JACKSONVILLE FALLS TO STRIPERS IN 2023 OPENER

Home runs from Jerar Encarnacion and Austin Allen helped the Jumbo Shrimp rally from a pair of deficits in Friday's season opener, but Jacksonville fell 8-5 to Gwinnett. After Allen tied the score at five in the top of the ninth by homering off Gwinnett (1-0) reliever Ty Tice (1-0), Jacksonville (0-1) reliever Enrique Burgos (0-1) yielded a leadoff single to Josh Fuentes to begin the bottom of the ninth. After a fly out, a ground out moved Fuentes to second. The Jumbo Shrimp intentionally walked Vaughn Grissom and then brought Robert Garcia out of the bullpen, but Shewmake, who had struck out four times in the game, launched a three-run bomb to win it for the Stripers.

GRAND OPENING

Since 2005, Jacksonville has customarily enjoyed a lot of success on Opening Day. After last night's loss, the Jumbo Shrimp fall to 10-8 (.556) in their season Lid-lifers since 2005, collectively outscoring opponents 77-70 on Opening Day. Jacksonville has taken its Opening Day battle in seven of its last 11 season openers dating back to 2012.

JUST WIN. BABY

Coming into the 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have earned back-to-back winning marks for the first time since 2013-14. Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) mark in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) record in 2022, Jacksonville's 155 wins over the last two seasons are the club's most in consecutive campaigns since the 163 victories piled up by the 2009-10 squads. In particular the last two years, Jacksonville has excelled on the road, with winning records in each campaign. Prior to 2021, the club's last winning record away from 121 Financial Ballpark was in 2014, when they finished 42-28 on the road.

Since 2021, their first season in their return to the Triple-A level, Jacksonville owns a 24-11 record against the Gwinnett Stripers. That .685 winning percentage is the second-highest against any opponent they've faced over this span. Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp clocked 24 home runs against the Stripers, third-most against all opponents. The pitching staff also owned Gwinnett, holding them to a .215 batting average against, the second-lowest among 2022 opponents, and a 2.99 staff ERA that was the best against 2022 adversary.

ROAD WARRIORS

Despite owning a home record of 38-37 (.507) in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp were world beaters on the road, posting a 42-32 (.568) record away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Of those 42 road wins, Jacksonville had 19 wins on the road against IL West opponents like Gwinnett. In 2022 contests away from 121 Financial Ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .263/.337/.453. Jacksonville's .263 batting average on the road ranked third in the IL and their .790 OPS placed second in the circuit. In comparison, the club ht .250/.330/.398 at home. Of the 744 runs the Jumbo Shrimp scored in 2022, 409 came on the road (55.0 percent).

GOING, GOING..GONE!

Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp clubbed 183 home runs, which ranked sixth in the International League while also placing as the most in a season for a Jacksonville club since a franchise record of 200 in 1996. In fact, Jacksonville has eclipsed 100 long balls in a season just twice in the previous seven campaigns. Jacksonville particularly got hot at the back end of last season, as they smashed 47 home runs in their last 43 games. The Jumbo Shrimp hit most of their long balls on the road last year, launching 107 of their 183 home runs (58.5%) away from 121 Financial Ballpark, which was the highest home run total on the road in the IL.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Jumbo Shrimp manager Daren Brown returns for his second year as Jacksonville's skipper. Brown holds a 1,340-1,326 (.503) record as a minor league manager. The Holdenville, Okla., native is in the midst of his third stint as a Triple-A skipper. The 55-year-old piloted Triple-A Tacoma in Seattle's organization from 2007-13 and again in 2019, tallying 494 victories, which marks the most wins of any manager in Rainiers franchise history. Brown led Tacoma to consecutive division titles in 2009 and 2010, and during that latter season, helped the Rainiers win the franchise's first outright Pacific Coast League Championship since 1969.

ABOUT CHI CHI

-Gonzáalez was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.

2023 SEASON 2022 SEASON -González posted an 0-1 record with a 5.87 ERA in the 2022 regular season. 2021 SEASON -González made Colorado's Opening Day roster and began season in Rockies bullpen.

-González then made a move to the starting roatation starting April 10, making seven starts for the Rockies.

-In his first stint in the rotation, Chi Chi went 1-4, 8.23 ERA (50.1 IP, 46 ER) through his last 11 starts (Rockies 4-7) from June 10 through his final start on Sept. 7. He was then placed on Injured List with a right oblique strain Sept. 8-Oct. 2 before electing to free agency.
