NOTES AND NUGGETS ROLLING IN THE DEEP

Despite just 3.0 innings from Mike Mayers yesterday Omahs tarting pitchers have combined to throw 137.0 innings this seasons, the 4th-most among International League teams, however the 6.70 ERA ranks as the worst in the 20-team league.

Omaha starters have thrown at least 5.0 innings in 17 of 30 games this season, including 15 of the last 17... in that 17 game stretch since April 18, the staff's 88.1 innings throw by Chasers starters are the most of any Minor League club (closest: Memphis Redbirds, 86.2 IP).

The last 17 games have featured five quality starts, from Mike Mayers (4/18 and 5/5), Jonathan Heasley (4/19), Austin Cox (4/27) and Drew Parrish (4/28).

While they're generally going deep into games, Omaha starters are receiving an average of 2.47 runs of support per start ... they're 8-5 when getting at least 3 runs of support and 4-13 when getting 2 or less, with 6 games of 0 run support for the starter.

HELLO, MY NAME IS

With their appearances in yesterday's ballgame, pitchers **Daniel Mengden** and **Jose Cuas** became the 36th and 37th players to suit up for Omaha this season.

Of the 37 players that have played for the Storm Chasers this season, 26 of them previous played for the team prior to this year (70%) ... starting today, pitcher **Daniel Lynch** becomes the latest to play for Omaha in 2023, also coming in with previous Storm Chasers experience (2021-22).

With 17 roster moves over six days this week, 29 different players have played in games this week for the Chasers, Lynch will become the 30th different player to face the Bats in this series.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

Omaha has gone 11-for-13 in stolen base attempts this week, including two steals in three attempts yesterday.

Omaha's 54 steals are tied second both in the International League and in Triple-A (tied with the Lehigh Valley IronPigs) but trailing 63 steals from the Worcester Red Sox ... they're tied ninth in the Minors in steals.

16 steals for Samad Taylor and Dairon Blanco rank tied 2nd in the International League and among all Triple-A basestealers, while tied 5th among all Minor League players in steals, trailing the MiLB leader with 21, Victor Scott II of the Peoria Chiefs (Cardinals High-A).

COMEBACK KIDS

Yesterday's 11-9 win marked the **EIGHTH** come-from-behind win of the season, coming back from a season-best six-run deficit to win the game.

Down 7-1 in the middle of the 4th inning, the Chasers scored five runs in the 5th inning, then tied the game with 2 runs in the 7th and scored 2 in the 8th to lead for the first time in the game ... other comebacks this season include:

MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Frame He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.

- **pane Johnson** enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- g He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).

- **Bijan Rademacher** (bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.

- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- g Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.
