Resetting the Record Books... The Bowling Green Hot Rods are up to a franchise-record 268 stolen bases this season. The 268 steals surpasses the 2024 Hot Rods squad, who stole 262 bases. Nine different players have logged 20-plus steal seasons for Bowling Green this season.

Dominic Dominance... LHP Dominic Niman opens Saturday's game on the mound. The former Kentucky Wildcat holds a 3.40 ERA across 39.2 innings pitched at Bowling Green Ballpark this season. Niman matched a career-high 7.0 innings pitched in his last start versus the Frederick Keys.

Run, Tony, Run!... Infielder Tony Santa Maria leads the 2026 South Atlantic League with 47 stolen bases. That moniker ties 2024 Hot Rods player Adrian Santana for fourth-most single-season steals in franchise history. Third-most is held by 2012's Ryan Brett, who added 48 swipes.

Cermak Attack... Outfielder Ryan Cermak blasted his second home run in as many games on Friday night in a 6-2 loss to the Greensboro Grasshoppers. Cermak also logged a two-run home run in Thursday's 11-2 win. The 24-year-old leads all Hot Rods players with 13 runs scored and eight stolen bases since rejoining the team on August 4.

Setting the (Ay)Bar High... Nicandro Aybar has reached base in all 17 games with Bowling Green following a promotion from the Charleston RiverDogs on July 19. The 21-year-old has torched Greensboro in particular, hitting 13-for-27 (.481 AVG) with six RBI in seven games.

Summer Thrill... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill has posted four hits and four runs driven in during this series with Greensboro. The Tampa Bay Rays' No. 28 prospect has hit in all six games since earning his callup, batting 8-for-17 (.471 AVG) with a home run and six RBI in five games.

Flew Takes Flight... Nathan Flewelling belted his 21st home run of the season Tuesday night. Flewelling tied 2018 Bowling Green backstop Ronaldo Hernandez for the most single-season home runs by a catcher in franchise history.
