On The Road Again

The Fightin Phils continue a two-week road trip on Tuesday night at the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 13th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and fourth-of-nine at TD Bank Ballpark. The season-series is tied 6-6.

Binghamton Blues

The Fightin Phils fell 2-1 in 10 innings at Binghamton Sunday and ultimately dropped five-of-six at Mirabito Stadium last week. Eiberson Castellano shined again on the mound, striking out 11 over six innings pitched, while allowing just one run on a solo home run. Andrew Walling (1 IP) and Daniel Harper (2 IP) each kept the Rumble Ponies off the board in relief. Andrick Nava drove in Reading's only run of the day, scoring Robert Moore on a single in the fifth. Andrew Schultz suffered the loss after allowing the inherited runner to score in the bottom of the 10th. It was the second walk-off loss of the week at Binghamton.

Racking Up Strikeouts

Moises Chace and Eiberson Castellano each turned in impressive starts on the mound on Saturday and Sunday, respecitvely. Chace struck out a career-high 10 hitters on Saturday night over 4.2 innings pitched. Castellano struck out 11 hitters the following night, Sunday, at Binghamton. It was the second-stragiht start Castellano punched out double-digit batters, as he did so on Aug. 18 vs New Hampshire. Castellano's 11 strikeouts match a Reading-season high for the third time. It was the fourth game this season where Castellano had over 10 strikeouts, and second time with the Fightin Phils.

Strong Starter

Last week was a strong week for Fightin Phils' starting pitchers. The group allowed 12 earned runs over 30.2 innings for the week, which is a 3.52 ERA. The Fightin Phils remain 12th in the Eastern League in starter ERA at 4.80, but it's a mark that has gradually improved the last few weeks. On August 1, Reading's starting piktchers had an ERA of 5.25, so it has dropped 0.45 runs over the last four weeks.

Crawford Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford has continued to look strong at the top of the Fightin Phils lineup since his Double-A debut on July 19. Through 26 games with Reading, Crawford is slashing .312/.356/.413, with a .769 OPS. He's added 17 runs, eight doubles, one home run and 17 RBI. Crawford is also 10-11 in stolen bases so far with the R-Phils. Crawford currently owns 10 multi-hit games, with five of them being three-hit games. Most recently, he had three hits and a Double-A high three runs scored last Saturday at Binghamton. Since his Reading debut, Crawford is third in the Eastern League in average, third in hits and tied for third in stolen bases.

Swiper Yes Swiping

The Fightin Phils enter Tuesday night's game in fifth place in the Eastern League with 130 stolen bases on the season. That mark passes last season's total of 119, which ranked 10th in the Eastern League. Reading is on pace to finsih this season with 150 stolen bases on the season. Since the All-Star Break, Reading is tied for third in the Eastern League with 45 stolen bases. That has coincided with the debut of Justin Crawford and return of Gabriel Rincones Jr., who each own 10 and 11 stolen bases, respectively, over that stretch. The R-Phils 130 stolen bases is their most in a season since swiping 130 in 2010. The next-best mark was 145 back in 2003.

Going Going Gone

This week's series matches up the two teams with the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. Somerset is in first place with 130 home runs and Reading sits in second with 124 long balls.

Sup Somerse

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 29-20 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took four-of-six at Portland. Following this week, Somerset goes to Binghamton. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (6), Brock Selvidge (7), Zach Messinger (17), Cam Schlittler (25), Trystan Vrieling (28) and Rafael Flores (30).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty, and Yankees' No. 28 Prospect, Trystan Vrieling makes the start tonight for Somerset. Across 23 games/21 starts this season, Vrieling is 10-7, with a 4.82 ERA (125 IP, 120 H, 41 BB, 114 SO). He last pitched Aug. 20 at Portland and earned the win with six no-not and scoreless innings, while striking out three. This season against Reading, Vrieling is 0-1, while allowing four-earned runs on nine hits over 8.1 innings, with nine strikeouts and one walk. This is Vrieling's first professional season as he was drafted by the Yankees in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Gonazaga and didn't pitch in 2022 or '23 with a stress fracture in his right elbow. He did pitch for Mesa in the Arizona Fall League last year, going 0-1, with a 5.06 ERA over five starts. He pitched for Gonaza from 2020-22.
