Seeing the SeaWolves: The Somerset Patriots host the Erie SeaWolves for the final game of a sixgame series tonight. The Patriots have taken three of the first five. The SeaWolves enter today's contest tied with Bowie for second in the Southwest Division, 0.5 games behind Akron, and boast two top 10 MLB prospects according to Baseball America: Spencer Torkelson (No. 5), Riley Green (No. 9).

Here's Oswaldo: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera hit the Patriot's first grand slam of the season in game one Friday night (first since 5/14/19 Edwin Espinal). Cabrera has homered in three of his last five games and in game one of Wednesday's doubleheader, matched a career-high in both home runs (2) and RBI (5). Additionally, he became the first Patriot this season to hit a home run as both a left-hand ed and right-handed batter in the same game. He leads the team with 38 RBI and 27 extra base hits.

Ottomatic: RHP Glenn Otto struck out eight over six scoreless innings last night. The reigning Double-A Northeast League pitcher of the week has now worked 13.0 consecutive scoreless innings with five hits, no walks and 20 strikeouts in his last two starts. The right-hander leads all Double-A pitchers with 103 strikeouts and is tied with Harrisburg's Cade Cavalli for the most overall strikeouts by a pitcher in all of Minor League Baseball.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff has the lowest ERA (2.96) among all of Minor League Baseball (full season), along with the lowest WHIP (1.13) and second-lowest batting average against (.204). The Patriots trail the Yankees' High-A Affiliate Hudson Valley (.199) in BAA.

Shutouts on Shutouts: Somerset tossed it's 10 shutout of the season last night, most among all Minor League Baseball teams. It marked the fourth shutout for the Patriots over their last eight days. The team has a 2.01 ERA over this stretch with 84 strikeouts and a 1.01 WHIP across 67.0 innings pitched.

Go, Diego! Go!: Infielder Diego Castillo hit his 11th home run of the season on Wednesday. His season total has already surpassed his career total (8) entering the 2021 season. He also went 2-for-4 with a pair of doubles last night and is 6-for-16 (.375) with a .444 OBP this series. Since shifting to the leadoff spot on June 22nd, Castillo has hit .343 (23-for-67) with five home runs, nine doubles, nine runs, 10 RBI, and a .397 OBP over 17 games. The Venezuelan infielder currently leads the league in OPS (.999) and ranks second in both slugging (.617) and batting (.331).

Gill-I-Am: Outfielder Isiah Gilliam has reached base safely in 17 of his last 18 games. Gilliam is hitting .354 (17-for-48) with two home runs, seven runs, 11 RBI, 13 walks, and a .484 OBP over this stretch. The outfielder has raised his batting average 43 points from .196 to .239 in this period.

Post Milone: Outfielder Thomas Milone has reached base in 25-straight games dating back to May 11th, the longest such streak for the team this year. Milone is hitting .301 (25-for-83) over this streak with four home runs, 10 RBI, 14 runs and a .375 OBP.

Saturdays Are For the Boys: The pitching staff has shined on Saturday's this season carrying a 2.00 ERA, the lowest of any day of the week. The team is 9-3 on Saturday's, the most wins of any day.

More Marinaccio: RHP Ron Marinaccio has not allowed a run over his last seven appearances, spanning 12.0 innings of work. He's allowed just two hits and five walks while striking out 18 over this stretch. He's also recorded a pair of saves and has lowered his ERA from 3.60 to 2.00 this year.
