Leading Off

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils begin a six-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It's the second of four series between the teams this season with New Hampshire, holding the edge 4-2. The Fisher Cats came to Reading from May 9-14 and return from Aug. 29 to Sept. 3. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from Aug. 8 to 13.

Some Firsts in a Win

On Sunday, Reading won its third-straight game to earn a series-split with Harrisburg. The R-Phils pitched it's first nine-inning shutout of the season and first as a team since Sept. 9, 2022. Nick Podkul stayed red-hot with another home run and Johan Rojas hit two homers, the first time an R-Phil has done that this season and first since Wendell Rijo on July 14, 2022. Reading preceeded Sunday's win with back-to-back walk offs.

No Donuts for the Fightins

R-Phils.

Through 44 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-11 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching earned its first shutout of the season Sunday.

A Look at the Bullpen

This weekend, Reading's bullpen was lights out. From Friday to Sunday, the bullpen allowed three earned runs in 12.1 innings pitched, which is good for a 2.19 ERA. In wins this season, the R-Phils bullpen has a 2.42 ERA, but it balloons to 7.56 in losses.

Home Run Merchants

Reading continues to pile on home runs as of late. The Fightin Phils have hit home runs in eight-straight games, having 14 home runs over that span, which leads the Eastern League since May 20. Reading now sits with 51 home runs on the season, which is third in the Eastern League and just six behind first-place Somerset. Nick Podkul, who also owns a 16-game on-base streak, had three home runs last week, including back-toback games. To add, Johan Rojas hit two home runs Sunday, the first time an R-Phils has hit multiple home runs in a game this season.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies ended up splitting a four-game series at Atlanta after a loss Sunday and begins a series at the New York Mets tonight. Lehigh Valley begins another series at home against Scranton-Wilkes/Barre after taking four-of-six against Buffalo last week. Jersey Shore begins an eight game series with Brooklyn at home this week, featuring two doubleheaders, after 5-2 week at Aberdeen. Finally, Clearwater returns home to open a series with Dunedin after dropping four-of-six at St. Lucie last week, the first series loss of the season for the 31-13 Threshers.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 30, 2015: At Reading, top Phillies prospect J.P. Crawford goes 1-for-4 with an RBI in his Baseballtown debut. The Fightin Phils beat Richmond, 4-3, scoring the winning run on Gabriel Lino's sacrifice fly that plates Aaron Altherr in the bottom of the 8th.

A Look at New Hampshire

This is the second meeting between these teams in the span of just 16 days. The Fisher Cats are 22-22 and tied for third in the Northeast Division, four games ahead of Reading. Last week, New Hampshire 2-4 at Portland, winning the final two games of the series. Up next, New Hampshire returns home for a six-game series against Reading's last opponent, Harrisburg.

Fisher Cat Starter

Righty Andrew Bash will get the start tonight for New Hampshire. It will be Bash's 12th game, but first start of the season. Overall, he is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA. Across 16.2 innings pitched, Bash has allowed 17 hits, 12 walks and has 19 strikeouts. In two games at Reading, he went 1-0 over 4.1 innings, allowing seven hits and two runs. He last pitched 0.1 innings Saturday at Portland.

Phillies Number Three Prosepct. Started season on injured list.McGarry has been a prospect since his high school days, when he was a late-round pick of the Rangers before honoring his commitment to Virginia. With the Cavaliers, he showed off his premium arm strength as well as a lack of familiarity with the strike zone, making him an intriguing, yet enigmatic college arm in 2021. The Phillies thought McGarry's stuff was worth taking in the fifth round, and he pitched his way from High-A to Triple-A in his first full season of pro ball. If you're just evaluating pure stuff, McGarry could be considered one of the better pitching prospects in the game. He's flirted with 100 mph in the past and was up to 99 mph at the upper levels in 2022, averaging over 95 mph. It's an elite pitch not just because of velocity, but because of his vertical approach angle as well. His mid-80s slider can be plus at times, missing a ton of bats, and he fools hitters with an upper-70s curve too. He doesn't throw his changeup nearly as much as the breaking stuff, but it has characteristics of a plus pitch. He added a hard cutter at the end of last year to give him a potential five-pitch mix. How often McGarry can land his elite-level stuff in the strike zone will determine exactly what he can be in the big leagues. A 13.9 K/9 rate to start off his pro career shows he can fool pro hitters, but even with some improvements since joining the Phillies, he's walked 5.4 per nine entering 2023. There's hope that as he adds mass to his loose 6-foot-2 frame, he can keep refining his delivery and throw enough strikes to start, a role he'll continue for now unless there's a need as a reliever in Philadelphia.
