CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Tuesday night, the Captains fell to the Lansing Lugnuts in the first game of a scheduled six-game home series by a final score of 5-4 at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This defeat extended Lake County's losing streak to four games, lengthening its first multi-game losing streak of the season.

Offensively, the Captains struck first in the bottom of the second inning after C Johnny Tincher hit a ground ball and LF Jorge Burgos scored on an ensuing Lansing fielding error. However, Lake County did not score again until the bottom of the seventh inning, when 2B Mate Furman hit a two-out, agme-tying RBI single to make the score 2-2. After the Lugnuts hit a two-run home run a half-inning later, the Captains started the home half of the eighth inning with three consecutive hits: consecutive singles from SS Jose Devers, Cleveland's No. 19 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and DH Cooper Ingle, and a game-tying, two-run double from 1B C.J. Kayfus. But a bases-loaded RBI infield single from the Lugnuts in the top of the ninth inning ultimately proved to be the difference.

RHP Trenton Denholm (ND) pitched 6 innings to record the longest start by a Lake County pitcher this season. The right-hander recorded his first quality start of the year, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs (via 2 solo home runs), and no walks, while throwing 7 strikeouts in 80 pitches (61 strikes). RHP Allan Hernández pitched a perfect seventh inning of relief, throwing 1 strikeout in his High-A home debut. RHPs Josh Wolf and Magnus Ellerts (0-1) combined to allow 4 hits, 3 earned runs, and 2 walks, while throwing a combined 4 strikeouts. RHP Alaska Abney finally left the bases loaded to end the top of the ninth inning by striking out the only Lugnuts hitter he faced.

CAPTAIN CONNECTION: Former Captain Kevin Kouzmanoff is back in town this week as the hitting coach for the Lansing Lugnuts. The former third baseman's 2004 season, his only one with the team, was a historic one for Lake County. He holds the Captains' single-season records (min. 2.7 plate appearances per team game) for batting average (330) and OPS (920), while also holding team gingle-season records for hits (156) and doubles (35, since tied). Additionally, Kouzmanoff recorded the first 5-hit game in Lake County franchise history on July 3, 2004, when he tallied 5 hits.

He eventually became the fourth Captain to reach MLB, and made baseball history in his big league debut with Cleveland. On September 2, 2006, Kouzmanoff became the first player in MLB history to hil a grand slam on the first Major League pitch of his career. The home run proved critical in Cleveland's 6-5 victory over the Texas Rangers. He ended up playing seven MLB seasons across five different teams, hitting .257 with 650 hits, 143 doubles, 8 triples, 87 home runs, 371 RBI, and a .726 OPS.

21st SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2.743 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,377-1,366 (.502).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

LAST YEAR AGAINST THE LUGNUTS: In 2023, the Captains finished with a 15-9 record against the Lugnuts in their 24-game regular-season series.

Offensively, Lake County batters hit 270 with 208 hits, 44 doubles, 4 triples, 13 home runs, 97 RBI, 94 walks, 191 strikeouts, and a .739 OPS against Lansing.

They also stole 21 bases, and were caught stealing 6 times. Captains pitchers recorded a 3.14 ERA, 2 shutouts, 9 saves in 12 opportunities, 200 strikeouts, 71 walks, and a 1.25 WHIP in 200.1 innings of work against the Lugnuts.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

AN EVEN SPLIT: Of Lake County's 30 active players to begin the 2024 season, 15 played for the team last year. Of the 15 players who did not, 13 were promoted from Single-A Lynchburg, and two were promoted from the Arizona Complex League (OF Jonah Advincula and RHP Carter Spivey).

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Seven players on the Captains' initial 2024 roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in the third round, and was followed by C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, C Johnny Tincher in Round 11, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

MOONEY'S STELLAR STREAK: Captains INF Alex Mooney, Cleveland's No. 20 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, is currently on a 6-game hitting streak, which is tied for the third-longest active hitting streak in the Midwest League, and is the longest hitting streak by a Captain this season. During this streak, the 21-year-old is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with 3 runs scored, 1 double, 2 home runs, 5 RBI, 1 walk, 1 walk, 5 strikeouts, a .409 OBP, a .714 SLG, and 1.123 OPS.

DRIVING IN RUNS: Lake County C Cooper Ingle (6), OF Jorge Burgos (5), INF C.J. Kayfus (5), and INF Alex Mooney (5), Cleveland's No. 20 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, are the only four Captains with at least 5 RBI so far this season. As a team, the Captains are hitting 20-for-77 (.260) with runners in scoring position so far this season, which ranks fourth in the Midwest League and seventh in all of High-A.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on April 12, **Jake Miller** (1-0) recorded his first career professional win in his 2024 debut on the road against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The right-hander pitched 3.1 innings of relief, allowing 4 hits, 2 earned runs, and 2 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in 55 pitches (34 strikes). **Miller's** 2 earned runs allowed were courtesy of a pair of RBI singles in the bottom of the sixth and seventh innings, respectively.

AGAINST LANSING IN '23: Miller made 1 relief appearance against the Lugnuts last season, pitching 3 scoreless innings. The left-hander allowed 2 hits and 1 walk, while throwing 1 strikeout en route to his first and only career professional save.

RETURNING CAPTAIN: After making four rehab appearances (three starts) for the Arizona Complex League Guardians last year, **Miller** made his final four appearances (two starts) with the Captains. The right-hander went 0-1 with a 4.76 ERA and 5 strikeouts in 11.1 innings of work.

SURGERY RECOVERY: Miller began the 2023 season on the 60-day injured list due to recovering from Tommy John surgery on his right elbow. The right-hander then made four rehab appearances (three starts) for the Arizona Complex League Guardians. **Miller** pitched 8.2 innings, allowing 2 hits, one earned run, and one walk, while throwing 9 strikeouts.

SINGLE-A SEASON: Miller made 9 starts for Single-A Lynchburg in 2022. The right-hander compiled an 0-1 record with a 4.81 ERA in 33.2 innings pitched, allowing 10 walks and throwing 43 strikeouts. **Miller's** last appearance with Lynchburg came on June 5, 2022, when he pitched a career-low one inning (since tied).

TERRIFIC TORERO: Miller pitched three collegiate seasons at the University of San Diego. The right-hander compiled a 9-7 record with a 3.14 ERA in 132 innings pitched, allowing 63 walks and throwing 151 strikeouts. As a sophomore in 2021, **Miller** was named 1st Team All-WCC after leading the conference with a 2.52 ERA in 60.2 innings pitched. On February 28, 2020, **Miller** threw a nohitter against Monmouth, allowing just 2 walks and throwing 10 strikeouts in 102 pitches. A notable baseball alum from the University of San Diego is four-time MLB All-Star, 2016 NL MVP, and 2016 World Series Champion **Kris Bryant**.

FAMILY ATHLETES: Miller's uncle played professional baseball for the Chicago Cubs, his father played professional football in the NFL for the San Francisco 49ers and Oakland Raiders, and his grandfather played professional football in the NFL for Washington.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on April 12, **Steve Hajjar** (0-0) did not record a decision in his 2024 debut on the road against the Fort Wayne TinCaps. The left-hander pitched 1.1 innings in his first start of the season, allowing 2 hits, 2 earned runs, and 5 walks, while throwing 2 strikeouts in 53 pitches (23 strikes). Hajjar's 2 earned runs allowed were courtesy of an RBI double and a bases-loaded walk in the bottom of the second inning.

AGAINST LANSING IN '23: Hajjar made 2 starts against the Lugnuts last season, going 0-1 with a 3.60 ERA and 1.40 WHIP. The left-hander allowed 8 hits, 4 earned runs, and 6 walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in 10 innings of work.

CAPTAIN STEVE RETURNS: Hajjar returns to Lake County after making 14 starts for the Captains last year. The left-hander went 3-4 with a 3.61 ERA and 58 strikeouts in 57.1 innings of work. His 9 walks against Beloit on August 22, 2023 set a franchise record for the most walks issued by a Lake County pitcher in a single game.

BACK FROM INJURY IN '23: Hajjar began the 2023 season on the 7-day injured list. The left-hander made two rehab appearances (one start) with the Arizona Complex League Guardians, pitching 7 innings, allowing 6 hits, 3 earned runs, and 6 walks, and throwing 7 strikeouts. He was then activated from the 7-day injured list on June 13, 2023.

MIDWEST LEAGUE EXPERIENCE: Hajjar made 2 starts for the Dayton Dragons in 2022, finishing with 0-1 with a 6.43 ERA and 10 strikeouts in 7 innings pitched. In his Minor League career, the left-hander has also pitched for the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels (Single-A, MIN) and the Florida Complex League Twins.

TWO TRADES: Hajjar was the player to be named later in the trade that sent former Captain **Will Benson** to Cincinnati and current Captains OF **Justin Boyd** to Cleveland on February 8, 2023. **Hajjar** was officially traded to Cleveland on March 26, 2023. Also, after being drafted by the Minnesota Twins in 2021, **Hajjar** was traded to the Cincinnati Reds on August 2, 2022 as part of the trade that sent RHP **Tyler Mahle** to Minnesota.

WONDERFUL WOLVERINE: Despite being drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 2018 MLB Draft, **Hajjar** elected to play college baseball at the University of Michigan, where he was teammates with former Captains C **Joe Donovan** for 2 seasons. After being redshirted as a freshman in 2019, **Hajjar** made 4 starts in 2020, finishing 3-0 with a 2.70 ERA and 24 strikeouts, and was named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice. He was also named 2nd Team All-Region by both ABCA and Rawlings.
