**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Brooklyn jumped into first place in the North Division of the South Atlantic League, beating Hudson Valley 7-5 on Saturday night. The Cyclones led the game 6-1 and held on at the end. LHP **Nick Zwack** lasted 4 1/3 innings and allowed three earned runs for the first time in a Cyclones uniform. However, Brooklyn's offense mustered 14 hits, including three from OF **Rowley Jordan** and three from 3B **Jose Peroza**. RHP **Nolan Clenney** struck out eight in a row before allowing a two-run home run to Hudson Valley OF **Grant Richardson**. RHP **Justin Courtney** came on for the final out to earn the save.

**IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU FINISH:** The Cyclones have a 3.79 ERA in July, good for third-best in the circuit behind Wilmington (3.68 ERA) and Hudson Valley (3.71 ERA). However, the Cyclones have five blown saves, ranking as the most for a team in High-A with an ERA sub-3.80. In the month, Brooklyn starters have a 2.61 ERA (38 earned runs in 131 IP), while the bullpen has a 4.81 ERA (39 ER in 73 IP).

**SCHWARTZ SWATTING:** 1B **JT Schwartz** has two singles, three doubles, and a grand slam over the first four games of this series with the Renegades, going 6-16 (.375). The Mets' No. 19 prospect has hit two of his four home runs against Hudson Valley.

**STEPPING UP IN SUBWAY SET:** Friday night, INF **Shervyen Newton** drilled his third home run against Hudson Valley this season and fourth with Brooklyn. 1B **JT Schwartz** has hit five of his 18 doubles against Hudson Valley and two of his four home runs, and OF **Rowley Jordan** had hit five of his 17 doubles against the 'Gades.

**RA-RA FOR RAMIREZ:** No. 4 Mets prospect OF **Alex Ramirez** went 1-5 last night and has hits in 17 of his past 38 at bats with six multi-hit games over his past 10 games. In the span, Ramirez has a two

**CON SWAGGER:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** has been on a tear since the start of the Greensboro series on July 12. Over his past 14 games, Consuegra is hitting .333 with a 1.055 OPS. In the span, the 21-year-old outfielder has been on base in 12 of the 14 games and has four multi-hit efforts.

**NIC KNOWS:** C/INF **Nic Gaddis** collected another walk last night. Since June 21, the 2019 draftee has been on base in 25 of his past 28 games, posting a .412 OBP and a .844 OPS. Gaddis has also spent some time at second base along with his natural positions at third and behind the plate.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 50 home runs in the past 61 games (0.82 HR/G) after just seven over the team's first 34 games (0.2 HR/G).

**METS TRADE WATCH:** Thursday night, the Mets made a deal with Cincinnati, bringing in OF **Tyler Naquin** and LHP **Philip Diehl** in exchange for two Low-A St. Lucie prospects 2B **Hector Rodriguez** and RHP **Jose Acuna**. The 2022 trade deadline is Tuesday, August 2 at 6 p.m. ET.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Santos lasted just 2/3 of an inning on Tuesday, tied for the shortest start of his career (last: 6/19/19 at Greeneville, pitching with Kingsport in Rookie-level).

**HIGH-RANKING MEMBER:** Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

**BREAKOUT:** The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

**VALUED MEMBER:** Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

**WEIRD START:** Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos' clunky start may have been affected by Friday night's postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

**OPENING DAY STARTER:** Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
