**TODAY'S GAME:** The Quakes finish their 12-game, 13-day home stand today, as they play the last game of a six-game set against the first-place Lake Elsinore Storm. Today, with the purchase of a ticket to the game, local little leaguers will participate in the FREE U.S. Bank Youth Clinic before the game (10am) and then "Run the Bases" after the game! Game time is 2:00pm and tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** Today's game is the 12th of 30 head-to-head meetings between the two clubs and the sixth of 12 here at LoanMart Field. In their one and only series so far here in 2022, the Quakes took four of six down at The Diamond. In 2021, the Quakes dominated the season-long series, winning 21 of the 30 meetings.

**LAST GAME:** The Quakes held the Storm to just three hits, but the Rancho offense couldn't get on track either, dropping a 3-2 decision to Lake Elsinore on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. Storm starter Victor Lizarraga (2-1) was shaky with his command early on, but settled down to give the Storm five strong innings, retiring the final seven hitters he faced. The Storm bullpen allowed just one base-runner over the final four innings, including holding the Quakes without a hit. Ben Miller worked a 1-2-3 ninth for his third save. Quakes' starter River Ryan (0-1) pitched into the third inning in just his second pro start, but gave up two runs over 2.1 innings in the loss. Luis Rodriguez knocked in both runs, as he had a pair of RBI doubles. Rancho reliever Jerming Rosario was strong in relief, as he fired 4.2 innings of no-hit scoreless baseball.

**RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** On Friday, right-handers Heissell Baro and Osvanni Gutierrez were transferred to Rancho Cucamonga from Extended Spring Training in Arizona. They take the roster spots of LHP Benony Robles (Temporary Inactive List) and Edgardo Henriquez (Injured List). On Wednesday, the Quakes made four moves, activating RHP Carlos De Los Santos from the Injured List and activating catcher Marco Hernandez from the Developmental List. LHP Maddux Bruns was placed on the Injured List and RHP Horacio Andujar has been transferred back to Extended Spring Training in Arizona.

**1 VERSUS 2:** The Quakes and Storm are now separated by three games in the South with just 16 to play in the first half. After consecutive losses to start this series, the Quakes won back-to-back games, pulling to within two games before last night's set-back dropped them to three games out. This is the only series at LoanMart Field in the first half between these two. They will meet again in the first half, as the half will actually end half-way through their six-game series in Lake Elsinore. The first three games of that series (June 21-23) will count in the first half standings, while the second three obviously count towards the second half. Rancho's other remaining games include six games at last-place Stockton and home against third-place Inland Empire. Lake Elsinore has the much tougher remaining games, as they host San Jose for six, before making their way to Modesto for six, then finishing with three against Rancho.

**CLAYTON KERSHAW:** In what will be his third rehab appearance with the Quakes over his career, Dodgers' left-hander Clayton Kershaw is scheduled to start for Rancho Cucamonga today. On the Injured List since May 13th with SI joint inflammation, Kershaw has made five starts this year, going 4-0 with a 1.80 ERA for the Dodgers. The 2020 World Series Champion has not been to LoanMart Field since September 3, 2016, when he went three innings against the Modesto Nuts. His only other outing for the Quakes was in 2014 against the Lancaster JetHawks. The eight-time All-Star is a three-time Cy Young Winner (2011, 2013, 2014) and was the NL MVP in 2014 as well. He was drafted by the Dodgers seventh overall in the first round of the 2006 draft and debuted in the big leagues in 2008. All Dodgers rehabbers are sponsored by Yaamava' Resort and Casino at San Manuel.

**JESUS GONZALEZ:** The Storm send lefty Jesus Gonzalez to the mound today in the series finale, as he makes his ninth appearance and eighth start of the year, his second against the Quakes. In his only start against Rancho (May 8), he allowed six runs (five earned) on eight hits over 3.1 innings in a loss. In his last start overall on May 29, he scattered three hits over five scoreless innings in a win over Inland Empire at home. Gonzalez was signed by San Diego in 2017 out of Venezuela.
