moves. Carolina League save leader Thomas Schultz was promoted to High-A Wilmington after posting a league-best eight saves and an ERA of 1.82 in 24.2 IP. Returning to the FredNats from Wilmington is infielder John McHenry, who appeared in three games with FXBG prior to an early-season promotion to Wilmington. Reliever Anthony Arguelles returns to Fredericksburg from the Complex after four early-season appearances with FXBG. Jared McKenzie continues to rehab a broken bone in his upper leg with the FredNats as well.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 22-4 this season when scoring first, including 19 out of the last 20 wins. Two of the four losses did come last week in Kinston against the Wood Ducks. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses in their last home series aginst the Lynchburg Hillcats, and last night's win was the first time this week that FXBG scored first.

**BULLPEN WORK**: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 288.1 innings this year and allowed 93 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.93, which is the best in the Carolina League. The Freddies are also 14/15 in save opportunities, and prior to his promotion, Thomas Schultz was first in the Carolina League and T-4th in MiLB with eight saves. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (24-0), and 8 (25-0) innings this season as well.

**RBI KING**: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 48. This year, Pimentel is hitting .375 with runners in scoring position, and is 11-for-22 (.500) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of Mil B

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 171-145 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TODAY'S START:** Josiah Gray is set to make a rehab start for the FredNats this afternoon, in the series finale against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Gray is expected to throw roughly 55 pitches, according to Davey Martinez.

Gray, in his third season with the Nationals, made a pair of starts this season before suffering a forearm flexor strain that sent him to the IL on April 9th.

**TRADE TARGET:** Josiah has been a key piece in two different trades in his professional career. Initially drafted by Cincinatti in 2017, the Reds shipped him to the Dodgers in 2018 for a deal involving Matt Kemp, Yasiel Puig, and others. Then in 2021, LA flipped Gray to DC as a main piece of the Scherzer/Turner deadline deal.

I < 3 NY: Gray was born in New Rochelle, NY, just 30 minutes north of NYC, and attended New Rochelle High School. He then played his college ball at Le Moyne College, in Syracuse. He was named an All-American and 2018 D2 Pitcher of the Year by the NCBWA.

**STAR STUDDED:** Gray was the Nationals' representative at the 2023 All Star Game. The righty posted a 3.30 ERA through June in '23, with a 2.39 clip on the road during the first half as well. He was also voted "Good Guy" by the DC media last season.
