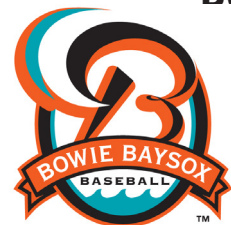

**STAR SPANGLED SHUTOUT:** In Monday's series opener on the Fourth of July, the Patriots secured their 5th shutout win of the season, 1-0 over the Bowie Baysox. Of Somerset's five shutouts, it was the second one started by Sean Boyle (6/11 vs. AKR) and it was also the second one that included Derek Craft (4/16 vs. ERI). All four of Somerset's nine-inning shutouts have been at home.

**STREAKING IN SOMERSET:** Anthony Volpe is actively responsible for the longest hit streak by any member of the Patriots this season. His 12-game hit streak is the longest active streak in the Eastern League and the 2nd-longest of his career (15 games, Single-A Tampa, 6/2-6/19/2021). Over this streak, Volpe is 15-for-46, slashing .326/.404/.652 with a 1.052 OPS, 9 RBI, 10 R, 4 HR, 3 2B, 5 BB and 9 SB. After beginning this season with hits in only 13 of his first 26 games at the Double-A level (.167 AVG / .698 OPS), Volpe has hit safely in 35 of his last 43 games with a .292/.373/.450 slash line (.823 OPS).

**SILENTLY SLUGGING:** Not to be overshadowed by Volpe's 12-game hit streak is Michael Beltre's 8-game hit streak entering today, which is the 2nd-longest by any Patriot this season. Over this stretch, Beltre is 11-for-27 (.407) with 10 RBI, 6 R, 4 HR, 3 BB and 5 SB. Additionally, Beltre has also stolen a base in 5 straight games, tied for the longest streak in the Eastern League this season (Hamilton, POR). Beltre has also homered in three straight games, becoming the third Patriot this season to have done so (Perkins, Bell).

**WHO'S NEXT?:** After an 8-game slump where Jesus Bastidas was 3-for-26 (.115) entering the series in Reading, he has broken out with a 5-game hit streak that has included four multi-hit games. Bastidas is 9-for-his-last-21 (.429). His 9 hits over the last 5 games are the most of any Patriot over that span.

### RHP #8 RANDY VASQUEZ

**CAREER:** (13-8, 2.65 ERA, 255.0 IP, 271 K, 1.14 WHIP)

- This season, Vasquez was named Pitcher of the Week (5/15) for the 3rd time in his career (all over the last year), after throwing 5.2 scoreless and hittless innings in Altoona on 5/13/22. He is one of two Patriots (Jhony Brito) to have been awarded Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors this year.
- Led all qualifying Yankees Minor Leaguers with a 2.52 ERA in 2021. Began 2021 in Single-A Tampa, where he spent the majority of his season. Pitched in 13 games (11 starts), going 3-3 with a 2.34 ERA and 58 strikeouts in 50.0 IP. Earned a promotion to High-A Hudson Valley, where he started six games and went 3-0 with a 1.75 ERA in six starts for the Renegades. He struck out 53 batters in 36.0 innings pitched for Hudson Valley, before earning an August promotion to Somerset. Vasquez ended the season with the Patriots, going 2-1 in 4 GS with a 4.22 ERA.
- In 2019, he spent the entire season with Rookie-level Pulaski, tying for the team lead with 11 starts, where he went 4-1 with a 3.29 ERA. Ranked second on the club in innings pitched (54.2) and strikeouts (53).
- In 2018, split his first professional season between the DSL Yankees and GCL Yankees. Combined to go 1-1 in nine games (seven starts) with a 1.78 ERA over 30.1 innings pitched.
- Signed with the Yankees as an international free agent at 19-years-old for a \$10,000 bonus on 8/2/18.
- Averages over 3,000 RPMs of spin rate on both his curveball and slider.

# COACHING STAFF



**DAN FIORITO**



**MANAGER**

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



**GERARDO CASADIEGO**



**PITCHING COACH**

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegade staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

**JAKE HIRST**



**HITTING COACH**

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



**AARON BOSSI**



**DEFENSIVE COACH**

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.
