## Jersey Shore BlueClaws (23-37) vs Aberdeen IronBirds (24-37)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001) RHP Casey Steward (3-6, 5.57) vs LHP Luis De Leon (0-0, 2.00) Series: Game 5 of 6 (Aberdeen leads season series 9-7 of 30)

Last Game Recap...Anderson De Los Santos had three hits and three RBIs while Leandro Arias drove in two and Aberdeen topped Jersey Shore 10-7 on Friday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...Jersey Shore battled back, cutting the lead to 10-7 on a two run double by Kehden Hettiger and they brought the tying run to the plate in the ninth but fell three runs short.

Going for a Series W...The BlueClaws need two wins in the last two games of the week to clinch their first series win of the season...They are 0-8-2, with one of the ties coming against Aberdeen in May and the other last week in Bowling Green.

The DC Show...Dylan Campbell had two more hits on Friday and is 10-25 over his current six game hitting streak...He had the game winning home run in the eighth inning on Wednesday and the game winning two run double in the seventh inning on Tuesday...Campbell is 20-65 with seven doubles, two home runs and six stolen bases since May 25", which he entered with a .160 batting average...Campbell has seven home runs on the season after he hit 10 last year with Great Lakes (A+, Dodgers), six of which came in August/September...Campbell stole 42 bases last year with Great Lakes (A+, Dodgers) and came over to the Phillies in a January trade...He was originally a 4" round pick of the Dodgers in 2023 from the University of Texas.

The Claws & The Birds...The BlueClaws and IronBirds meet this week (tied 2-2), their third series of the season...Aberdeen took four of six in the first series and the teams split the second one last month...Aberdeen split six games with Hudson Valley last week but got swept at Brooklyn the week before...Since beginning the season 6-5, they are just 17-32.

Walk This Way...The BlueClaws have walked nine hitters in each of their last two games (season high)...They walked nine (or more) in a nine inning game five times last year...The franchise record for most walks in a nine inning game is 13 (8/4/22 vs Hudson Valley)...On Friday, Aberdeen scored nine runs in innings that the BlueClaws walked the lead-off batter.

Kehden and the Claws...Kehden Hettiger had two hits and drove in three runs on Friday and is now 15-50 with two doubles, a triple (off Mets RHP Frankie Montas) and three home runs (all on the last road trip) since May 24<sup>th</sup>....Hettiger homered in his first BlueClaws at bat on 4/17 at Greensboro and hit a walk-off home run to beat Aberdeen on 5/6 at ShoreTown Ballpark...He was an 11<sup>th</sup> round pick in 2023 (Sierra Canyon HS, CA) and turned 21 on May 25<sup>th</sup>....Hettiger committed to Oregon before signing with the Phillies two years ago.

Elio Heating Up, Faces Former Team...Elio Prado, who played with Aberdeen last year in Orioles system, had two hits and two RBIs on Tuesday plus another hit on Wednesday...He had a home run and drove in four runs in the game two win on 6/7 at Bowling Green...The centerfielder, who began the year with Reading, is 13-39 with five doubles and a home run since May 31\*...Prado joined the BlueClaws on 5/14 from Reading, where he was hitting .200 in 23 games...Prado was taken from Baltimore in the Minor League Rule-5 Draft by the Phillies from Particular Company.

Saul Locks It Down...Saul (Sah-OOL) Teran earned his first BlueClaws save with a scoreless inning on Wednesday...He has thrown three scoreless innings since joining Jersey Shore last week...Teran joins the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he gave up two earned runs in 18 innings with 31 strikeouts and three walls...He also spent last year with the Threshers, going 3-1 with a 3.96 ERA and 36 strikeouts in 25 innings pitched...Teran, 23 years old, signed with the Phillies in February of 2021...RHP Josh Hejka was transferred to Reading.

Ware 'em Out...Bryson Ware is 9-27 since last Tuesday's opener at Bowling Green and had a four hit game on Thursday and a two hit game on Sunday...He now has seven homers on the year, five since May 22<sup>st</sup>... Since May 9<sup>st</sup>, he is 25-80 with eight doubles, six home runs, 16 RBIs, and four walks...Prior to the current stretch, Ware had in 0-20 and 2-35 slumps...Ware was an 8<sup>st</sup> round jetch in 2023 from Auburn University...He hit 10 home runs in 2023, nine with Clearwater and one with the BlueClaws.

Caleb's Back...Caleb Ricketts (3-11) is back with the BlueClaws, this time on a minor league rehab assignment...He hit a walk-off grand slam for Clearwater on Sunday and went 7-13 in three games with the Threshers...He began the year with Reading and went 6-19 before going on the IL on 4/16...Ricketts hit .218 with three homers with Jersey Shore in 2023.

Out With a Bang (2)...Carson DeMartini hit two home runs on Sunday in what turned into his final game with the BlueClaws...The 2024 Phillies 4th round pick (Virginia Tech) was promoted to Reading on Monday after a stretch (since May 20th) in which he went 23-64 (359) with seven home runs, 16 RBIs, and five steals (.766 SLG and 1.206 OPS)...He had eight home runs in total with Jersey Shore, with his first in the home opener on 4/8 vs Aberdeen...He is the third member of the Opening Day roster with Reading (RHPs Tommy McCollum and Luke Russo [Andrew Baker was with Reading and is now back).

Going, Going, Gone...Last year, the BlueClaws had four players hit more than six home runs (Jordan Dissin – 9, Leandro Pineda – 8, Felix Reyes – 8, and Troy Schreffler – 8), though for the first time in team history, nobody hit 10...This year, they already have four players with five or more (Carson DeMartini – 8 (promoted), Bryson Ware – 7, Dylan Campbell – 7, Kehden

Big Files in Big Moments...Eduardo Lopez has five home runs on the year and a knack for the big moment...June 5th at BG (solo HR to tie the game at 3 in the 8th inning)...June 1th at GVL (2-run HR to break 7-7 tie in 12th inning)...May 2th ws BRK (3-run HR to put BlueClaws up 8-5 in 6th inning)...June 1th break 7-7 tie in 12th inning)...May 2th ws BRK (3-run HR to put BlueClaws up 8-7 in 5th inning of seven inning game)...Lopez (bined the Phillies in December in the Minor League Rule-5 Draft after spending the last wo years with Greenville in the South Atlantic League.

Getting Higgy With It...Matt Higgins hit his third BlueClaws home run on Sunday and hit two in Bowling Green...Since May 15°, Higgins is 12-44 with two doubles and two home runs plus nine RBIs...Higgins joined the BlueClaws on May 8° after he was released by the Giants while playing for Double-A Richmond...Higgins had played in the Giants system since 2022 after signing out of Bellarmine (KY).

Walk-a-Thon...Luke Davis has drawn 30 walks in just 125 plate appearances so far this season...Davis has at least two walks in seven games this season and had a team-record tying four in a 4/18 game at Greensboro...The BlueClaws High-A record is 60 walks by Baron Radcliff in 408 plate appearances in 2022...Davis has two home runs, the most recent coming on 6/7 at Bowling Green...The 2 year old Davis signed with the Phillies in July out of Long Beach City College where he was the South Coast Conference Player of the Year.

Lock It Down...Saul Teran earned his first save on Wednesday...Jaydenn Estanistata picked up his fourth save, and eighth of his career, with a scoreless inning in game one on 6/7 at Bowling Green...Paxton Thompson earned his second save of the year in the win in game two on 5/25 against Brooklyn...Tommy McCollum (promoted to Reading on 5/1), has three.

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 24 times this season, once on Tuesday (Asheville has allowed 26 such innings, the most in the league), in 21 different games over which they are 2-19...Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in the seventh and won in 10)...Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...15 of the 23 innings have included multiple walks.

From the Draft...With Carson DeMartini promoted to Reading on 6/9, the BlueClaws have no members of the 2024 Phillies draft class...Aaron Combs was an 8<sup>th</sup> round pick last year by the White Sox and traded to the Phillies (for LHP Tyler Gilbert) on New Year's Day...DeMartini (4<sup>th</sup> round, Virginia Tech) was the only 2024 draft class member to open the season with Jersey Shore, marking the third straight season the BlueClaws have only had one member of the preceding year's draft class on the Opening Day roster (Troy Schreffer, 12<sup>th</sup> round in 2023 in 2023, 28cah Arnold, 13<sup>th</sup> yound in 2023 in 2023, 28cah Arnold, 13<sup>th</sup> yound in 2023 in 2024,

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes six players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert). OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations), OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox), and OF Elio Prado (Minor League Rule-5 from the Orioles)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10<sup>th</sup> to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning - they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9<sup>th</sup> inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in

Power Index...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have one walk-off win this year - a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reves hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show...Otto Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6<sup>th</sup>, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Season Notes: Gave up two runs in five innings with seven strikeouts to earn win on 6/7 at BG...Struck out seven over five innings on 5/7 vs ABD, allowing one unearned run...Gave up nine runs in two innings and took loss on 4/29 at HV...Threw six scoreless innings to earn win on 4/22 vs BRK...Earned win on Opening Day with five one-hit, scoreless innings on 4/4 at HV...On Opening Day roster.

Career Notes: Split 2024 between Clearwater (4-2, 3.38 ERA with 52 strikeouts in 50.2 innings) and the BlueClaws (4-3, 3.46 ERA with 49 strikeouts in 52 innings)...Threw seven scoreless innings on 7/23/24 at ABD...Struck out 15 over 10.2 scoreless innings between 8/21/24 at BRK and 8/28/24 vs HV...Made five appearances between the FCL Phillies (two scoreless innings in two games) and Clearwater (two runs in four innings in three games) in first professional season...First player the Phillies have drafted from D2 Washburn University...Notable baseball alumni include Davey Lopes, who had a 16 year big league career, managed the Brewers (2000 – 2002) and was the Phillies 1B coach from 2007-2010, including for their 2008 World Series title...Has a twin brother named Calvin.
