KING CAKES NEWS & NOTES

A NEW LOOK: Today marks the second of four games in which the Biloxi Shuckers will transform into the Biloxi King Cakes, one of two new alternate identities for the 2024 season... The King Cakes honor Mardi Gras traditions on the Gulf Coast... The city of Biloxi is home to the birthplace of Mardi Gras in the state of Mississippi, with the celebration dating back to the early 20th century.

<u>SPARKS FLY</u>: OF Lamar Sparks extended his hit streak to four consecutive games on Friday in a 2-for-4 performance... Over his four-game hit streak, Sparks is 7-for-15 with two doubles and a home run... Over seven games in June, Sparks is 8-for-26 (.308) with three doubles, a home run and three RBI.

Since May 1, Sparks is 22-for-80 (.275) with five doubles, two home runs and a .754 OPS, the third-highest mark on the Shuckers (min. 80 PA) over that span.

WALKING THE TIGHTROPE: The Shuckers pitching staff limited the Smokies to 2-for-21 with a runner in scoring position on Thursday night... It marked the first time in franchise history that the Shuckers limited an opponent to five hits or less with at least 20 at-bats with a runner in scoring position.

The feat marked the ninth time in the Southern League since 2005 that a team was held to two hits or less with at least 20 at-bats with a runner in scoring position... It marked the first time since the July 2, 2022, when the Birmingham Barons were held to 2-for-20 with a runner in scoring position by the Chattanooga Lookouts.

<u>THE DARRIEN MILLER BAND</u>: C Darrien Miller recorded his second multi-hit game of the series on Thursday with a 2-for-5 performance... Over three games in the series, Miller is 6-for-11 with an RBI, two walks and has been hit by a pitch once.

Entering today, Miller leads the Southern League in walk rate (21.4%), on-base percentage (.434) and times hit by a pitch (11)... Miller is second in Double-A in walk rate and on-base percentage.

<u>ODDS ARE IT'S A CLOSE ONE</u>: Entering today, 34 of the Shuckers' first 60 games (57%) have been decided by two runs or less, including nine of the first 10 games in their season series against the Tennessee Smokies... Six of the Shuckers' last eight games have been decided by two or less.

<u>ALL ABOUT THE HOMERS</u>: The Biloxi Shuckers and Tennessee Smokies combined for six home runs during Wednesday night's game, the most hit in any game at Keesler Federal Park during the 2024 season... It marked the most in a game at the ballpark since July 1, 2023, when the Shuckers and Mississippi Braves combined for seven... Wednesday night's game was the 11th time in ballpark history (since 2015) that at least six home runs had been hit in a game.

LET'S GO PROSPECTING: The Biloxi Shuckers roster features seven Brewers Top-30 prospects, including RHP Jacob Misiorowski (No. 1, No. 24 overall), the organization's top prospect... The other six are; 3B Brock Wilken (No. 5), SS Eric Brown Jr. (No. 10), 3B/1B Mike Boeve (No. 13), RHP Brett Wichrowski (No. 14), RHP Logan Henderson (No. 16) and RHP Bradley Blalock (No. 17).

<u>TODAY'S STARTER // RHP LOGAN HENDERSON (1-0, 0.00)</u>: Henderson makes his Keesler Federal Park debut today after he threw five shutout innings last Sunday in his Double-A debut against the Montgomery Biscuits... Over five innings, Henderson threw a season-high 65 pitches, with 49 of them being strikes... The five innings in his Double-A debut marked his longest start since September 2, 2023, when he threw six innings and allowed one run against the Down East Wood Ducks as a member of the Carolina Mudcats.
