THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On May 11, 1978, Tommy Sohns hits the first home run by a Sounds player in Greer Stadium history. Not much power in the first season as Nashville only had 38 home runs the entire season, where the 2019 Sounds have recorded 37 home runs through their first 34 games.

Today's Game: The Nashville Sounds host the Memphis Redbirds tonight in their first home game of the 2021 campaign. Nashville is coming off three straight wins while Memphis has lost five of their first six games. Right-hander Thomas Jankins makes his second start for the Sounds against right-hander Miles Mikolas for the Redbirds.

Thomas Jankins: 25-year-old Thomas Jankins starts for the Sounds in tonight's game. The right-hander is making his second start of the 2021 season. He worked a no decision on May 5 at Toledo and gave up six runs on six hits in 4.0 innings. In 2019, Jankins went 11-5 with a 4.19 ERA in 25 games (23 starts) with Triple-A San Antonio and Double-A Biloxi. Jankins finished tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League for wins (10), logged 10 quality starts and four starts of 6+ IP and one or less runs allowed. In his 2019 debut, he tossed the only complete game of his career on April 7 vs. Birmingham. The Massachusetts native was named a Southern League All-Star in 2018 after he went 10-9 with a 4.42 ERA with Double-A Biloxi. The Brewers drafted Jankins in the 13th round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

Miles Mikolas: 32-year-old Miles Mikolas starts for the Redbirds tonight. He makes his second rehab start of the season after getting the ball for Memphis on May 5 against Durham. Mikolas surrendered two runs on five hits in 2.1 innings pitched. He missed the 2020 season after undergoing surgery to repair a flexor tendon in his right arm. He was selected to represent St. Louis in the 2018 All-Star game and finished 6th in the National League Cy Young Award voting. The Florida native was selected by the San Diego Padres in the 7th round of the 2009 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 0, Second: 0, Third: 1, Fourth: 4, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Home Opener History: The Sounds have a 12-8 record all-time in home openers. The team opened the 2019 season at First Horizon Park and suffered a 5-4 setback to Iowa. In First Horizon Park history, the Sounds are 3-2 in home openers. They walked off with a 3-2 win over Colorado Springs in the inaugural game in 2015, lost to Oklahoma City, 5-0, in 2016, topped Oklahoma City, 3-1, in 2017 and blanked the Iowa Cubs, 7-0, in 2018.

Power Surge: Nashville's powerful swing continued in Saturday night's 6-1 win with another three home runs (Luis Castro, Zach Green, Weston Wilson). Through the first five games of the season, the Sounds have clubbed 12 home runs, good for fourth-most in the Triple-A East. 10 different Sounds have homered, led by Corey Ray and Green with two apiece.

Early and Often: In each of the five games of the opening series, Nashville both scored first against Toledo and out-hit them. Collectively, Nashville out-hit Toledo, 43-28 during the five-game series.

Not Hit City: Nashville pitchers limited Toledo hitters to just a .189 batting average (28-for-148) through the first five games. That's tied for the second-best opponent batting average in the Triple-A East League behind Iowa (.153).

Start the Streaks: Three Sounds have modest hitting streaks of four games - Dee Strange-Gordon, Zach Green and Jamie Westbrook have all hit safely in four straight. Green has picked up six RBI in his first five games.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

There's History Here: The Sounds enjoyed 10 years as the Brewers' top affiliate from 2005-14. The 2005 season culminated with the Sounds winning the Pacific Coast League Championship - the City of Nashville's most recent championship in any sport. Nashville compiled a 723-713 (.503) record during the 10-year stretch and made three consecutive postseason berths from 2005-07. In 2007, the Sounds won 89 games, the second-most in franchise history (97 in 1980).

Top Prospects: Nashville opened the 2021 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 5 prospect, left-handed pitcher Aaron Ashby is the No. 7 prospect, outfielder Corey Ray is the No. 24 prospect and left-handed pitcher Clayton Andrews is the No. 25 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,034-1,923. The 2,034 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

That Doesn't Hurt So Bad: The Sounds have four Major League rehabbers on the roster. Right-hander Josh Lindblom (April 24 - right knee effusion), outfielder Derek Fisher (April 1 - strained left hamstring), infielder/outfielder Jace Peterson (April 23 - cryotherapy on left thumb) and infielder/outfielder Tim Lopes (March 8 - right oblique) are all on the current roster.
