SWEET AS HONEY

♦ The Reno Aces fell 6-3 to the Salt Lake Bees on Thursday night at The Ballpark at America First Square... **Jordan Lawlar** showed off the power, launching his first home run of the campaign, a two-run shot into the left-centerfield bleachers, to put the Aces on the board in the first inning. The Diamondbacks #1 overall prospect has swung it well in April, going 12-for-38 (.316) with five extra-base hits and nine RBI in nine games this month... **Rene Pinto** provided the rest of the offense, who also smashed his first home run of 2025, a solo shot over the left-field porch. Pinto is off to a solid start, slashing .273/.304/.500 with four RBI in six games... Despite taking the loss, **Tommy Henry** was effective on the mound. The lefty allowed three runs through five innings before returning in the sixth, where he gave up three more to the Bees. While he's had some early-season struggles, Henry's performance shows signs that he's trending in the right direction... **Ildemaro Vargas** extended his hitting streak to six games after a 1-for-3 effort in the defeat. The veteran has gone 9-for-26 (.360) with three home runs and 10 RBI over the hot stretch... The Aces will attempt to flip the script in Friday's matchup against the Salt Lake Bees, with the first pitch scheduled for 5:35 P.M. PST.

ACES vs DANA

♦ The Aces will face right-hander Caden Dana in Friday's match-up against the Bees... Currently ranked as the Angels #2 overall prospect: **Scouting grades:** Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 45 | Slider: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 50 | Overall: 55... The 21-year-old was efficient in his first outing in 2025, allowing one run on three hits and three walks with four strikeouts in four frames against the El Paso Chihuahuas... He most recently appeared out of the bullpen in MLB, surrendering two runs on four hits and one walk with two strikeouts in three innings vs the Cleveland Guardians... He was dominant in 2025, spending time with Double-A Rocket City, and the Angels, skipping Triple-A. Dana led all of Double-A in ERA (2.52) and WHIP (0.94) while striking out 147 in 135 2/3 total innings with the Trash Pandas last season... He earned a September call-up to the bigs, registering a 9.58 ERA with eight punchouts and seven walks in 10 1/3 frames (three starts)... Dana is a threat on the mound and the Aces must capitalize vs the righthander in Friday's matchup.

♦ NEXT STARTER: RHP CASEY KELLY (0-0, N/A ERA) ♦

♦ **Casey Kelly** is set to make his Aces debut in Saturday's matchup against the Salt Lake Bees... The 35-year-old has yet to appear in a game in 2025, but he brings a wealth of professional experience dating back to 2009... Originally selected by the Red Sox in the first round of the 2008 MLB Draft, Kelly was part of the blockbuster trade that sent Adrian Gonzalez from San Diego to Boston in the winter of 2009. He made his Major League debut with the Padres in 2012... Kelly spent six seasons in the KBO (2019-2023), where he compiled a 73-46 record with a 3.25 ERA across 163 starts. He returned to the U.S. in 2024, signing a minor league deal with the Cincinnati Reds. That season, he earned a brief call-up to the majors, making two relief appearances in which he allowed three runs over 5 1/3 innings, struck out four, and notched one save... Kelly looks to start his Aces career with a win in Fridays matchup.

♥ **Jordan Lawlar:** Smashed his first HR of the 2025 campaign in yesterday's loss... Has been red-hot as the plate after a slow start, going 10-for-30 (.333) with 3 2B, 1 HR, and 8 RBI in the last 7 games... Currently ranked as the Dbacks #1 overall prospect (#11 according to MLB Pipeline)...**Scouting grades:** Hit: 55 | Power: 50 | Run 70 | Arm: 55 | Field: 60 | Overall: 60... Slashing .263/.391/.368 with 4 2B, 5 RBI, and 6 BB vs RHP this season.
♦ **Carter Kieboom:** Went 3-for-3 with 1 HR, and 1 RBI in last night's matchup... Off to a blazing hot start with Salt Lake, going 14-for-31 (.452) with 3 XBH (2 HR), 4 RBI, and 3 BB in 8 games... Spent four seasons in the bigs, owns a career .199/.297/.301 slashline with 12 HR and 42 RBI in 133 games with the Washington Nationals... Ranked as the #21 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline in 2020.

THIS DAY IN BASEBALL

♦ **April 11, 2013** - A bench-clearing brawl in the Dodgers' 3 - 2 win over the Padres proves costly, as prize free agent signee Zack Greinke breaks his left collarbone in the melee. Greinke plunks Carlos Quentin on the left shoulder with a 6th-inning pitch and the slugger charges the mound and tackles the pitcher to the ground; they end up at the bottom of a huge pile of players from both dugouts. Greinke's left shoulder took the brunt of the impact as Quentin first ran into him. Three players are ejected, including Quentin, while Greinke will be out for a number of weeks because of the injury. The Dodgers win the game on Juan Uribe's pinch homer in the 8th. Quentin received an eight-game suspension.

MENA MADNESS

♥ **Cristian Mena** is ready to make his third start of the campaign in Friday's matchup vs the Bees... The right-hander was electric in his previous outing, collecting his first quality start of the season after limiting the Tacoma Rainiers to one run across six frames with two walks and five punchouts... He is off to a solid start to the year, registering an elite 0.84 ERA with nine strikeouts and four walks... The 22-year-old faced Salt Lake four times last season, going 0-2 with a 6.43 ERA, surrendering 15 earned runs in 21 total innings with 24 punchouts and 9 walks... His best outing vs Salt Lake came on 4/18/24 when he struck out seven Bees in four innings, allowing one unearned run with three walks... Mena is poised to keep his strong start in Friday's game vs Salt Lake.
♦ Was the youngest pitcher to throw more than 90 frames at Triple-A last season... Relied more on his mid-80s breaking pitches to get whiffs than his fastball in 2024... His curveball drops sharply downward while his slider shows decent sweep but can bleed into the curve.

♦ Was acquired in February 2024 from the White Sox in a trade for OF Dominic Fletcher.

♦ In AA with BIR in 2023, he went 7-6 in 23 GS with a 4.66 ERA, 136 K, 55 BB in 114.0 IP.

INTERNATIONAL REPRESENTAION

♥ Signed with CHW as an international free agent from Pimentel, Dominican Republic on July 2nd, 2019 for \$250,000.

♦ In his first professional season (21'), he appeared in 13 games (12 starts) with ACL White Sox, 2021 went 1-4 with a 7.82 ERA and 62 K's.
