LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox fell 4-0 to the Harrisburg Senators on Wednesday night. Bowie tallied just four hits on the evening, and saw Harrisburg take a 2-0 lead in the fourth on a two-run home run from Brady House against right-handed starter **Cameron Weston** who took the loss. Dylan Crews singled home two more runs in the fifth. Harrisburg's Brad Lord totaled seven shutout innings. Bowie's **Nick Richmond** and **Houston Roth** each posted a scoreless frame.

BASALLO BITS

During his team-high 19-game on-base streak, C/1B **Samuel Basallo** is hitting .356 (5th EL) with a 1.050 OPS. Basallo's five home runs during that stretch are fifth-most in the league. The 19-year-old is the youngest player in the Eastern League this season. He currently has the fourth-most hits (62) and fifth-most home runs (10) of all qualified players. Basallo's on-base streak is tied with Portland's Blaze Jordan for the longest active streak in the league and the fourth-longest overall this season.

TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot Friday night, **Samuel Basallo** became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 43 of 49 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.369) and leads the team in walks (30), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Tuesday was the ninth time Beavers reached base at least three times in a game this season.

TERRY TWO BAGS

Baysox RF/1B **TT Bowens** hit his team-leading 15th double of the season on Saturday night - tying him for the third-most in the Eastern League this season. Bowens has been a clutch bat for Bowie, leading the team with 34 RBI and hitting a team-best .308 with runners in scoring position.

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (281.1) and strikeouts (326). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.19 WHIP, which is good for fourth-lowest in Double-A.

HITTING IN BUNCHES

Bowie's **Jud Fabian** tallied three hits on Tuesday night. It marked the fifth game of at least three hits for Fabian on the season - the most on the team. Fabian also has both four-hit performances from the Baysox this season. Fabian's tenth home run of the season on Tuesday tied him with Samuel Basallo for the team lead and fifth-most in the league.

SCOUTING THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators sit at 32-25 on the season - tied for second in the Eastern League Southwest division and just a game out of first place. Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators are led by second-year manager and former Baysox player (1999) Delino DeShields. Harrisburg's roster includes four of the Nationals' top 8 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Dylan Crews (WSH No. 2/MLB No. 6), IF Brady House (WSH No. 3/MLB No. 36), IF Yohandy Morales (WSH No. 4/MLB No. 88), and OF Robert Hassell III (WSH No. 8).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Kyle Luckham gets the ball tonight for Harrisburg. A 15th round pick of the Nationals in 2022 out of Arizona State, Luckham has started 11 games at Double-A so far this season, after making his debut for the Senators at the end of 2023 against the Baysox. Luckham allowed four runs and eight hits through five innings that day, including two hits and 3 RBI to **Jud Fabian**. Luckham has allowed 10 hits and six earned runs in two of his last three starts. He's allowed the second-most hits (67) in the league this season.

1997

June 13, 1997 - Bryan Bogle laced a go-ahead, three-run home run in the ninth to help clinch a comeback 6-5 win for Bowie over Akron. Position player Chris Kirgan, who made five appearances on the mound that season, in addition to 139 games at first base, was the winning pitcher.

Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC. Baysox are 4-7 when Bright starts but have lost last four in a row. Recorded first career Double-A win in last meeting at HBG on 9/13/23 with 4.0 IP in relief with 4 K. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager
The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.
