**2023:** Made his Double-A debut on 4/15 at Erie, tossing 2.1 scoreless innings before hitting his pitch limit... Tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his Double-A career, longest by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras threw 18.2 IP to start the 2021 season... Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16... Matched his career-high with 7 runs allowed (4 earned) on 6/22 vs. Bowie... Made his first appearance post-All Star break in a one-inning relief outing on July 18 vs. Reading... Tossed his first career complete game as a professional in a 7-inning affair with Erie on 8/9 in the first of a doubleheader, first CG by a Curve pitcher since **Trey McGough** in 2021 (5.0 IP) and first 7-inning CG since **Domingo Robles** in 2019... **Has allowed 2 runs or fewer in 11-of-19 starts this season...**
