SECOND SERIES AGAINST SCRANTON: The Syracuse Mets continue their fourth road series and second set of the season against the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the Triple-A affiliate of the New York Yankees.

The Mets took four out of five games against the RailRiders in their first meeting of the season from 4/14-4/18 at NBT Bank Stadium. Syracuse crushed a single series-high 13 home runs and had a .956 team OPS.

LAST TIME OUT: The Mets won their second game of the series on Friday 8-2. Syracuse was guided by SP Zach Thornton. In his second Triple-A start, the left-hander tossed 6.0 IP, allowed 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB and recorded 9 K to pick up his first Triple-A win.

Offensively, the Mets crushed three home runs. 3B Yonny Hernandez lifted his second home run of the season, both of his homers coming against the RailRiders. C Ben Rortvedt blasted his first home run in a Mets uniform and RF Cristian Pache found the seats for the fifth time this season.

LAST SERIES RECAP: Syracuse lost its most recent series against Rochester four games to two. The Mets hit .206 as a team, the second-worst team batting average in the International League on the week (Indianapolis - .150).

Mets' starting pitchers combined for a 3.30 ERA, the sixth-best in the IL last week, and threw 27 strikeouts, tied for third in the IL.

RYAN REPEATS: For the second time this season, OF/1B Ryan Clifford earned Mets Minor League Player of the Week honors, a nod awarded by the Mets Player Development. In six games against Rochester, the 22-year-old went 9-for-22 (.409/.458/.818) with 4 R, 1 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 3 RBI, 2 BB and just 4 K.

Clifford took home his first honor of the season after his performance from 4/14-4/18 against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The Mets No. 3 prospect went 6-for-16 with 2 HRs, 5 RBIs, 3 BBs and just 2 Ks.

CARRILLO IS CRUISIN': RP Alex Carrillo has not allowed a run over his last seven appearances, which is the active team lead. Over his last seven outings, a stretch that began on 4/25 @WOR, Carrillo has worked 6.2 IP, allowed 6 H, 4 BB and recorded 13 K.

A.J. TO THE BIG LEAGUES: After just 12 games with Syracuse, the Mets called up the organization's top prospect A.J. Ewing. In his major league debut on Tuesday, Ewing picked up his first big league hit on an RBI triple, went 1-for-2 with 3 BB, 2 R and 2 RBI. The 21-year-old outfielder also scored the game-winning run on Carson Benge's walk-off single on Wednesday to defeat Detroit.

In 12 Triple-A games, Ewing went 15-for-46 (.326/.392/.435) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 RBI, 5 BB, 5 SB and an .827 OPS.
