Jersey Shore BlueClaws (2-10/28-49) vs Rome Emperors (5-7/38-38)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001)

RHP Ramon Marquez (0-0, 2.70) vs RHP Cade Kuehler (6-3, 5.68)

Game 4 of 6 (Rome leads season series 5-4 of 12)

Last Game Recap... Mason Guerra finished a triple shy of the cycle and Rome topped the BlueClaws 8-4 on Thursday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...Rome hit three home runs, one by Guerra, Owen Carey, and Dixon Williams...Williams' shot was a three run blast in the top of the first inning off Luke Gabrysh, who exited after recording two outs...Zach Royse gave up one run in 5.2 innings to earn his first High-A win...Carter Mathison homered for Jersey Shore.

State of the BlueClaws...The BlueClaws have dropped six in a row (matching their longest losing streak of the season – June 4th thru 10th vs Brooklyn/at Hudson Valley) and are 2-10 to start the second half...They have scored eight runs in their last five games, including one each in four games Saturday thru Wednesday.

Hello Rome...Rome comes north to ShoreTown Ballpark for a six game series...The BlueClaws took four of six from the Braves in April at AventHealth Stadium in Georgia...Their only previous series as High-A rivals came in 2023 when the BlueClaws took four of six at ShoreTown Ballpark...Rome beat the BlueClaws 3-1 in the 2016 SAL Championship Series with a team that includes Max Fried, Kolby Allard, Austin Riley, Ronald Acuna, and Mike Soroka.

Carter Booming...Carter Mathison homered on Thursday night, his sixth home run of the year, five of which have come at ShoreTown Ballpark...Four of his home runs have come since June 16th...His home run June 26th at Brooklyn was his first that did not come at ShoreTown Ballpark...Mathison hit seven with Clearwater last year...He also has 17 stolen bases this year and is 34-36 in his career...Mathison was a 5th round pick in 2024 from Indiana University...There, he became one of three Hoosiers to hit 40 home runs in his first three collegiate seasons (Kyle Schwarber and Alex Dickerson).

The First...The BlueClaws have scored 19 runs in the first inning across their 77 games this season...This is the fewest in the first inning of any team in Minor League Baseball (Jupiter, Low-A Marlins is next at 23...St. Paul, AAA Twins is first at 82)...The BlueClaws have scored in the first inning 14 times in their 77 games, have done so twice since May 30th (June 7th and June 13th)...They enter today having not scored in the first inning in their last 16 games.

A Familiar Team...BlueClaws manager Mycal Jones played 53 games for Rome in 2010 and hit .261 with six home runs, his first full year after being taken in the fourth round by the Braves in 2009...He was promoted to High-A Myrtle Beach that June.

Heating Up...Jake Eddington is heating up out of the bullpen for Jersey Shore...The right-hander has allowed just two earned runs in his last 10.2 innings (both on 6/26 at Brooklyn), with seven strikeouts in that stretch...Before the current run, he gave up seven runs in his first 14.2 innings this season...Eddington was a 7th round pick in the 2023 draft out of Missouri State, the same alma mater of Ryan Howard (though when Howard played there it was known as Southwest Missouri State).

Staying Salti...Devin Saltiban has three home runs since Father's Day, giving him four on the season (he hit two in Brooklyn last week after he hit his first home run on May 8th at Frederick)...Since June 14th, Saltiban is 16-49 with four doubles and three home runs, while adding three stolen bases...The 21 year old now has 29 career home runs, 17 of which came with Clearwater in 2024 and five of which came in 66 games with the BlueClaws last year...He was a 3rd round pick in 2023 from Hilo High School in Hawaii.

Daunte's First...Daunte Stuart, who had two hits on Tuesday, hit his first affiliated home run on June 26th in Brooklyn (he had 19 over three years in three different independent leagues)...Stuart began the year with the New Jersey Jackals in the Frontier League and signed with the Phillies on June 18th...He played last year for the Lake Country Dockhounds (Oconomowoc, Wisconsin) in the American Association and the Oakland Ballers of the Pioneer League in 2024...He finished his collegiate career at Memphis after beginning it at Northwestern State in Louisiana...Stuart was born in the Bahamas and moved to Texas at the age of 14.

Stay Hot Tyler...3B Tyler Pettorini two two-hit games in Brooklyn last week... Pettorini is 17-65 in his last 16 games with six doubles and his first two professional home runs...He hit a two run walk off home run on Father's Day, his second career home run (June 13th at Hudson Valley) and the third by the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate (Felix Reyes on 9/3/23 vs Aberdeen and Kehden Hettiger on 5/6/25 vs Aberdeen)...Pettorini joined the BlueClaws on May 26th from Clearwater, where he was hitting .179 in 35 games with 13 stolen bases...He was a four year player at Ohio State and signed with the Phillies after the draft last year.

Getting Biddy With It...Nick Biddison is 17-69 since June 5th...He went 1-3 on Tuesday and had three 2-hit games on the last homestand...He hit his second home run of the season in the win on June 17th, a three run shot, and drove in four runs (the third time in his career he drove in four in a game, the other two coming in 2022 with Rancho Cucamonga in the Dodgers system)...He has played five games in right field (the first was June 24th in Brooklyn), his first time in the outfield with the Phillies...Biddison did play 106 games in the outfield in the Dodgers system before coming to the Phillies in June of 2025.

Two for B-Lew...Brandon Lewis had his first two-hit game with the BlueClaws on June 25th in Brooklyn, going 2-5 with two RBIs in the win at Brooklyn...Lewis joined the BlueClaws on June 18th from York in the Atlantic League, where he was hitting .347 with 19 home runs and 59 RBIs, leading the league in home runs, RBIs, slugging percentage (.776), runs (47), and total bases (132)...Originally a 4th round pick of the Dodgers in 2019 (UC-Irvine), he hit 40 Double-A home runs with Tulsa (2022-24).

Run Run BlueClaws...The BlueClaws are 26-30 stealing bases since June 17th (the second game of last week's series with Greenville)...Daunte Stuart had three stolen bases on June 23rd at Brooklyn and is 6-6 with Jersey Shore...Nick Biddison had five last week against Greenville while Devin Saltiban had three (four in the current stretch, 18 on the season)... Luis Caicutto, Carter Mathison, and Trent Farquhar had two apiece (Caicutto has three in the current stretch).

Number One for Kodey Sho...Kodey Shojinaga hit his first BlueClaws home run on June 23rd at Brooklyn, the second home run of his career...He had two multi-hit games last week and had two more on Wednesday...He is now 24-83 since May 24th, with six multi-hit games in that stretch...Shojinaga drew four walks on May 29th, tying a BlueClaws single-game record with seven others (Keaton Anthony matched him on May 31st)...Luke Davis did it on 4/17/25 at Greensboro...Shojinaga has 30 walks in 192 plate appearances this year and had 49 in 341 last year...Shojinaga was a 6th round pick in 2024 from the University of Kansas.

Going Deep...BlueClaws starters have thrown six innings in a game nine times this year – once by Sam Highfill on June 9th at Hudson Valley, five by Reese Dutton (including June 13th at Hudson Valley) and three by Ryan Dromboski (including May 26th vs Frederick)...The last BlueClaw to throw seven innings in a game was Braydon Tucker on September 7, 2024 at Aberdeen.

Tuesday Blues...After winning the first three series openers (April 3rd at Wilmington, April 7th vs Brooklyn, April 14th at Rome), the BlueClaws have dropped their last 11 (including Tuesday night)...Their last series win was April 28th – May 3rd when they took four of six (the last four) from Hudson Valley at ShoreTown Ballpark.

Mr. 900...The BlueClaws entered the season having used 894 different players in their club history, and technically, RHP Danyony Pulido, who threw a scoreless eighth inning on 4/4, was the sixth player to appear in a game this year that had not yet done so before the season, making him the 900th player to play in a game for the BlueClaws.

Second Half Underway...The SAL Northern Division Second Half Champion will play Frederick in the first round of the post-season...Bowling Green won the Southern Division First Half title...In 2023, Jersey Shore made the playoffs despite a 7-14 start to the second half, going 30-15 the rest of the way to clinch on the final day of the season.

Extra, Extra...The BlueClaws have played 39 home games, and six have gone to extra innings (3-3 at home, 3-5 overall in extra innings)...The BlueClaws played 10 extra inning games all of last year (two at home)...Extra Inning Home Games By Year: 2021 (3), 2022 (3), 2023 (8), 2024 (3), 2025 (2)...Since 2005, the most extra inning games they have played at home is 14 (7-7) in 2010...They have reached double-figures four times, most recently in 2012.

Things in 10s...The BlueClaws have already reached 10+ runs in a game eight times this year (most recently on 6/17 vs GVL), and scored 19 on Opening Night in Wilmington, a new club record...Last year, the BlueClaws scored 10+ runs in a game seven times and did not do it for a fourth time until June 8th...After their 13-2 win on April 18th, the BlueClaws have won by 10 runs or more three times already this year...They did so twice all of last year, four times in 2024, once in 2023, and once in 2021 (8 times as a High-A affiliate from 2021-2025).

Familial Faces...Of the 30 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 22 are returning to the BlueClaws and only eight are making their BlueClaws debuts...By comparison, last year, 13 players on the Break Camp roster made their BlueClaws debuts...The new faces: LHP Juan Amarante, RHP Ryan Degges, RHP Adilson Peralta, RHP Danyony Pulido, RHP Giuseppe Velasquez, IF Brady Day, IF Raider Tello, and OF Carter Mathison.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have four walk-off wins this year...Tyler Pettorini hit a walk off home run on Father’s Day (6/21) against Greenville (the third walk-off home run by the BlueClaws as a High-A affiliate – Felix Reyes in 2023 and Kehden Hettiger in 2025)...They beat Brooklyn 5-4 in 10 innings on June 4th on an RBI single from Luis Caicuto...They beat Hudson Valley on 5/2 on a strikeout/passed ball...They picked up their first walk-off win in 2026 on 4/9 vs Brooklyn on an 11th inning RBI single from Devin Saltiban...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins last year – a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger.

The Big Five...The BlueClaws have used two pitchers from Big Five schools in Philadelphia...RHP Luke Gabrysh went to St. Joseph’s and RHP Ryan Dromboski went to the University of Pennsylvania.

College Teammates...The BlueClaws have one pair of college teammates in C Kodey Shojinaga and RHP Reese Dutton, who played together at Kansas.

Just Grand...Luis Caicuto hit a grand slam in Rome on April 17th...Bryan Rincon’s grand slam on May 20, 2025 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin’s on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...135 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two to debut Opening Week with the Phillies and eight total this year...**Justin Crawford** (2023-24 BlueClaw) made his debut in the March 26th season opener while **Andrew Painter** (2022 BlueClaw) debuted on March 31st in the fifth game of the season...RHP **George Klassen** (2024 BlueClaw) debuted on April 6th with the Angels...IF **Hao-Yu Lee** (2022-23 BlueClaw) debuted on April 17th with the Tigers...UT **Felix Reyes** (2023-24 BlueClaw) debuted on April 18th with the Phillies and homered in his first at bat...C **Rodolfo Duran** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on May 7th with the Padres...OF **Gabriel Rincones** (2023 BlueClaw) debuted on June 12th with the Phillies...RHP **Julian Garcia** (2018 BlueClaw) debuted on June 24th with the Reds...Two former BlueClaws made debuts in 2025 – RHP Mick Abel (2022 BlueClaw) and UT Otto Kemp (2023-24 BlueClaw).

Mycal Jones Takes Over...Mycal Jones, in his seventh year in the organization, takes over for Greg Brodzinski as the new BlueClaws manager and is the 18th manager in BlueClaws history...Jones was a coach with Reading last year and with Clearwater the two years prior...He played in the Braves system and was originally a fourth round pick in 2009.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter returns the BlueClaws as the pitching coach...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Darnell Sweeney, with the FCL Phillies last year, is the hitting coach...Ryan Wroblewski makes his coaching debut after playing four years in the Astros organization, serving as the position coach and assistant hitting coach...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws position coach...Marissa VanHassel is the Athletic Trainer, Sam Cartier is the Assistant Athletic Trainer, and John Sweeney is the Strength & Conditioning Coach.

How Acquired: Amateur Free Agent, signed 1/2025

Season Notes: Threw five no hit innings with six strikeouts in BlueClaws debut on 6/19 vs GVL...Joined the BlueClaws on 6/16 from Clearwater where he was 3-0 in six games with a 1.86 ERA over 29 innings with 47 strikeouts and 10 walks...Struck out nine batters three times including his debut on 5/9 at DBT over four innings...Fanned at least six batters in all six of his Threshers appearances...#9 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Career Notes: Born in Phoenix, but signed with the Phillies as part of their international class in 2025 out of Mexico...In pro debut, pitched for both the FCL Phillies and Clearwater, going a combined 3-3, 4.42 with 72 strikeouts and 17 walks in 55 innings.

Closing The Door

Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, the most saves for any player in a season is 11 from Saul Teran in 2025...He was the first BlueClaw to reach double-digits after the previous high of eight (Aidan Anderson and Jonathan Hughes in 2022 and Blake Brown in 2021).
