LAST OUTING: Rodriguez picked up his second win of the season versus Norfolk on May 4. He went 5.0 innings, allowing one hit, one earned run, one walk and had a season-high nine strikeouts.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Rodriguez's first career start against Durham.
