TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints managed only a solo homer from Elliot Soto in a 4-1 loss to the Louisville Bats on Friday night at Louisville Slugger Field. Ariel Jurado was fantastic out of the bullpen going 4.0 shutout innings allowing one hit while striking out three.

A REMARKABLE STREAK: Jake Cave failed to reach base on Friday night at Louisville for the first time in more than two months. His streak of reaching base safely came to an end at 49 games. The streak began on May 3 when he went 0-4, but drew a walk. During the streak, he hit .295 with 10 doubles, 11 home runs, 39 RBI, a .385 on base percentage, .580 slugging percentage, for a .965 OPS. He hit safely in 39 of the 49 games, extended the streak with a walk nine times, and a hit by pitch once. The previous franchise high was 20 consecutive by Jimmy Kerrigan last season. It was the second longest streak in Minor League Baseball this season. The longest streak is 51 consecutive games by Luke Berryhill of Corpus Christi from April 14-June 21.

HEAD ABOVE WATER: Above .500 continues to elude the Saints. The Saints had the opportunity to get above .500 with a win on July 8 vs. Louisville. Their 4-1 loss marked the fifth consecutive time that they have had a chance to get over .500, but lost. The last time they went into a game at .500 and won was June 19 @ Columbus when they won 11-10.

HOW DO YOU SPELL RELIEF: Over the last two night's the Saints have gotten excellent bulk relief appearances from Ronny Henriquez and Ariel Jurado. Both guys tossed 4.0 shutout innings of relief. In the month of July, the Saints relievers have been solid with a 3.75 ERA, seventh best in Triple-A.

WE BELIEVE THE PROSPECTS ARE OUR FUTURE: On July 7, Spencer Steer was chosen to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium. Steer is one of two Minnesota Twins Minor Leaguers to be chosen. He joins Wichita Wind Surge outfielder Matt Walner. Steer is the first Saints player chosen to the Futures Game. Josh Winder, who was chosen in 2021, was called up to the Saints two days before the announcement, but hadn't pitched for the Saints.

DO WE GET SPECIAL JACKETS IN THIS CLUB: The St. Paul Saints joined the 100/100 club on Thursday. Tim Beckham's first inning home run was the 100th of the season for the Saints. The home run by Louisville's Colin Moran in the 2nd was the 100th allowed by the Saints. They are the 11th team in all of Minor League Baseball to hit 100 homers and allow 100 homers. They join: Albuquerque, Amarillo, Durham, El Paso, Greensboro, Greenville, Memphis, Reno, Sacramento, and Tacoma. All, but Greensboro & Greenville are Triple-A team.s

COMING UP EMPTY: The Saints struck out 17 times on Wednesday, the highest total this season. It's the fourth most in franchise history. The Saints fanned 20 times in a 14 inning game on August 28, 2021 @ Toledo. They struck out 19 times twice last year on May 6 @ Omaha in an 11 inning game and 19 times on May 30 @ Iowa, their franchise record for a 9-inning game.

FIRST INNING FLOP: The St. Paul Saints have allowed at least one run in the first inning in 35 of 81 games (43.2%) the Saints have allowed at least a run in the first inning. They have allowed 73 runs in the first, most in the International League and third most in all of Minor League Baseball behind Albuquerque (91) & Stockton (81). Their 19 home runs allowed are fifth most in Mino

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT: The St. Paul Saints have played 81 games this season and have an extra base hit in all, but one game. They have an extra base hit in 73 consecutive games, the second longest streak in all of Minor League Baseball. The only team with a longer streak is El Paso's 82 game streak, which is also active. The lone game they didn't collect an extra base hit was the game they were no-hit on April 13 vs. Indianapolis. They have just one extra base hit in only 10 games.

AND THEN THERE WERE SIX: The St. Paul Saints are a part of the final six, but not a final six they care to be included in. The Saints have yet to throw a shutout in 2022. They are one of only six Minor League teams that have yet to throw a shutout. They are joined by the Charlotte Knights in the International League, the Chattanooga Lookouts in the Southern League, Columbia Fireflies and Delmarva Shorebirds in the Carolina League, and the Visalia Rawhide in the California League. The Saints 5.19 ERA in the second lowest of the six teams. Chattanooga's ERA in 5.12.

QUALITY OVER QUANTITY: Aaron Sanchez pitched an outstanding game on July 3 vs. Omaha throwing 6.0 innings allowing just one runs. It was his first quality start of the season and fifth by a Saints pitcher. The other Sanchez, Mario has three quality starts. Sanchez had back-to-back quality starts on May 26 vs. Indianapolis and June 2 @ Iowa and again on June 25 at Buffalo. Chi Chi González tossed a quality start on May 11 @ Columbus. The Saints, however, are just 3-2 when a starter throws a quality start.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins lost the first game of their series to the Texas Rangers 6-5 on Friday night at Globe Life Field. Ryan Jeffers collected three hits including a home run. Carlos Correa also homered and Max Kepler had three hits. Jharel Cotton pitched 2.0 scoreless innings while striking out four.

LAST APPEARANCE: 7/3 vs. OMA...tossed 6.0 innings allowing one run on three hits while striking out two...received the win in a 10-2 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 6/25 @ BUF...pitched 5.0 innings allowing three runs on five hits, giving up one home run, while walking five and striking out three...received the win in a 7-4 Saints victory.

SAILING ON THE SAME SHIP: Aaron's step Dad, Mike Shipley, was selected twice by the California Angels in 1976. Once in the 10th round of the January Draft-regular phase and then again in June-secondary phase. Shipley, however, would never pitch for the Angels organization because he suffered a left shoulder injury.

HEARD IT THROUGH THE GRAPEVINE: The city of Barstow, California, once known as Grapevine, is the birthplace of Aaron Sanchez. He is believed to be the first ever Major Leaguer born in Barstow. After his debut and successful first season in the Majors in 2014, the Barstow City Council declared October 20, 2014 to be "Aaron Sanchez Day"

WALKS DON'T ALWAYS WARE ON YOU: Aaron Sanchez recorded his first win as a Major League starter on April 22, 2015. He became the first Blue Jays pitcher to win despite walking seven since Jeff Ware in 1995. He pitched 5.1 innings allowing two runs on two hits while walking seven and striking out four.

BIG GAME PITCHER: In the 2015 ALDS, Sanchez appeared in all five game of the 2015 Division Series against the Texas Rangers and did not allow a run in 5.1 IP. He got the win in Game 5 of the ALDS, the game Bautista hit the memorable bat flip homer.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR: In 2016, Aaron Sanchez was one of the more dominant pitchers in the American League. Despite his amazing numbers, he wasn't selected to the All-Star game...initially. That was until Craig Kimbrel needed surgery on a torn miniscus, Sanchez got his first, and only, Major League All-Star nod. Sanchez got Wil Meyers to ground out, walked Buster Posey, gave up a single to Anthony Rizzo, an RBI single to Marcel Ozuna, a lineout by Carlos Gonzalez, and a groundout by Addison Russel.

ALL I DO IS WIN: On July 25, 2016 Sanchez won his 10th straight decision becoming the first Blue Jay since Roy Halladay in 2003 to win at least 10 consecutive decisions.

POR ME: At the end of the 2016 season, Aaron Sanchez led the American League in ERA at 3.00. Despite going 15-2 with a 3.00 ERA and fanning 161 in 192.0 IP he finished seventh in the Cy Young balloting. Rick Porcello of the Boston Red Sox, who went 22-4 with a 3.15 ERA and 189 strikeouts in 223.0 IP, took the award. He edged out Justin Verlander 137.0-132.0. Sanchez wasn't even the highest Cy Young finisher on his own team. J.A. Happ finished sixth going 20-4 with a 3.18 ERA and 163 strikeouts in 195.0 innings pitched.

GONE FISHING: When Aaron Sanchez walked into the Saints clubhouse, there was a face he should have recognized. On July 31, 2019, Sanchez was traded from the Blue Jays to the Houston Astros along with RHP Joe Biagini and OF Cal Stevenson in exchange for OF Derek Fisher, current Saints outfielder.

GREAT FIRST IMPRESSION: Following the trade to the Astros, in Sanchez' first start he went 6.0 no-hit innings. The Astros would finish off a combined no-hitter as Will Harris (1.0 IP), Joe Biagini (1.0 IP), who was a part of the trade, and Chris Devenski (1.0 IP) finished it off.

- DFA'd by the Washington Nationals on 29 and cleared waivers. Elected free agency on May 31
- Signed a Minor League contract with the Washington Nationals on March 16, 2022
- Joined San Francisco near the start of Spring Training in 2021. Pitched fewest Major League innings (35.2 IP) since appearing in eight games with Toronto in 2017
- Missed the 2020 season recovering from a shoulder injury to repair a torn capsule in his throwing shoulder that he suffered in September of 2019
- Began the 2019 season with Toronto posting a 3-14 record in 23 games
- Posted a 4-6 record in his final full season with the Blue Jays in 2017. Toronto won seven of the last nine starts Sanchez made with the Major League team. Pitched 6.0 IP or more in 10 of his 20 Major League starts
- Pitched in a career-low eight games while registering career highs in ERA (4.25), opp. avg. (.288) and WHIP (1.72) in 2017 with Toronto
- Finished the 2016 season 1st in the AL in ERA (3.00), opponents' OPS (.625) and SLG % (.335), and 4th in opponents' average (.224). Allowed just a .219 opp. avg. with RISP that season, 9th lowest in the American League. Posted a groundball percentage of 54.4%, 3rd best in AL
- Was ejected for the first time in his career after hitting Alcides Escobar in the 8th inning on August 2, 2015 vs Kansas City.
- Earned his first win of the season and first victory as a starter on April 22, 2015 vs Baltimore with Toronto
- Earned three saves in three opportunities becoming the 4th youngest Blue Jays pitcher to record a save after collecting his 1st on August 30, 2014 vs. NYY
