NOTES

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Harrisburg Senators, 7-3, on Monday night in the series opener. **Brandon Sproat** earned his first Double-A win and struck out five and allowed just one run, while tossing a career-high seven innings for the second-straight start. **Matt Rudick** (8), **Kevin Parada** (8), **Ryan Clifford** (2), and **JT Schwartz** (7) all recorded multi-hit games. Parada extended his hitting streak to nine games. Eight hitters in the Ponies' starting lineup recorded at least one hit.

LIGHTNING MCLEAN: Mets No. 19 prospect **Nolan McLean** is slated to make his second-career Double-A start on the mound for Binghamton today. McLean is a two-way player and allowed three runs over four innings with five strikeouts in his Double-A pitching debut at Reading last Wednesday. In his final start with High-A Brooklyn on May 16 at Bowling Green, McLean struck out a career-high nine batters over four innings without allowing an earned run. The 22-year-old has four hits and two runs batted in over his first six games as a designated hitter at the Double-A level. McLean was the Mets' third-round draft pick in 2023 out of Oklahoma State.

SPROAT KEEPS SPROUTING: Mets No. 13 prospect **Brandon Sproat** shined on the mound on Monday night against Harrisburg in his third-career Double-A start. Sproat struck out five batters and allowed just one run on four hits and two walks, while earning his first Double-A win. He tossed a career-high seven innings for the second-straight start. The first-year pro lowered his season ERA to 1.42 (across High-A Brooklyn and Double-A Binghamton), which ranks sixth among qualified pitchers from Single-A to Triple-A in all of Minor League Baseball. In three starts at the Double-A level, Sproat is 1-0 with a 1.89 ERA and 20 K.

PARADA PARTY: Mets top catching prospect **Kevin Parada** hit two singles and drove in a run in the series opener against Harrisburg on Monday and extended his hitting streak to nine games. Over his nine-game hitting streak, Parada is hitting .343 (12-for-35) with a .415 on-base percentage and a 1.043 OPS, along with two homers, eight runs batted in, and seven runs scored. He has three multi-hit games over that span. Parada has a team-high 25 runs batted in, which is currently tied for the seventh-most in the Eastern League. He has an .848 OPS, four homers, five doubles, and 16 RBIs over his last 17 games.

SENATORS ROSTER: The Harrisburg Senators current roster features eight of the Washington Nationals top 30 prospects and three of the top four prospects in the organization, via MLB Pipeline: #2 Dylan Crews (#7 OVR), #3 Brady House (#37 OVR), #4 Yohandy Morales (#89 OVR), #8 Robert Hassell III, #17 Andrew Pinckney, #23 Cole Henry, #24 Israel Pineda and #30 Andry Lara. Crews, House, Morales, Pinckney, Henry, and Lara all played in the 2024 Spring Breakout game for the Nationals prospects against the Mets prospects at Clover Park on March 15. Crews was the No. 2 overall pick in the 2023 MLB Draft out of LSU, after leading the Tigers to the national title.

BASEBALL IN EDUCATION DAY: This morning's game is the second 'Baseball in Education Day' of the season. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are expecting about 5,000 students from 44 different schools around the Southern Tier area. The Ponies beat the Bowie Baysox, 2-0, on May 14 in the first BIE Day of the season.
