LAST TIME OUT: The New Hampshire Fisher Cats rallied from down six runs to beat the Binghamton Rumble Ponies 14-8. Trailing 8-3 entering the bottom of the sixth, New Hampshire scored seven runs in the sixth inning all with two outs to take the lead for good. Miguel Hiraldo launched a grand slam to the batter's eye in center for his second home run of the game to trim the deficit down to one. Steward Berroa came off the bench and drilled a three-run pinch-hit home run to right-center to give the Fisher Cats a 10-8 lead. New Hampshire plated home three more runs in the seventh on RBI singles by Alan Roden, Leo Jimenez and Will Robertson and one more run in the eighth on an RBI double by Roden. Right-handed reliever Fitz Stadler picked up the win for New Hampshire after pitching 1.1 scoreless innings and inducing an inning-ending double play in the seventh with the bases loaded.

HIRALDO IS HOT: 2B Miguel Hiraldo is the hottest hitter right now in the Fisher Cats lineup. The second baseman is hitting a team-high .359 with seven homers and a team-leading 26 RBI in the month of August after hitting two homers and driving in six RBI last night. It's the second time this month where Hiraldo has recorded a multi-homer, six RBI game. The 22-year-old has driven in the second most RBI in the Eastern League this month and has driven in the most RBI by a Fisher Cat in a single month this season.

STEWARD STAYS READY: OF Steward Berroa hit the seventh pinch-hit homer in team history last night, a go-ahead three-run shot in the sixth inning. The last time a Fisher Cat hit a pinch-hit home run was Cavan Biggio at Harrisburg on May 10, 2018. Berroa is hitting .340 in the second half and remains second in the league in stolen bases.

CATS LOVE GRAND SLAMS: New Hampshire has hit grand slams in back-to-back games. For the season, the Fisher Cats have hit six, one shy of matching the team record set back in 2021. Miguel Hiraldo and Damiano Palmegiani each have two grand slams this season.

ROCKIN' AND RODEN: OF Alan Roden has been on a tear at the plate over his last 10 games. The Blue Jays No. 7 prospect is hitting .450 (18-for-40) with three doubles, three homers and eight RBI and has struck out only four times. Last night, Roden went 3-for-4 with a double and three RBI, including his fifth Double-A homer. He has had three 3+ hit games this month.

SOME OTHER NUGGETS: Andres Sosa tallied three doubles last night, the most in a game this year and one shy of the team record...New Hampshire turned five double plays on the night, which has only happened twice in team history.... Yesterday's comeback win marked only the second time in team history where New Hampshire has rallied back from down six or more to win...After hitting four more home runs last night, New Hampshire is tied for second in the league in homers this month (32). The most the Fisher Cats have hit in a single month is 38 back in May.

CHEDDAR CHEESE ON THE BUMP: RHP Chad Dallas makes his 15th start of the year and his third against Binghamton. The 23-year-old Texan is coming off a six inning, seven strikeout performance on Sunday in Hartford where he picked up the win. The Blue Jays No. 14 prospect has allowed just one run in 14 innings against the Rumble Ponies this year, including seven innings of one run ball with five strikeouts last time out on Aug. 2 at Binghamton to pick up the win. In four August starts, Dallas has a 1.96 ERA in 23 innings with 27 strikeouts and just four walks.

THIS DAY IN FISHER CATS HISTORY (August 26, 2012)—The Fisher Cats completed a four-game sweep of the New Britain Rock Cats with a walk-off 8-7 win. New Britain rallied to tie with four in the top of the ninth, but the Fisher Cats finished off the win. Jake Marisnick doubled and Ryan Goins bunted him to third. Walks to Brian Van Kirk and Ryan Schimpf loaded the bases, and Gabe Jacobo's fourth hit of the day brought home the game-winner.

MANCHESTER-BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: Toronto (70-59) dropped the opener of the series with the Guardians 5-2. The Blue Jays are now 1.5 games out of the wildcard. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and George Springer hit homers last night. Game two of the series was slated for 3:07 p.m. today with Hyun Jin Ryu the scheduled starter...Buffalo (60-62) took a 7-6 lead in the top of the tenth at Syracuse, but gave up a walk-off homer in a 9-7 loss. Tanner Morris hit a first-inning grand slam for the Bisons and Spencer Horwitz had three more hits, including his 29th double...Vancouver (72-45) fell 2-1 to Spokane on Friday afternoon. Estiven Machado homered for the Canadians run...Dunedin (55-62) swept a doubleheader from St. Lucie 6-0 and 15-2. Trent Palmer went 1.1 IP in a first-game start (40 pitches). He did not allow a hit but walked three in just his third game back off Tommy John surgery. In the second game, Nick Goodwin drove in four runs. Dunedin had just six hits but drew 18 walks. The Mets struck out only one in the game.
