TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game homestand against the Indianapolis Indians (Triple-A, Pittsburgh Pirates) on Wednesday night at AutoZone Park in Memphis. Left-handed pitcher Alex Cornwell is slated to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Carmen Mlodzinski for Indianapolis.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds snagged game one of a six-game series against the Indianapolis Indians (Triple-A, Pittsburgh Pirates) by a 4-2 final score on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Left fielder Matt Koperniak gave Memphis the lead on two occasions. The left-handed hitter struck a laser beam to right field for his fifth home run of the season to lead off the third inning and start the scoring. Koperniak then singled home a run in the seventh to put the Redbirds in front 2-1. Koperniak finished the win 3-for-3 with two runs scored and two RBIs. Center fielder Michael Siani and shortstop Thomas Saggese each drove in an insurance run in the three-run seventh. With the win, Memphis improved to 27-1 when leading after seven innings and 19-0 when leading after the eighth. Starting pitcher Michael McGreevy was fantastic in his 4.1-inning start. The right-handed pitcher, who finished with 75 pitches, did not allow a run and struck out four. McGreevy worked around four hits and a walk with aid from two double plays. Ryan Fernandez (3-1) earned the win with 2.0 innings of scoreless relief. Riley O'Brien (S, 3) allowed a run on three hits in the ninth but recorded the final out with the tying run in scoring position to record the save.

Ben Johnson enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

 Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

 Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

 Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH **HOWIE CLARK**

 Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

 In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. - Is tied for 4th among St. Louis minor leaguers with 21 wins since the start of the 2022 season, the most by any left- handed pitcher in the organization during that time.
- Also leads St. Louis minor league left-handers with 279 strikeouts from 2022-24 (7th in STL system) and his 288.1 IP are second among lefties (9th overall) behind only Connor Thomas (319.2 IP).
- Southern California native graduated from Maranatha High School in Pasadena, Calif., which produced former MLB pitchers Dylan Covey and Tim Worrell.
- Attended the University of Southern California from 2018-21 but did not play his first two seasons because of injury.
- Made 15 starts in 2021 with 65 strikeouts against 21 walks.
- Originally selected by the Chicago Cubs in the 37th round of the 2017 MLB Draft, but did not sign.

CAREER NOTES

- 2023 Rule 5 pick from Boston spent his first full season in the Majors and appeared in a professional season high in games (62) and innings pitched (66.2)
- Became the first Rule 5 Selection to play an entire season with St. Louis since RHP Matt Bowman (2015).
- His 62 appearances led 2023 Major League Rule 5 Draft Picks and were the most by any Cardinals Rule 5 Draft Pick in the season immediately following his selection.
- His 62 appearances for St. Louis in 2024 were the most by a Cardinals rookie since Giovanny Gallegos (66 in 2016).
- Made Major League debut on April 3, 2024 at San Diego, striking out the side in the 9th inning. Became the 38th pitcher in MLB history
 and the 2nd Cardinal (Braden Looper, March 31, 1998 vs. Dodgers) to strike out three in 1.0 inning pitched in an MLB debut.
- According to Baseball Savant, threw his Slider 48.1% of the time in 2024 (573 of 1,191 pitches), most of any pitch. Ranked among 2024 leaders in Run Value (9, T-11th) & Hard-Hit Pct. (23.5, 6th) among pitchers to throw 400+ sliders.
- Was one of 11 prospects invited to the 2023 Red Sox rookie development program.
