KEYBER RODRIGUEZ HITS GO-AHEAD GRAND SLAM IN 8-5 WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders defeated the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 8-5 on Thursday evening from Arvest Ballpark. Northwest Arkansas (25-28, 60-62) opened the scoring against Frisco (31-23, 75-48) starter **Mitch Bratt**. After a one-out error, Josh Lester belted a two-run homer to left to help the Naturals to a 2-0 lead in the first inning for the second consecutive night. In the home half of the second inning, Jack Pineda delivered a two-run double to extend the Naturals lead to 4-0. The Riders found the run column in the top of the fourth inning. **Cody Freeman** mashed a leadoff double before scoring on an RBI single by **Abimelec Ortiz**. **Luis Mieses** made it a 4-2 game, driving in Ortiz with a single to left. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his first two innings Bratt settled in to spin 6.0 innings, surrendering just the three earned runs on five hits and two walks while fanning five. The Naturals extended their lead in the bottom of the seventh on an RBI groundout by Tyler Tolbert against **Ricky DeVito** (4-0). Trailing 5-3 in the top of the eighth inning, **Keyber Rodriguez** mashed a go-ahead grand slam against Anderson Paulino. Two batters later **Alejandro Osuna** added a 403-foot solo homer to give Frisco a 7-5 lead and make it three consecutive multi-hit games for the lefty. **Seth Clark** worked a scoreless bottom of the eighth, allowing a leadoff single before getting out of the inning with a double play and a groundout. Ortiz padded the Riders lead with an RBI single in the top of the ninth, plating Freeman to push the lead to 8-5. **Skylar Hales** worked a scoreless ninth inning with a strikeout, extending the Riders winning streak to four games with his third save of the season. Offensively, Frisco logged 12 hits as Mieses led the charge with three. Osuna, Freeman and Ortiz each collected two hits and Rodriguez paced the team with four RBI.

THOSE ROUGHRIDERS ARE SO HOT RIGHT NOW:

The RoughRiders have been playing well recently, winning seven of their last eight games. In the eight games, Frisco is first in the Texas League in runs per game (6.6) and OBP (.371) while hitting 11 home runs in the eight games. Frisco is now 13-12 in August and have a chance to have a winning month in every month of the season for the first time in franchise history.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz has been on fire for the RoughRiders recently. Over his last 35 games, Ortiz is hitting .328/.425/.565/.990 with seven doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBIs, 27 runs scored and 21 walks. Ortiz has reached in 16 games in a row, batting .421 (24-for-57)/.542/.737/1.279 with three doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, 14 walks, 14 strikeouts and 17 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. Since, he is hitting .309 with an .923 OPS, raising his batting average to .235 and a .719 OPS.

DOUBLE-A RON TAKING DOUBLE-A:

Aaron Zavala has been swinging the bat well as of late, hitting in eight games in a row. Over that streak, he is batting .414 (12-for-29)/.471/.483/.954 with two doubles and 11 RBIs. Over his last 24 games, he is hitting .282/.380/.353/.733 in August.

HOMER HAPPY:

On August 16th, the Riders hit a season-high four home runs with **Luis Mieses** capping the night with his second for a walk-off home run. It was Mieses's third multi-home run game of his career. The RoughRiders have hit 17 home runs in the last 12 games, with those 15 home runs being tied for second in the Texas League over the last 12 games. Frisco is still just seventh in the Texas League in home runs this season with 91 across their 121 games (on pace for 104, which would be for the fifth-fewest in the 21 seasons of the franchise).

HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 40-22 at Riders Field this season. At home this season, Frisco has a +69 run differential, a 4.12 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .763 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 35-26 with a 3.23 ERA, but a +30 run differential while averaging 4.0 runs per game and owning a .652 OPS (9th in the league). **Cody Freeman** has 10 of his 14 home runs at home while **Abimelec Ortiz** has hit 10 of his 13 homers at Riders Field. Ortiz is batting .314/.406/.543/.949 at home as opposed to .152/.223/.247/.470 on the road.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current Rough Riders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the Rough Riders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MLB experience.

2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the Rough Riders starting rotation.

-Became the first Rough Riders pitcher to complete a quality start on 4/14/24 against Corpus Christi.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among Rough Riders starting pitchers.

-Three fourth scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14-2 consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
