Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It is the fourth matchup of the season between the teams, as Reading won last year's season-series 11-8. The Fightin Phils went 7-5 at home and 4-2 on the road against New Hampshire. The teams see each other for three more series this season, with one more at home and two at New Hampshire.

Late Game Struggles

Last night, the R-Phils fell 9-2 after a six-run top of the seventh from New Hampshire. Reading's lone offense came from a two-run home run from Oliver Dunn, to put Reading up 2-1 at the time. David Parkinson pitched in relief and after three strong innings to start, he allowed six-earned runs and suffered the loss. Griff McGarry had his first start of the season and showcased an upper-90s fastball over two innings of work.

Rare Off Night

Reading's offense had a rare off night last night. The R-Phils tied a season low with three base hits, which matched a mark set on the opening weekend at Richmond. Drew Ellis, Ethan Wilson and Oliver Dunn each had a hit a piece for the Fightin Phils, but the rest of the lineup combined to go 0-23 in the loss. Reading still owns the Eastern League's best batting average at .262, 19 points higher than second-place Portland.

A Look at the Pitching

Last night, the combination of Griff McGarry and David Parkinson were sharp through six innings. But six runs allowed in the seventh and another in the eighth led to the loss. The six runs allowed in the seventh were the most runs the R-Phils have allowed in an inning this season, along with the five home runs allowed, being the most in a game in 2023. But, the staff did register 12 strikeouts, which ties a nine-inning best.

Chasing 1K

R-Phils Manager Al Pedrique is closing in on a couple of milestones in his storied managerial career. Including winter ball, Wednesday night's win gave Pedrique 1,000 wins in his career. But, when including just minor and major league wins, Pedrique needs to get to 46 wins this season to achieve the mark of 1,000 professional wins in affiliated baseball.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies were off last night and begin a three-game series tonight at Colorado at 8:40. Lehigh Valley fell 8-6 at home to the Memphis Redbirds. Jersey Shore fell again 4-3 to Greenboro, while Clearwater suffered a 15-5 loss at Dunedin last night. The Threshers still hold the best record in the Florida State League at 22-8.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 12, 2016: At Trenton, Ricardo Pinto gets his first Double-A win (7.0 IP, 0 R, 2 H, 2 BB, 5 K) in a 3-0 whitewashing of the Thunder. Dylan Cozens hits a solo home run, his 10th blast of the season.

New Opponent

For the first time this season, Reading and New Hampshire meet. The Fisher Cats are 15-14 this season and won four-of-six games at home against Harrisburg last week. After dropping the first two of the series, New Hampshire was won four straight. After this week, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Binghamton.

The Robberse Report

Righty Sem Robberse gets the start tonight for New Hampshire. Over six starts, Robberse is 0-2 with a 3.64 ERA. He has allowed 18 hits and 12 walks, while picking up 30 strikeouts in 29.2 innings pitched. Last Saturday, he went six innings, allowing no runs on one hit and seven strikeouts in a no decision against Harrisburg. He split 2022 between Vancouver and New Hampshire, going 4-7 with a 3.23 ERA over 22 starts.

They found a bargain later on in the period, in January of 2018, when they inked Rojas for just \$10K. In each of his two years of full season ball, he's started slowly but finished well offensively, showing off his plus speed and defense at all stops. He made it to Double-A for the first time in 2022 and then finished with a strong performance in the Arizona Fall League before getting added to the 40-man roster. Rojas has shown he can be an impact player on both sides of the ball thanks to his near-top-of-the-scale speed. He's an elite baserunner, one who stole 62 bases in 67 tries last season and then went 13-for-13 in the AFL. His speed is an obvious asset in the outfield, where he is a premium defender in center field, one who could be a Gold Glov.
