FROM THE CROW'S NEST

RUNS, RUNS, RUNS: The Marauders have scored 50 runs over their last three games, the highest total of any three-game stretch this season. Bradenton ranks second in the Low-A Southeast with 595 runs scored (Tampa leads at 704). Sunday's 22-5 win in Fort Myers established a new franchise record for runs in a game, while Tuesday's 19-7 victory saw Bradenton fall just one shy of the franchise single-game home run record of 7, set on July 31 against Dunedin.

ERNNY'S EARNIN' IT: Ernny Ordóñez's two-home run game Thursday night was the Bronx native's first career multi-homer game, and his 3 hits and 4 RBI on the evening both matched his season high. Ordóñez has hit safely in 4 of his last 5 games, recording 7 RBI during that stretch.

ENDY'S GAME: Endy Rodríguez has hit safely in 9 straight games, batting .438 with 13 RBI during the streak. Since the beginning of July (42 games), Rodríguez is batting .327 with a .428 OBP, .545 SLG, and a .973 OPS. He is currently second in the league with 91 hits (Jupiter's Victor Mesa Jr. leads with 100 hits).

NEW KID ON THE BLOCK: Jackson Glenn has reached base safely in each of his first 14 games at Low-A, batting .413 with a .525 OBP. The Pirates' fifth-round draft pick out of Dallas Baptist has hit safely in 13 of the 14 games, and has walked 12 times while striking out just 7 times.

MAGIC WANDI: Right-hander Wandi Montout turned in an effective month of August out of the Marauders bullpen, posting a 1.69 ERA while holding opponents to a .205 batting average in 7 appearances. The 24-year-old from the Dominican Republic has allowed an earned run in just 2 of his last 10 appearances, stretching back to July 23 at St. Lucie.

THE OPPONENT: The Tarpons are coming off a 4-games-to-3 series loss in Clearwater. Tampa has held sole or partial possession of first place in the West Division for the entire season, with the Marauders last tying for first place on July 1. The Tarpons are 35-21 on the road and own Minor League Baseball's best run differential at +227 (the Charleston RiverDogs rank second in MiLB at +226).

TOP PROSPECTS: Per midseason ranking updates, the Marauders roster currently includes four prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#15), **Endy Rodríguez** (#19), and **Maikol Escotto** (#20). Head and Rodríguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the Joe Musgrove trade in January, while Escotto was one of four prospects obtained from the Yankees in the Jameson Taillon trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: Bradenton pitchers' 1,113 strikeouts are 9th in all of MiLB (San Jose leads with 1,217)... The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +96 (Tampa's +227 leads all of MiLB)... Eight Marauders players rank within the league's top 10 in home runs: **Jase Bowen** and **Hudson Head** (14 HR, T-2nd), **Endy Rodríguez** (12 HR, T-3rd), **Jack Herman** (10 HR, T-5th), **Daniel Lopez** and **Sammy Siani** (8 HR, T-7th, and **Maikol Escotto** and **Alexander Mojica** (7 HR, T-8th).

REPERTOIRE: Fastball (mid- to high-90s), Slider (low-80s), Changeup (low-80s)

2021: Made professional debut in relief on May 25 vs Palm Beach: 3 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 6 K... Did not allow an earned run through first seven innings of career... First career start, June 5 at Dunedin: 3.2 IP: 3 H, 1 R, 2 BB/3 K, 66 pitches/41 strikes... June 27 vs Jupiter: career-high 11 K, struck out 11 of 14 batters faced... His 11 K are the highest single-game total by a Marauder in 2021 (topping Santiago Florez, 10 K on June 2 at Dunedin) and finished just two shy of matching Nick Kingham’s franchise record 13 K on 4/28/13 vs Brevard County... That day, Jones combined with Domingo Gonzalez for 18 strikeouts, matching the franchise record (18 K in 14 innings on 6/23/11 at Fort Myers)... July 11 vs Clearwater, hit Rixon Wingrove in the leg with a pitch, sparking a benches-clearing incident... Two weeks ago vs Clearwater, held Threshers scoreless through 3 IP but labored in 4th (2 BB and INF-1B loaded the bases, 2 BB forced home a run each, 2-run single allowed by Carlos Campos in relief)... Last Friday at Fort Myers: shortest start of his career (2.2 IP), season-high 4 Bradenton errors committed behind him (including 3 errors in 5-run 3rd inning)... **Has a 1.46 WHIP, .250 BAA on the season.**

2020: Drafted in the 2nd Round (44th overall) out of La Mirada High School... From the Long Beach *Press-Telegram*: Jones: "I was standing right next to my dad (Keith) and we both just really broke down and started crying. It was a moment to remember forever." ... Was committed to the University of Texas before being drafted... Before Covid shutdown: 3 GS, 2-1 record, 0.82 ERA, 28 K in 17 IP... Was also hitting .409 and was 8 for 8 in stolen bases... Also from the *Press-Telegram*, La Mirada head coach Jimmy Zurn: "What this kid's been able to do from a pitching standpoint ... and not just that, I'm talking in all areas of the game — hitting, stealing bases, the way he plays center field. And No. 1 is his competitive nature. I think that's what separates him from a lot of these people in this draft. This kid is a winner and he wants to win and he expects to win."

PERSONAL: Was a two-way standout at La Mirada HS, playing center field when not pitching... Father, Keith, played baseball at Fullerton College (CA) before spending two seasons as an infielder in the Diamondbacks organization (Rookie-level and Low-A, 1997-1998)... Mother played college softball...
