LAST GAME

While they may have missed plenty of chances for a larger win, the Bowie Baysox were still able to celebrate on Saturday night, and in a larger fashion, too. Bowie collected their seventh walk-off win of the season, as they downed the Richmond Flying Squirrels 2-1. Neither starting pitcher worked too far into the night, as Richmond's Kai-Wei Teng walked a career-high six batters, but Bowie's Brennan Haniffee was as efficient as could be, allowing only three hits over five scoreless innings, on just 58 pitches. In the bottom of the ninth, Cesar Prieto drew a one-out walk, and Hudson Haskin blooped a single to right field to push Prieto to third base. Andrew Daschbach drilled a line drive to right field, and Prieto swam around the throw to home plate, scoring the winning run.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

In a series that (Bowie hopes) should preview the first round of the Eastern League playoffs, Bowie will try to make one more charge against the team that they have battled tightly with this season. While Richmond went 7-2 against Bowie in the first half of the season, Bowie flipped the record around against Richmond in the second half, bringing the season series to an even 9-9. While they were able to win the first half of the season in a tiebreak with Akron, the second half has been much more difficult for the Squirrels, as they have the league's worst record in the half. Richmond has relied constantly on power this season, as they have the third-most home runs in the league, despite sporting the lowest batting average.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Keaton Winn is yet another high-volume strikeout arm in the Giants organization, and has used that volume to climb through three levels this season. A fifth-round JuCo pick by San Francisco, Winn did not pitch in 2021 after undergoing Tommy John surgery, and made 13 appearances at Single-A to start the season. He only made eight appearances at High-A, but struck out 46 batters in 37 innings to earn his promotion. The strikeouts aren't there for him in Double-A just yet, as he's only punched out 16 batters in 21 innings, and has given up 26 hits, including ten hits in his last start. He's averaging over one hit per inning this season.

SUNDAY SCARIES

Bowie has not been able to close out as many series as they would like this year. Bowie is 8-16 on Sundays this season, the worst record in the league on the last day of the week. The basic starter rotation that pits a starting pitcher versus the opponent a second time might be a factor, as Bowie has a 5.01 ERA on Sunday games this year.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie has had a love-hate relationship with one-run games this season. One-run games have been one of the most common outcomes for Bowie this season, as their 48 one-run games leads the Eastern League. Their .429 winning percentage in one-run games (21-28) is the second-lowest in the Eastern League, trailing only Binghamton. The 28 one-run losses is the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

MEAT LEFT ON THE BONE

Some of Bowie's offensive woes this season have not been from a lack of effort. In fact, the Baysox are the team most likely to start an inning with a runner on base in the Eastern League. Bowie leads the league in all three slash lines (.272/.370/.469) from the first batter of an inning this season. They also lead the league in lead off doubles. All of those numbers combine to Bowie leaving 959 runners on base this season, the most in the league, and an average of 7.4 per game. Bowie has also stranded the most runners in scoring position in the league (708). Inversely, Bowie has the third-most strikeouts in the league when batting with runners on base (561). In this series, Bowie is only 3-for-39 (.077) with runners in scoring position.

LATE ARRIVALS

Bowie has not been able to get their offense going against opposing starting pitchers lately. So far in September, opposing starting pitchers have fired 47.1 innings, and allowed only 15 runs, a 2.85 ERA. The strong opposition has not been fully able to seal the deal, however, as opposing starters have only won two games out of Bowie's last seven losses.
