On the Road Again

The Fightin Phils are back on the road for the final time in the season's first half, as they make the trip North to face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. It is the third-of-18 meetings between the teams this season and third-of-six at Mirabito Stadium in Binghamton. After this week, Binghamton returns to Reading from July 28-August 2 and from August 25-30. The Rumble Ponies won last year's season-series 12-5 and this year's season-series is tied at one after the teams split the first two games of the week.

Morning Game Wildness

The Reading Fightin Phils fell to 24-29 after dropping a wild 16-11 contest to the Binghamton Rumble Ponies at Mirabito Stadium. Reading scored first on an RBI single from Raylin Heredia, but Binghamton answered with nine consecutive runs over the first two innings to build a commanding 9-1 lead. The Fightin Phils battled back, scoring eight unanswered runs to erase the deficit, highlighted by RBI contributions from Austin Murr, Dylan Campbell, Dante Nori, Cade Fergus and Heredia. Fergus tied the game in the sixth, and Nori's RBI single in the seventh gave Reading its first lead since the opening inning at 10-9. The advantage was short-lived, however, as Binghamton responded with a five-run seventh inning, capped by JT Schwartz's grand slam that swung the game back in the Rumble Ponies' favor. Reading added one more run in the eighth, but a two-run homer from TT Bowens provided the final margin. Schwartz led Binghamton's offense with seven RBI, while Nori paced the Fightin Phils with three hits. Despite rallying from an eight-run deficit to briefly take the lead, Reading could not overcome Binghamton's late offensive surge.

Wood You Believe It

Phillies top pitching prospect, and number two overall prospect, Gage Wood makes his third Double-A start on Thursday night. Across two starts with Reading, Wood has allowed two-earned runs over seven innings, and has compiled 10 strikeouts. He was promoted to Reading May 18 directly from Clearwater (A) after just nine-career starts. Entering play on Thursday, Wood ranks fifth amongst Phillies Minor League pitchers in total strikeouts (50) and has posted a 13.50 SO/9.0 IP ratio, along with a 3.85 SO/BB mark this year. The Phillies drafted Wood in the first round (26th overall) in the 2025 draft out of Arkansas, where he famously fired a 19-strikeout no-hitter in the College World Series just weeks before being drafted.

King Tucker

Braydon Tucker's red-hot start to the 2026 season continued on Tuesday with seven-shutout innings, marking his second-straight seven-inning outings, matching both a season and career high. Through nine starts this season, Tucker has a 1.24 ERA (7 ER, 51.0 IP). Tucker has tossed five innings or more in seven-of-nine outings and six-plus frames five times, all of which were quality starts (6.0 + IP & < 3 runs). Tucker has allowed not allowed more than two-earned runs in a start this season and has allowed one-or-less in eight-of-nine appearances. Entering play on Thursday, Tucker leads the Eastern League in ERA (1.24), T-2nd wins (5), 6th IP (51.0), is fifth in BAA (.205) and third in WHIP (1.02). Tucker now leads all of Double-A in ERA and has the lowest ERA amongst all full-season minor leaguers. He has even a lower ERA than MLB's leader, also a Phillie in Cristopher Sanchez (1.46).

The Murr Man

Austin Murr is red-hot at the plate right now, riding a five-game hit streak, along with hits seven of his last eight games. Murr has also clubbed a double in four of the last five games he's played in. Since May 24 (eight games), Murr is slashing .444/.515/.815 (1.330 OPS), along with five runs, five doubles, one triple, one home run and nine RBI. Entering play on Thursday, Murr is ninth in the Eastern League in AVG (.311), T-3rd doubles (15) and seventh in XBH (23).

Rincon Raked

Despite missing a week on the injured list, Bryan Rincon turned in a very impressive May across 20 games. The 22-year old shortstop slashed .301/.400/.630 (1.030 OPS), along with 19 runs, 11 extra-base hits (4 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR), 17 RBI and was 5-5 in stolen bases. For the month of May, Rincon held the following Eastern League ranks: 6th OBP (.400), 5th SLG (.630), 4th OPS (1.030) and T-6th runs (19).

Money McFarlane

Alex McFarlane continued his excellent season with a scoreless inning on Tuesday, along with his fifth save of the season. On the season, the Phillies No. 17 prospect has a 0.46 ERA (1 ER, 19.2 IP). McFarlane has not allowed an earned run in 14-straight outings and has not allowed one in 19-of-20 appearances on the season. Amongst Eastern League pitchers that have fired at least 19.0 IP this season, McFarlane has the lowest ERA at 0.46.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 4, 2016: At Reading, Rhys Hoskins hits his 3rd walk-off homer of the season in the 10th for a 6-5 win on the club's first ever Star Wars Night. Hoskins finishes 2-for-5 with 2 solo HRs. The homer is Reading's 4th walk-off HR in the team's last 5 home games.

Rumblin' Into Binghamton

After winning the Eastern League Championship last season, it has been a tough year for the Rumble Ponies in 2026, as they sit at 19-34, which is the worst record in the league. Binghamton dropped four-of-six games against Portland last week and continue their two-week home stand with Reading this week. Next week, Binghamton is back on the road at Somerset. The Rumble Ponies' roster features eight of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jacob Reimer (4), Jonathan Santucci (8), Will Watson (9), Eli Serrano III (12), Chris Suero (14), RJ Gordon (18), Marco Vargas (19) and Brendan Girton (28).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Mets' No. 28 prospect, Brendan Girton makes the start on Thursday night for Binghamton. Over 10 starts this season, Girton is 1-3, with a 6.02 ERA (27 ER, 40.1 IP), along with 41 strikeouts. Girton last pitched on Friday against Portland, allowing four runs over 5.1 innings of work, in a no-decision. He spent his first-full professional season in 2025 between Brooklyn (A+) and Binghamton, combining to go 3-4, with a 3.10 ERA (30 ER, 87.0 IP) across 25 appearances/21 starts. Girton made his pro debut with three appearances for St. Lucie (A) in 2024. The Mets drafted Girton in the 10th round in 2024 out of Oklahoma, where he pitched in 2024. Girton began his college career at Texas Tech, pitching for the Red Raiders from 2021-23.
