WINS OF CHANGE: The Somerset Patriots enter today having won four games in a row for the first time in the second half and the first time since winning five straight games from June 6-11. Somerset's offense enters today with 14+ hits in back-to-back games for the second time this season (May 5 – May 6).

BRIDGEWATER BOMBERS: The Somerset Patriots enter today leading all Double-A teams with 137 HR, which is tied for 7th in MiLB. The Patriots have recorded multiple HR in 40 of 95 games this season, already surpassing their total of 35 multi-home run games during the entire 2025 season (in 138 games). Somerset has homered in six straight games for the first time since homering in six straight games from June 16 – June 21.

FIRST INNING FIREPOWER: The Somerset Patriots have scored first in each of their last four games. DJ Gladney has opened the Patriots' scoring in the first inning in three out of five games this week, including twice with a first inning home run. The Patriots' 70 first inning runs lead the Eastern League and rank second in Double-A, while their 20 first inning homers are tied for second in Double-A.

SOMERSET SHOING: The Patriots' pitching staff enters today leading all Double-A teams with 992 strikeouts, which ranks 6th in MiLB. In their last nine games dating back to July 12 vs. REA, Somerset starting pitching has combined to allow 10 earned runs in 40.1 IP, for a 2.23 ERA, 1.02 WHIP and .163 BAA with 57 K to 18 BB.

MAMBA MENTALITY: Coby Morales enters today on a season-high-tying 14-game on-base streak (first time since 4/3-4/21). Over his last seven games, Morales is 10-for-28 (.357/.419/.679) with 2 HR, 4 XBH, 4 RBI, 7 R and 3 SB. Morales has four stolen bases in his last eight games, after having just two stolen bases in his prior 48 games.

EDGE OF SEVENTEEN: One day after Jace Avina clubbed his 18th home run of the season on Friday, DJ Gladney hit his 18th homer to tie for the active team lead on Saturday. Coby Morales enters today with 17 home runs.

MR. DJ SONG PON DE REPLAY: Coming off a season-high 4 RBI on Thursday, DJ Gladney enters today with back-to-back three-hit games for the first time this season. His seven three-hit games lead all Patriots batters. Gladney enters today with a six-game hit streak in tact over which he is 11-for-26 with 3 HR, 10 RBI, 5 XBH and 3 SB. With RBIs in all five games of this week's series, Gladney's 64 RBI rank third in the Eastern League and are tied for third in the Yankees minor league system.

REAL COLE WORLD: Cole Gabrielson has at least one hit and one RBI in all four games he has started this week since returning to Somerset from Triple-A SWB. In that span, he's 5-for-14 with 1 HR, 2 2B, 4 RBI, 4 R and a stolen base. Gabrielson has reached safely in 13 of 16 games with Somerset this season, including nine straight dating back to his June stint with the Patriots.

COBB DOING THE JOB: Owen Cobb has collected multiple hits in three of his last four games, totaling 13 multi-hit games on the season. Over this four-game stretch, Cobb is 7-for-13 with 3 RBI.

MOYLAN IS BOILIN': Josh Moylan enters today on a five-game hit streak, made up of all five games in this week's series. During the streak, he is 6-for-18 with 1 HR, 2 XBH, 4 RBI and 2 BB.

MERDA MAGIC: Hayden Merda earned his second win of the season on Saturday, while racking up two strikeouts with the bases loaded. The performance marked Merda's seventh straight outing with multiple strikeouts, now totaling 61 strikeouts on the season to lead all Yankees minor league relievers. Over his last seven appearances, Merda has recorded a 1.74 ERA, 2-0 record, 0.87 WHIP, .088 BAA with 20 K in 10.1 IP. Merda's 61 K in 36.0 IP this season equate to a 40.4 K%, which leads all Double-A relievers with 35.0+IP.

2026 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

JAMES COOPER: Manager (1st year)

James Cooper enters his first season as manager of the Somerset Patriots, his fifth overall year in the Yankees organization and his fourth consecutive as a minor league manager. He spent the 2025 season as the manager of the High-A Hudson Valley Renegades, after serving as manager of the Single-A Tampa Tarpons in 2024 and beginning his minor league managerial career with the FCL Yankees in 2023. Under Cooper's leadership in 2025, Hudson Valley finished with a franchise-record 79 wins (79-50), being eliminated from playoff contention on the final day of the regular season. During the season, the Renegades finished second in AVG (.235), H (970), OBP (.336), SLG (.363), OPS (.699), third in R (598) and HR (547). In 2024 at the helm for Tampa, the Tarpons led the FSL in SB, while ranking second in AVG, H and 2B, and fourth in OPS. During Cooper's first assignment with the Yankees organization in 2022, he served as defensive coach for the FCL Yankees, where he helped the team with the 2022 FCL Championship. The following season, Cooper made his managerial debut with the FCL Yankees and was named the Florida Complex League Manager of the Year in 2023, when his team led the FCL in runs, hits, triples, RBIs, AVG, OBP, SLG and OPS.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (2nd year)

Mike Fransoso enters his second season as a coach in Somerset and within the Yankees organization. Under Fransoso's leadership during the 2025 season, the Patriots' offense ranked among the Eastern League leaders with 129 HR (2nd), a .691 OPS (4th) and 600 R (5th). Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots (2018-2019) during the team's run as an independent team and also the Pittsburgh Pirates organization (2013-2015). He previously coached in the Seattle Mariners organization (2021-2024), serving as the hitting coach and interim manager for the Double-A Arkansas Travelers in 2024, when he helped manage the team to a Southern League Championship.

DEMETRE KOKORIS: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Demetre Kokoris enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees. He served as the pitching coach in Hudson Valley in 2025 and guided the team to a league-best 2.82 ERA and 20 shutouts. Prior to joining the Yankees, Kokoris, coached in the Texas Rangers (2022-2024) and Toronto Blue Jays (2019-2021) organizations. He spent the 2023 and 2024 seasons as the bullpen coach for the Triple-A Round Rock Express, and was the pitching coach for the Single-A Down East Wood Ducks in 2022. Prior to joining the Rangers, he was the pitching coach for the Short-Season Class-A Vancouver Canadians (2019-20) and was a rehab pitching coach (2021) with the Blue Jays. Before entering the professional coaching ranks, Kokoris was a college pitching coach at Chemeketa Community College, Point Loma Nazarene University, and Santa Barbara City College. He has also served as the pitching coach for the Greek National Team since 2021.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (2nd year)

Uziel Viloria enters his second consecutive season as a defensive coach in Somerset and his second season with the Yankees organization. Under his leadership in 2025, the Patriots posted a franchise record .983 fielding percentage. Viloria began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), reaching High-A Jersey Shore in 2022 and 2023.

CALEB HAMILTON: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Caleb Hamilton enters his first season in Somerset and second with the Yankees organization. After a playing career that included MLB experience with the Minnesota Twins (2022) and Boston Red Sox (2023), Hamilton completed his first year in coaching as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley in 2025. During his final season playing in 2024, Hamilton saw time in 39 games for the Rocket City Trash Pandas, the Double-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Angels. He was drafted by Minnesota in the 23rd round of the 2016 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, where he was an All-Pac-12 performer for the Beavers. Despite not catching in college, Hamilton made 323 of his 574 professional appearances as a catcher, and he played at least one game at all nine positions.
