TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for game four of a six-game series, as your first-place Quakes host the Inland Empire 66ers. In honor of National BBQ Day, the first 1,500 fans will receive a BBQ Apron, thanks to Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel! Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the tenth of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the fourth of 12 here at home. Last year, the Quakes went 7-5 here at home against the 66ers, 17-7 overall. Three straight wins in this series, coupled with five of six in San Bernardino in late-April give the Quakes an 8-1 mark against the 66ers through nine games.

LAST GAME: The Quakes held on for a 9-5 win over the Inland Empire 66ers on Thursday, their fifth straight win overall and their third straight to open this series at LoanMart Field. Roger Lasso had a season-best three hits and was one of three Quakes' to record a multi-hit game. Jaron Elkins went 1-for-2, but had two sacrifice flies for a game-high four RBIs. Myles Caba (2-0) struck out five over 2.1 innings of scoreless work to notch the win. Inland Empire starter Chris Clark (1-3) suffered the loss, allowing six runs over five innings.

ALL THIS WINNING: The Quakes have the best record in the Cal League at 26-10 and are a season-best 16 games over the .500 mark, after winning five straight and 17 of their last 20 games overall. Their home record is 15-3, thanks to five straight wins at LoanMart Field. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history and second as a Dodgers' affiliate.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST: The Quakes have put up some remarkable numbers offensively over the first three games in this series. After setting a franchise record with 25 runs in Tuesday's series-opener, they followed up with 12 in Wednesday night's win. Last night, it was a nine-run, 12-hit performance that gives them 46 runs on 49 hits over their 24 offensive innings this week. They've also scored in 16 of those 24 innings. Rancho's offense is currently first in the league with a team average of .274 and a league-best 32 home runs in 36 games.

EVEN MORE WEEKLY AWARDS: The Cal League Awards just keep coming for Rancho, with Eduardo Quintero getting tabbed as this week's Player of the Week. Quintero, the fourth Quake to win a weekly award this year, hit .375 (9-for-24) last week with three homers, five RBIs and six walks, giving him OBP of .500 for his week in Visalia.

AIDAN FOELLER: Right-hander Aidan Foeller makes his seventh start and eighth appearance, his second start against Inland Empire. In his lone outing against the 66ers, he struck out a career-high 12 batters, while walking four, giving up just two runs on one hit over five innings in a no-decision on April 23rd in San Bernardino. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on two hits in a no-decision over 4.2 innings at Visalia on May 10th. Last year, Foeller got a brief taste of the Cal League, striking out four, without surrendering a hit or run over three scoreless innings for Rancho. Foeller was an 11th-round selection in last year's draft, out of Southern Illinois.

FRANCIS TEXIDO: Francis Texido makes his eighth start and his second against the Quakes. In his lone outing against Rancho, he allowed four runs on two hits, but with five walks over 2.2 innings in a loss on April 24th at San Manuel Stadium. In his last outing overall, he allowed three runs on one hit, but with eight walks over 4.1 innings in a no-decision vs Stockton on May 11th. Last year, Texido made 25 appearances (24 starts), going 4-7 with a 6.77 ERA for Inland Empire. Texido signed with the Angels in March of 2023 out of Havana, Cuba.
