Looking for Two in a Row

Today, Reading plays the fourth of six games against Hartford at home as the R-Phils aim for their second-straight win. Last season, the R-Phils were strong at home, finishing with a 36-33 recored. Which compared to 25-44 away from FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2022 season series 10-8, but Reading took the lone series at home four games to two.

In the W Column

For the first time this season, Reading picked up a victory. It was an all-around clean win for the R-Phils. Offensively, Reasing garnered nine hits and scored four runs. The pitching staff looked the best it has on the young season. Mick Abel bounced back with four innings of work, allowing just one-earned run and three hits. Reading's bullpen combined to pitch five innings, allowing just two hits and one run.

Carlos De La Crushed

Carlos De La Cruz conitnued his red-hot start to the season on Thursday night. De La Cruz smoked a long home run into the brand-new Redner's Event Center in right-center field. It was the second-straight night De La Cruz hit a home run. De La Cruz hit home runs in back-to-back games once last season, on July 26 and 27 for Jersey Shore. He also did it once in 2019 for Lakewood and in 2018 for the Phillies Rookie Team. De La Cruz has never hit a home run in three-stright games.

Number One for the Skipper

New R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique earned his first win as R-Phils manager last night. Pedrique was hired this past offseason after Shawn Williams relocated to the Phillies complex in Clearwater. Most recently, Pedrique served as the third-base coach for the Miami Marlins. Prior to that, Pedrique managed Miami's triple-A affiliate, Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. He also has experinece coaching within the Diamondbacks, Astros, Yankees and many more organizations.

Looking Up

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies, struggled against the Cincinatti Reds, falling 6-2 on the road. Kyle Schwarber hit his fourth home run of the season, while a couple of fromer R-Phils had strong games. Alec Bohm went 1-4 and is hitting .327 on the season. Bryson Stott also added a hit to keep his average high at .400, which leads all Phillies. Philadelphia conntinues its series at the Reds tonight at 6:40.

Loaded with Prospects

Reading's Opening Day roster features five of the Phillies top-30 prospects. Mick Abel ranks second, Johan Rojas sixth, Carlos De La Cruz ninth, Ethan Wilson 14th and Andrew Baker 17th. All those players spent time in Reading last season.
