**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** The Vancouver Canadians had the rug pulled out from under them in a 4-3 loss against the Eugene Emeralds (Giants) Tuesday night at PK Park, as the C's game-tying rally was cut short after it was deemed a runner didn't touch third base.

Trailing 4-1 to begin the ninth, the C's started their comeback with a one-out solo shot from Luis De Los Santos. Ryan Gold walked before DJ Neal beat out an infield single. After a line out and a throwing error moved runners to second and third, up stepped Rafael Lantigua. The Puerto Plata, DR native laced a double down the first base line that seemed to score two runs to tie the game, but Eugene appealed to third base thinking the second runner didn't touch the bag. Despite inconclusive evidence, the umpires determined that the runner did not touch the bag and the game ended on the arbiter's ruling.

The ninth inning rally was a bright spot in a game otherwise controlled by the Emeralds. Eugene took an early 1-0 lead in the first inning after starter Brian Rapp (L, 1-0) gave up consecutive two-out hits while their starter Kai-Wei Teng (W, 2-2) baffled the Canadians offense for six shutout innings in which he scattered three hits, walked two and struck out nine.

Rapp - who signed with Toronto yesterday after playing in the independent Frontier League - was otherwise solid in his system debut. The right-hander worked five innings in which he allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts.

After Eugene added a run in the fourth to go up 2-0, the C's finally broke through with a run in the top of the seventh. A one-out double from Gold set up Eric Rivera, who laced a single to centerfield that cut the deficit in half. Eugene got two in the bottom of the inning on three hits - including a solo home run - that gave them a 4-1 lead.

**THE EMERALDS CITY:** Vancouver arrives at PK Park this week for their first and only visit to Central Oregon. These two teams last met June 1-6 at Ron Tonkin Field when the Emeralds took four of six from the C's, when the Giants affiliate outscored the Canadians 38-29.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY:** June 23, 2011 - Vancouver used 13 hits and worked around four errors to beat Everett 9-3 at Everett Memorial Stadium. Shane Optiz drove in a pair and scored once as part of a 4-for-4 night, Steve McQuail went 3-for-5 with a homer and Bryan Longpre struck out four over two innings of perfect relief to earn the win as the C's improved to 5-2 on the season.

**CLOSE, BUT NO C'S-GAR** - Last night was the 12<sup>th</sup> time Vancouver played a game decided by a single run. The Canadians are 7-4 in those contests.

**OMAHA** - Two C's - Phil Clarke (Vanderbilt) and Tanner Morris (Virginia) - have alma maters playing in the College World Series this week. Parker Caracci's former team (Ole Miss) was bounced in the Tucson Super Regional while Sam Ryan (VCU), Sean Wymer (TCU) Cobi Jonson & CJ Van Eyk (Florida State), Brandon Eisert (Oregon State) and Sean Mellen (Northeastern) all saw their former clubs lose in their respective regionals.

**RAFA IS RAKING:** Infielder Rafael Lantigua is in the midst of his hottest stretch at the plate this season. In his last five games, he's 8-for-20 (.400) with two home runs, a triple, a double, five RBI and four runs scored. Lantigua has a hit in seven of eight games this month.

**ON THE HILL:** #10 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) CJ Van Eyk takes the ball tonight for Vancouver looking for his third consecutive win. In his last turn on June 16 against Everett, the right-hander limited the Sox to one run on three hits with two walks and seven strikeouts. He last faced the Emeralds on June 2, when he went five frames in which he allowed three runs on five hits but did not factor into the decision.

Right-hander Taylor Rashi goes for Eugene in what will be his first start of the year after making 11 appearances in relief. He last faced the C's on June 4 in Hillsboro when worked two innings of relief and gave up three runs (one earned) on two hits with no walks, a hit batter and three strikeouts. Rashi, 25, was a 23<sup>rd</sup> round pick (686 overall) in 2019 out of UC-Irvine.
