NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 12 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 2 ... the Storm Chasers have a 10-18 record over their last 28 games.
 - Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
 - The Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days this season at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

The Storm Chasers have 21 comeback wins this season, while Omaha also has blown a lead in 23 losses.

- 21 comeback wins are tied for the 4th-most in the International League, tied 7th in Triple-A ... 23 blown leads are tied for the 3rd-most in the league, tied 5th in Triple-A.
- The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 11 of their last 18 losses, including 3 games where the team led for over half the game.
- In the last 43 games (since May 9), Omaha is 20-23 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 14 of 20 wins and led at some point in 13 of 23 losses, meaning 27 of Omaha's last 43 games have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... In this stretch, 31 of 43 games have been decided by 3 runs or less ... Omaha's 16 losses by 1 run are the 2nd-most in the International League.

YOU GO, WE GO, LUGO

Matthew Lugo has been one of Omaha's best hitters in June since joining the Storm Chasers at the start of the month.

- Since the Royals claimed Lugo off waivers from the Angels on June 2, he has hit .325 (25-for-77) with 14 extra-base hits and 21 RBI in 19 games.
- Lugo's 19 RBI in 16 games since June 9 are tied for the 4th-most in the IL.
- Lugo has hits in 14 of 19 games with Omaha – including an extra-base hit in 11 of 19 – and has reached base in 15 of 19 ... he's driven in a run in 10 of 19 games.

JUNE BUGS

Beyond the offensive success from Matthew Lugo, he's had good company in Omaha's lineup in the month of June.

- Abraham Toro has hits in 16 of his 20 games in June, batting .308 (24-for-78) with 4 doubles, 3 triples, 5 homers and 19 RBI for a .985 OPS.
- Peyton Wilson has hits in 15 of his 19 games this month, batting .316 (25-for-79) in June with 10 doubles, 7 RBI and 7 walks for an .815 OPS.
- Since rejoining Omaha on June 18, Brandon Drury has hits in all 7 games he's played, hitting .444 (12-for-27) with 4 doubles, 2 homers and 8 RBI for a 1.315 OPS ... he is 3rd among qualified IL hitters since June 18 in OPS and 4th in average.

HONEST ABE

Abraham Toro started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May

- Since May 12, Toro has a .314 average (38-for-121) ... he ranks 5th in the IL in SLG (.579) and 6th in OPS (.996) ... his 30 RBI over 33 games since May 12 are tied 5th-most in the league.
- From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit just .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 25 of 33 games.

SUMMER SWINGING

The Storm Chasers come to the end of June with one of the hottest offenses in the International League.

- Omaha's 87 extra-base hits in June lead the league while a .283 team batting average ranks 3rd and .477 slugging percentage ranks 4th and a .824 OPS is 5th ... Storm Chasers have scored 132 runs in June, 4th-most in the IL this month.
- Omaha has scored 6+ runs in 12 of 22 games in June, tied for the 2nd-most in the International League (1st: Rochester, 13) ... that comes from 11 games this month with double-digit hits, tied for the 2nd-most such games in the IL (1st: Charlotte, 13).

TODAY'S START

- ▶ Kris Bubic is making his **3rd start with the Storm Chasers** this year and his **12th overall appearance** this season.
- ▶ Bubic joins Omaha on a Major League rehab assignment ... he was placed on Kansas City's 15-day injured list on May 18, retroactive to May 15, with **left elbow soreness**.
- ▶ Playing his **9th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- ▶ This is Bubic's 5th career appearance against Columbus ... he threw a perfect 1st inning in his only frame of action in Wednesday's game against the Clippers.

BUBIC'S BEST

- ▶ **SHORT REST:** While Bubic pitched just 1.0 inning in his rehab start earlier in the series against the Clippers, this will be the first time since **2024** that the left-hander pitches on 3 days rest or less.
- ▶ **WORKING HIS WAY BACK:** Bubic was off to a strong start in the Majors before his injury this season, working a 3.50 ERA (18 ER in 46.1 IP) with 47 strikeouts in his first 8 starts, excluding his final appearance before injury ... That included an 11-strikeout gem against the White Sox on April 10 where he **WORKED 7.0** shutout innings allowing just 2 hits and 1 walk ... He is one of 23 pitchers in Major Leagues this year to have 11+ strikeouts in a game.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, JUNE 24 vs. COLUMBUS

- ▶ Made his 2nd appearance for the Storm Chasers this season, his 1st since he was initially sent to Omaha for a rehab assignment on June 9 ... threw just 1.0 inning and 8 pitches, but retired all 3 batters he saw, including a strikeout of **CJ Kayfus**.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Made the Royals Opening Day Roster for the 4th time in his career ... 4 of his first 7 starts with Kansas City were quality starts, including a 7.0-inning, 11-strikeout game on April 10 vs. Chicago (AL).
- ▶ Placed on the 15-day Injured List on May 18, retroactive to May 15 with left elbow soreness ... sent on a rehab assignment to Omaha on June 9 and made 1 start vs. Las Vegas (ATH) ... shut down for 2 weeks until being re-assigned on rehab to the Storm Chasers on June 24.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- ▶ Named a first-time All-Star, posting a 2.55 ERA with Kansas City that ranked 4th in the American League (min. 20 starts).
- ▶ Posted a career-high 8 wins across 20 starts and 116.1 innings with the Royals, his most since 2022, with a Major-league-low 0.46 HR/9 (min. 20 starts) and a career-best 32.0-inning homerless streak from May 13 to June 24.
- ▶ Owned a 1.43 ERA through 12 starts, the lowest such mark in franchise history and in the Majors at the time ... was named AL Pitcher of the Month for May, going 3-0 with an AL-best 0.56 ERA (2 ER in 32.1 IP) in 5 starts – the 3rd-best ERA in any month in Royals history (min. 5 starts).
- ▶ Placed on the Injured List on July 27 with a left rotator cuff strain, ending his season.

MAJOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Was limited to 46.1 regular season innings in the Majors from **2023-24** due to Tommy John Surgery ... was reinstated from the Injured List on July 6, **2024**, 447 days after he was placed on the IL.
- ▶ Made his MLB debut in 2020, after recording just 187.1 innings over 36 starts in the Minors, with no experience above the High-A level.
- ▶ In **2022**, tied **Daniel Lynch IV** for the team high with 27 starts, and for the second straight year he led the team in double plays induced (19) ... had a 13-start stretch from June 4 to August 10, **2022** in which he recorded a 3.59 ERA (29 ER in 72.2 IP), before going 0-7 over his next 7 starts.

MINOR LEAGUE HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Named the Wilmington Blue Rocks (A+) Pitcher of the Year in **2019**, going 11-5 with a 2.23 ERA (37 ER in 149.1 IP) in 26 starts, including his time with the Lexington Legends (A) ... was also named the Royals' Paul Splittorff Pitcher of the Year and an MiLB.com Organization All-Star.
