LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn's losing streak fell to a season-high-tying five with a 6-5 defeat at Hudson Valley on Friday...The Renegades jumped out to a 4-0 lead through two innings before 3B **Nick Lorusso** clubbed a three-run home run to pull the Cyclones within one...Hudson Valley carried a 6-3 lead before Brooklyn sliced it to one in the seventh...In the eighth, PH-LF **Kareil Paz** was robbed of a go-ahead base hit with runners at second and third and two out on a leaping snag by IB **Kiko Romero**...Lorusso picked up a pair of extra-base hits, while CF **Nick Morabito** reached base four times — on two singles and walks — and swiped three bags...IB **Mateo Gil** collected a pair of hits, including a double...2B **Junior Tilién** extended his on-base streak to 21 with a walk in the eighth...RHP **Josh Hejka** and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** combined to throw 3.0 hitless and scoreless innings out of the bullpen.

SUPER STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** is also in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...Consuegra had a 12-game on-base streak snapped on Wednesday and has a hit in 18 of his last 22 games since May 17 at Bowling Green...During that time, he's hitting .304/.417/.620 with a 1.037 OPS...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has scored 12 runs and added seven doubles, six home runs, and 18 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 57 points (.171 to .228) and his OPS by 224 points (.519 to .743) during the stretch...Since that date, the 23-year-old leads the South Atlantic League in slugging (.653), is tied for the league lead in home runs (6), and ranks second in OPS (1.088)...Consuegra set the Cyclones' all-time doubles record (39) on June 8 vs. Aberdeen and the all-time hits mark (179) on May 29 at Jersey Shore...He is also the franchise's all-time leader in extra-base hits (80), home runs (35), RBI (119), and outfield assists (19)...Consuegra also holds the single-season mark for home runs (23), and extra-base hits (42), and is tied with INF **Ronny Mauricio** (63) for single-season RBI.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.460)...He is also seventh in stolen bases (30) and 10th in batting average (.344)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (19) with Aberdeen OF **Matthew Etzel**, tied for sixth in runs scored (25), and ninth in on-base percentage (.409).

CALM, COLÓN, COLLECTED: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** was sublime out of the bullpen for the Cyclones on Wednesday night...The 24-year-old stranded the bases loaded with one out in the second inning, hurling 6.2 innings of shutout ball...Colón scattered four hits and struck out a season-best six...The 6.2 innings on the hill was the longest effort by the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native since he threw 6.2 innings in a start, taking a no-decision, on May 26, 2023, vs. Winston-Salem...The 6.2 innings of the bump also matched the longest outing by a Cyclone pitcher this year...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run ball to earn the win in a start vs. Hudson Valley on May 21...Colón is the first Brooklyn relief pitcher to toss 6.2+ innings since RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 7.0 scoreless innings to earn the win vs. Aberdeen on May 7, 2023...Colón and Geber are the only South Atlantic League pitchers to throw 6.2+ innings in a single game since the start of the 2023 season.

JUNIOR MINTS: INF **Junior Tilién** enters play tied with Greenville OF **Allen Castro** for the longest active on-base streak in the South Atlantic League, reaching in 21 consecutive games since Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 16 at Bowling Green...The 21-year-old has accumulated a .286/.383/.429 slash line with a .812 OPS during the streak, adding three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 11 RBI, and 13 walks...The infielder is the first Cyclone to record an on-base streak of 20 or more games since INF **José Peroza** reached in 31-consecutive games from July 29 until September 2, 2022...Tilién also posted a 10-game hitting streak from May 26 until June 9...He slashed .375/.409/.550 with a .959 OPS in that time.

SUERO SUAVE: C **Chris Suero** has started to find his rhythm offensively in the South Atlantic League...The 20-year-old capped last week's series vs. Aberdeen with his first career multi-home run game, blasting two-run shots in the fourth and sixth innings...In five games against the IronBirds, Suero was 7-for-16 (.438) at the dish with seven runs scored, a double, three home runs, and an eye-popping 11 RBI...Since May 17 at Bowling Green, Suero has reached safely in 18 of 19 games, hitting .308/.451/.508 with a .959 OPS...The Bronx native has

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn hits the road for the final six-game series of the season's first half against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...Hudson Valley possesses five of New York's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), INF **Tyler Hardman** (25), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...The Cyclones captured the first meeting at Maimonides Park, winning 4-of-6...In 2023, Brooklyn went 6-6 against Hudson Valley on Coney Island and 8-4 at Heritage Financial Park...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 144-149 (.491).

scored a whopping 19 runs with a double, four home runs, 16 RBI, and 16 walks...Since that date, Suero is fourth in the SAL in runs scored (19), sixth in on-base percentage (.451), tied for sixth in walks (16), and 10th in OPS (.959).

JOLTIN' JEFREY: IF/OF **Jeffrey De Los Santos** has been an extra-base machine in recent games...The 20-year-old had a seven-game hitting streak since the beginning of June snapped on Wednesday...He has also tallied multiple knocks in six of his last 11 games...Since May 30 at Jersey Shore, De Los Santos is hitting .349/.417/.721 with a 1.138 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, two triples, three home runs, seven RBI, and five walks...Since the start of June, De Los Santos is second in the circuit in slugging (.714), tied for second in triples (2), fifth in OPS (1.150), tied for seventh in extra-base hits (6), and ninth in batting average (.371)

FETTUCINE WILFREDO: INF **Wilfredo Lara** has been scorching hot for the Cyclones since May 19...The 20-year-old has appeared in 21 games and tallied a .306/.407/.472 line with a .879 OPS...Lara has scored 16 runs and added two doubles, two triples, two home runs, 10 RBI, 10 walks, and four stolen bases...Lara is also had a 13-game on-base streak since May 26 vs. Hudson Valley snapped on Wednesday...He hit .372/.509/.535 with a 1.044 OPS during the stretch.

YOU'LL GET NOTHING AND LIKE IT: RHPs **Dakota Hawkins** (5.0 IP), **Joey Lancellotti** (1.0), and **Joshua Cornielly** (3.0) combined on the first nine-inning no-hitter in Brooklyn Cyclones history in Tuesday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...The only previous no-hitter came on August 23, 2009, when RHP **Brandon Moore** tossed a seven-inning no-no in a 5-0 win during Game 1 of a doubleheader at Aberdeen...It is just the third no-hitter in Minor League Baseball in 2024...LHP **Chayce McDermott**, RHP **Nolan Hoffman**, and RHP **Kaleb Ort** combined on a 2-0 no-hitter for Baltimore's Triple-A Norfolk on May 3 vs. Nashville...RHP **Dylan Cumming**, RHP **Nick Sinacola**, and LHP **Seth Corry** of San Francisco's High-A Eugene combined on a 4-0 no-no on April 17 vs. Vancouver...Tuesday's effort was the first no-hitter by a Mets minor league affiliate since RHP **Joander Suárez** hurled a seven-inning one on September 7 at Hartford...It was also the first nine-inning no-hitter thrown in the borough of Brooklyn since RHP **Sal Maglie** tossed a no-no for the Dodgers against the Philadelphia Phillies on September 25, 1956, at Ebbets Field.

THE CENTURY MARK: RHP **Michel Otañez** became the 100th player in Brooklyn Cyclones history to make the trip from Coney Island to the Major Leagues, making his Major League debut for the Oakland Athletics on Monday night...The 26-year-old threw 0.2 scoreless innings in San Diego allowing a hit and a walk...Otañez made seven starts for Brooklyn in the 2019 season and 35 relief appearances during the 2021 campaign...In 42 appearances (seven starts), the right-hander held a 5-2 record with a 4.20 ERA (33 ER in 70.2 IP), one save, 58 walks, and 84 strikeouts...Otañez is the second former Cyclone to make his Major League debut in 2024...RHP **Christian Scott** (2022-23) was the first to do so for the New York Mets on May 4.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 59 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-2 record with a 2.43 ERA (26 ER in 96.1 IP) and 6 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 84.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Friday night vs. Aberdeen...Surrendered four runs on a career-high seven hits over 5.0 innings...Walked one and struck out eight...Permitted a two-run home run to 1B **Maxwell Costes** in the second inning...Tossed 86 pitches and 59 strikes (68.60%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** to start the top of the sixth with the Cyclones leading 6-4...The IronBirds scored three in the sixth to take the lead...However, Brooklyn scored three in the seventh and four more in the eighth to defeat Aberdeen on SNY, 13-7.

PROSPECT RADAR: Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 22 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

THE TONG SONG: The 20-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In 11 appearances (nine starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-1 with a 2.58 ERA (13 ER in 45.1 IP).

2023: After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

TRAVELING MAN: A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season...Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an 0-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zachary Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
